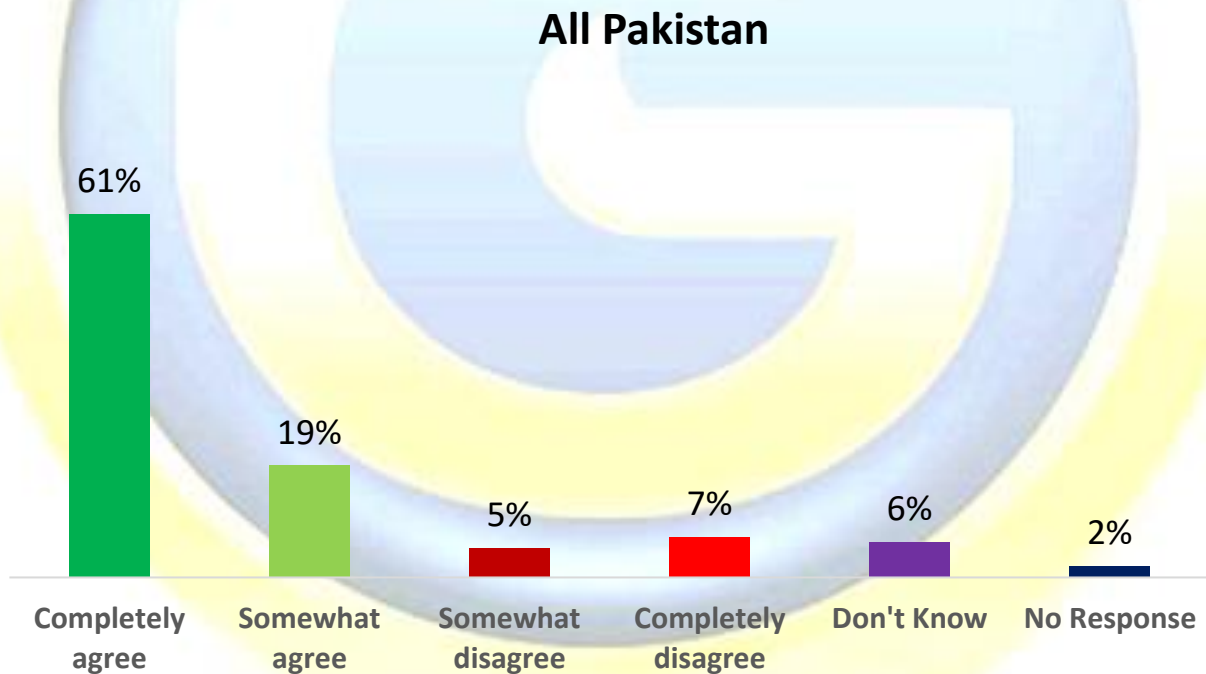
4 in 5 Pakistanis agree that political parties and politicians do not care about the ordinary people: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad), September 16, 2021

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 4 in 5 Pakistanis agree that political parties and politicians do not care about the ordinary people.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, *“Please indicate to what extent you agree or disagree with the following statement? - Political parties and politicians do not care about ordinary people like me”* In response to this question, 61% said they completely agreed, 19% somewhat agreed, 5% somewhat disagreed and 7% completely disagreed. 6% did not know and 2% had no response.

Question: “Please indicate to what extent you agree or disagree with the following statement? - Political parties and politicians do not care about ordinary people like me”

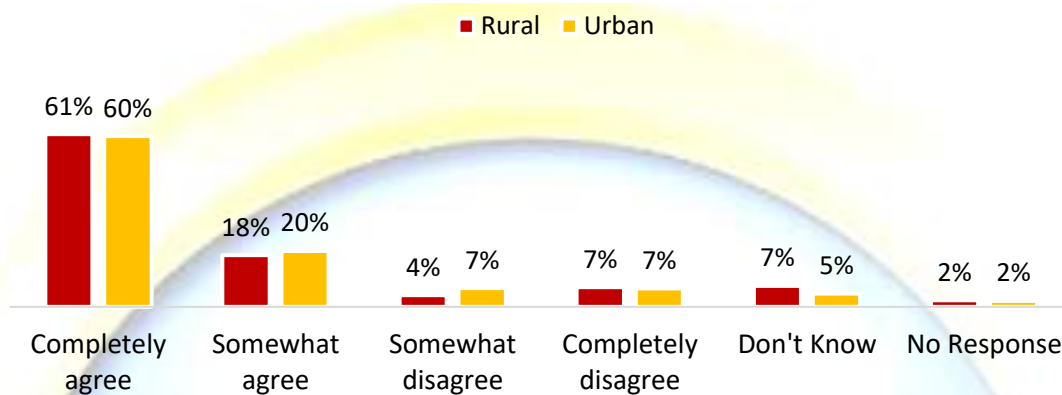

Urban-rural Breakdown

79% from rural areas and 80% from urban areas agree that politicians and political parties do not care about the ordinary people.

Rural/Urban Breakdown



The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1418 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during August 13, 2021 – September 05, 2021. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was CATI.
