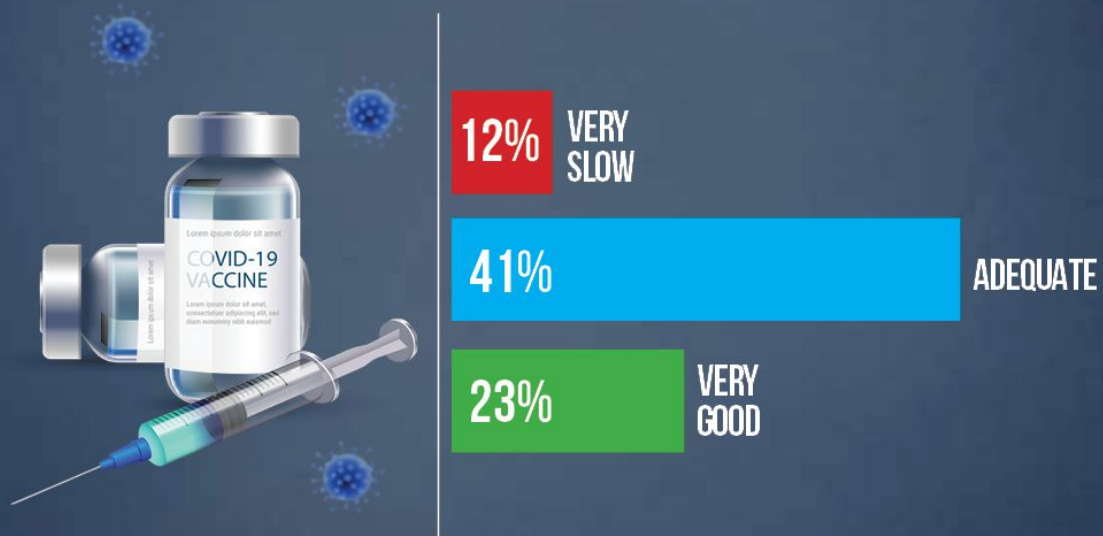

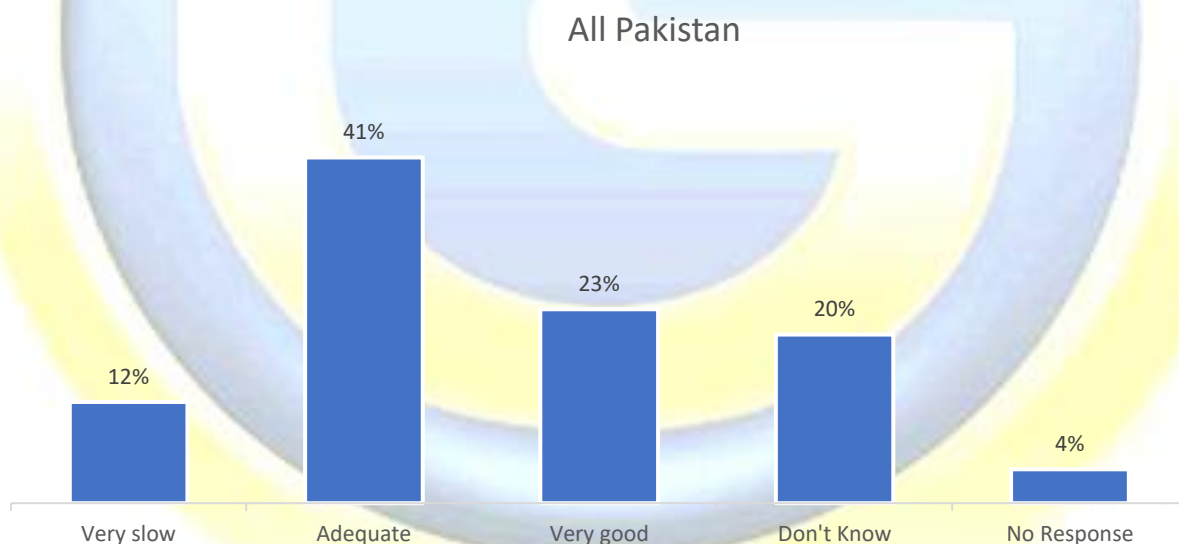

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 41% Pakistanis think that the speed of the coronavirus vaccine rollout by the Pakistani government is adequate.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, “*What is your opinion regarding the speed of vaccine rollout by the Pakistani government?*” In response to this question, 12% said very slow, 41% said adequate, 23% said very good, 20% did not know and 4% did not respond.

Question: “What is your opinion regarding the speed of vaccine rollout by the Pakistani government?”

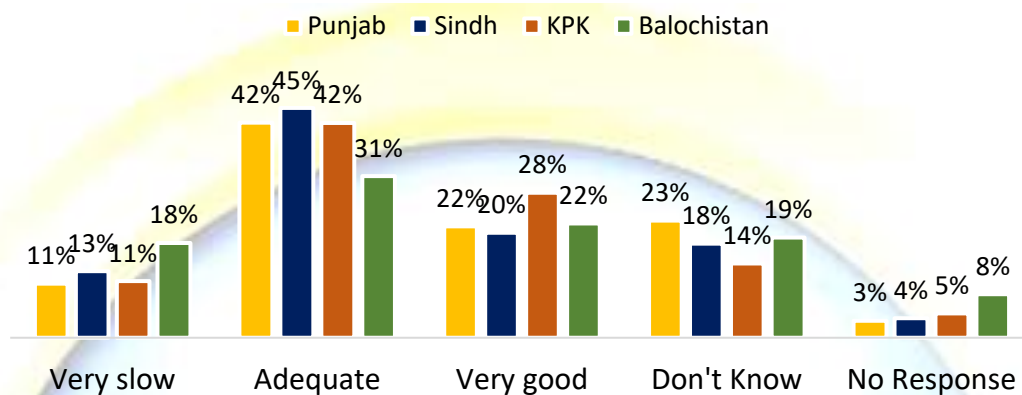

More people in KPK consider the speed of vaccine rollout within Pakistan to be “very good” as compared to other provinces.

Provincial Breakdown



The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1066 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during July 01, 2021 – July 13, 2021. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was CATI.
