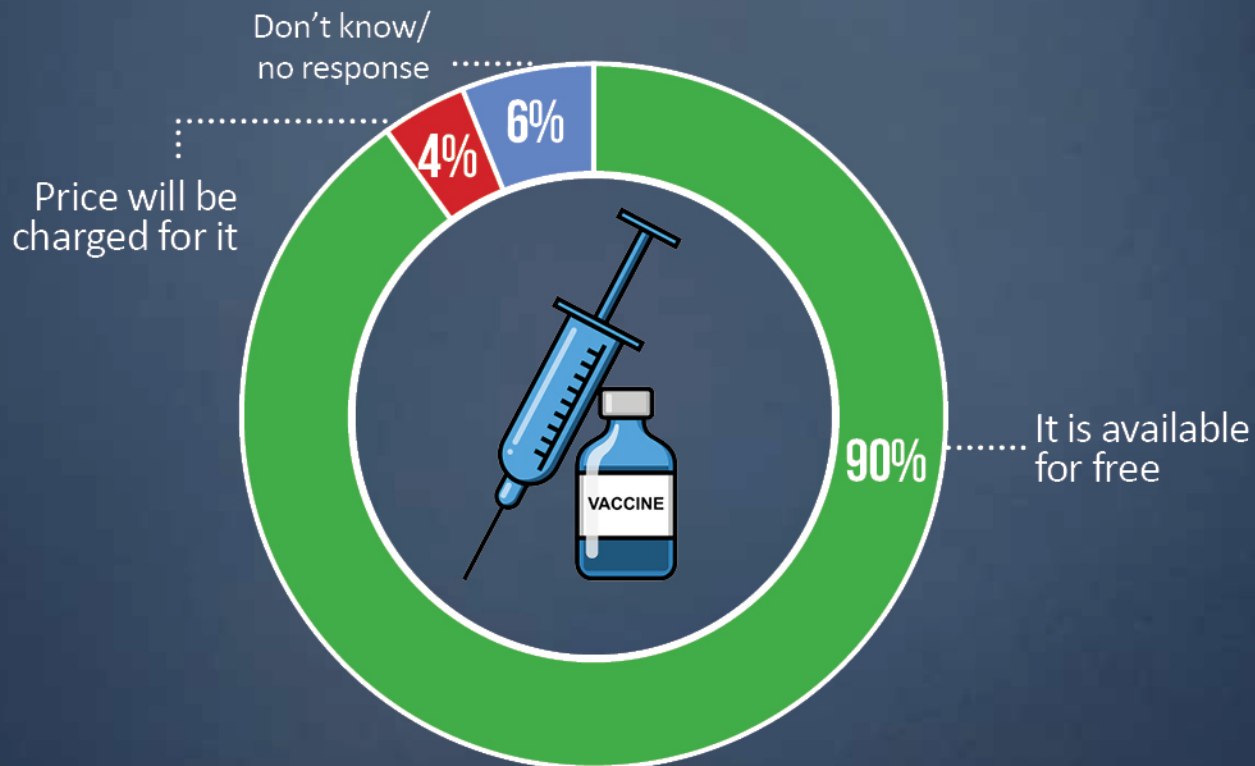

4 % of Pakistanis still believe that a price will be charged for the COVID-19 vaccine; this is a 31 % decrease from 35 % in March 2021: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 4% of Pakistanis still believe that a price will be charged for the COVID-19 vaccine.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, “Do you think getting vaccinated for corona will be free or be charged with a fee?” In response to this question, 90% responded that it will be available for free while only 4% believe that a price will be charged for it. 6% did not know or did not respond.

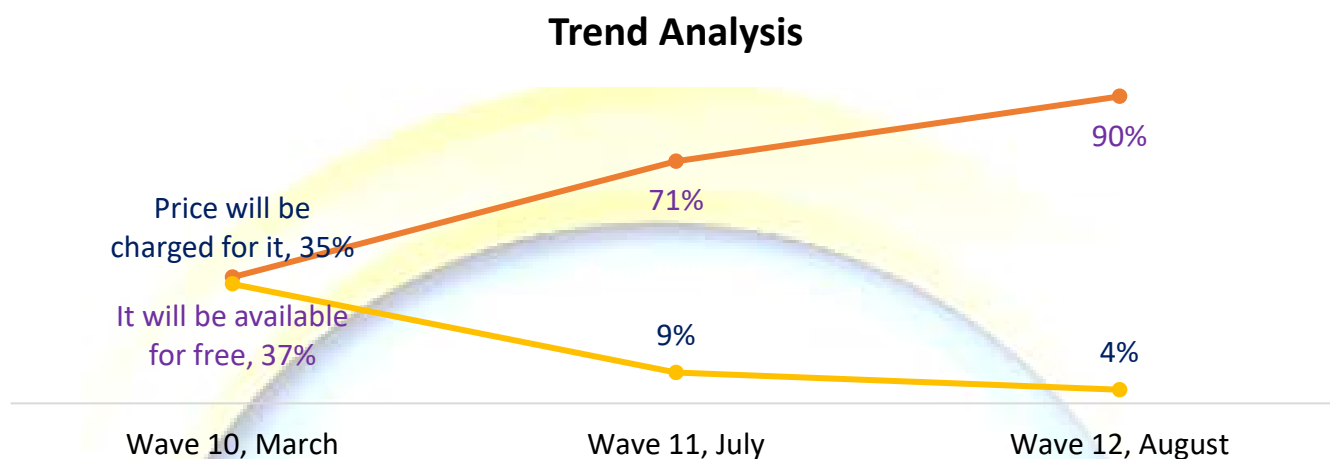
Question: “Do you think getting vaccinated for coronavirus will be free or be charged with a fee?”

Trend Analysis

As compared to the previous waves, there is now more awareness that the COVID-19 vaccine will be provided for free. In March 2021, 35% believed that a price will be charged for the COVID-19 vaccine, but this number has reduced to only 4% in August 2021.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1727 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during August 13, 2021 – September 5, 2021. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was CATI.
