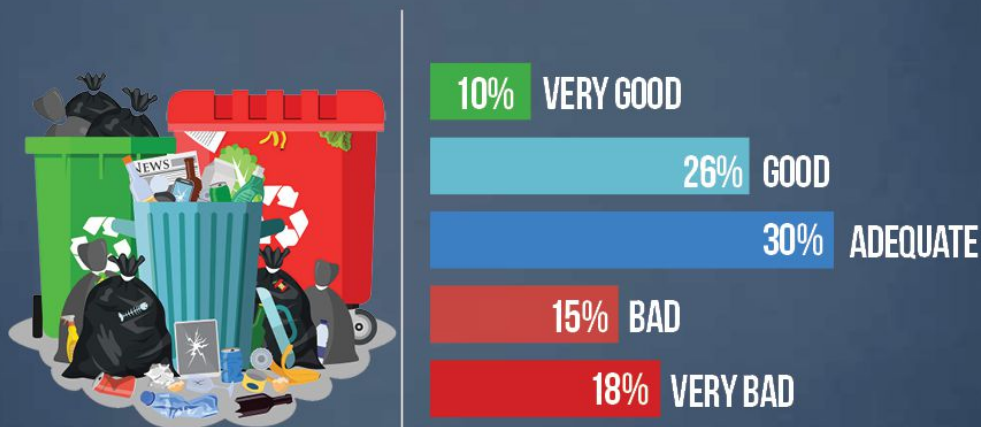

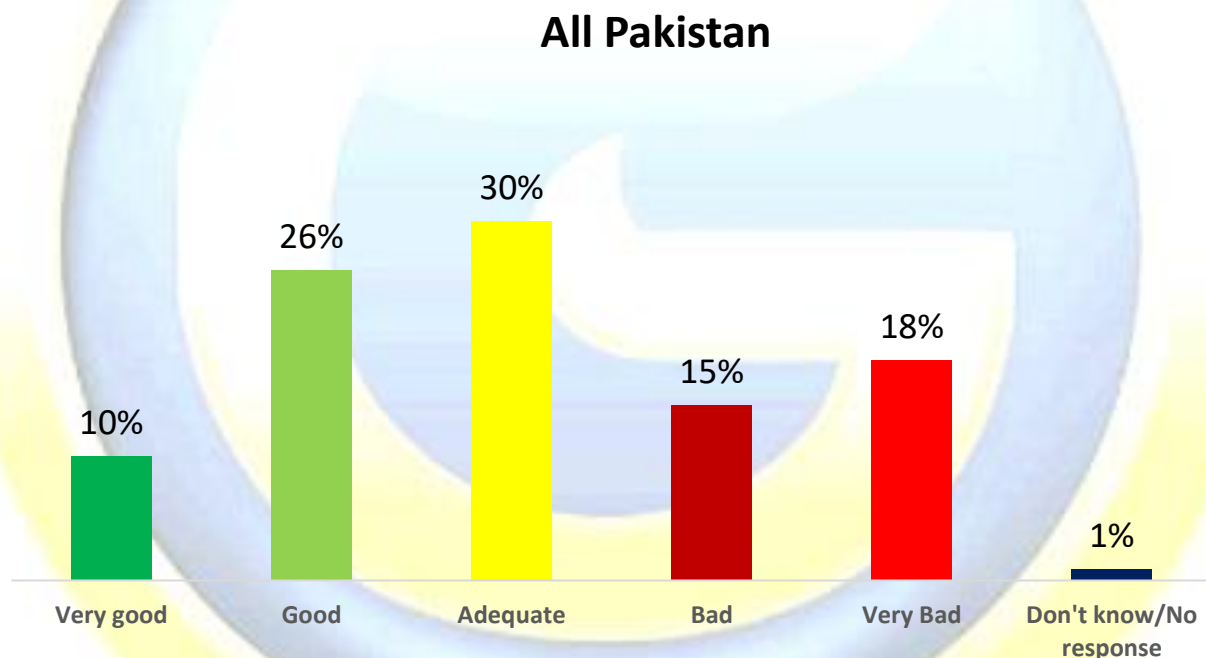
Approximately 1 in 3 Pakistanis complain that the general state of cleanliness in their neighborhood is poor: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, approximately 1 in 3 Pakistanis complain that the general state of cleanliness in their neighborhood is poor.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, “*What is the general state of cleanliness in your neighborhood/village?*” In response to this question, 10% said very good, 26% said good, 30% said adequate, 15% said bad and 18% said very bad. 1% did not know or did not provide any response.

Question: “What is the general state of cleanliness in your neighborhood/village?”

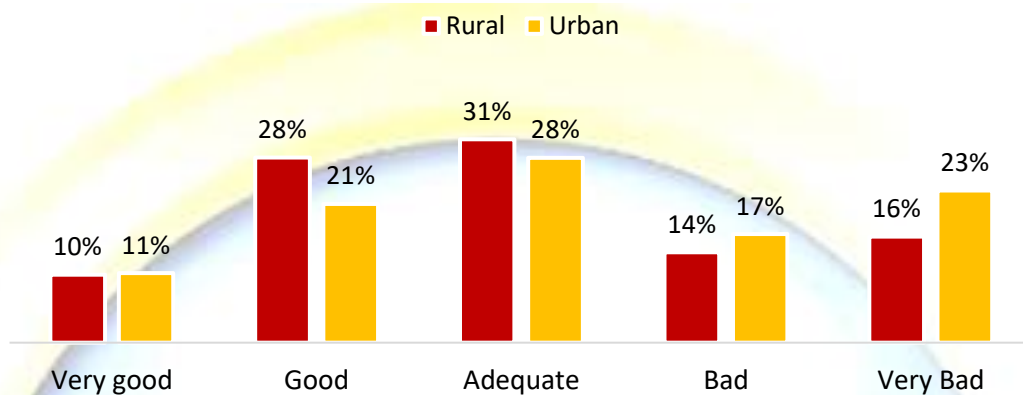

Rural-Urban Breakdown

More people in urban areas (40%) believe that the general state of cleanliness in their neighborhood/village is bad as compared to those from rural areas (30%).

Rural/Urban Breakdown



The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1422 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during August 13, 2021 – September 05, 2021. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was CATI.
