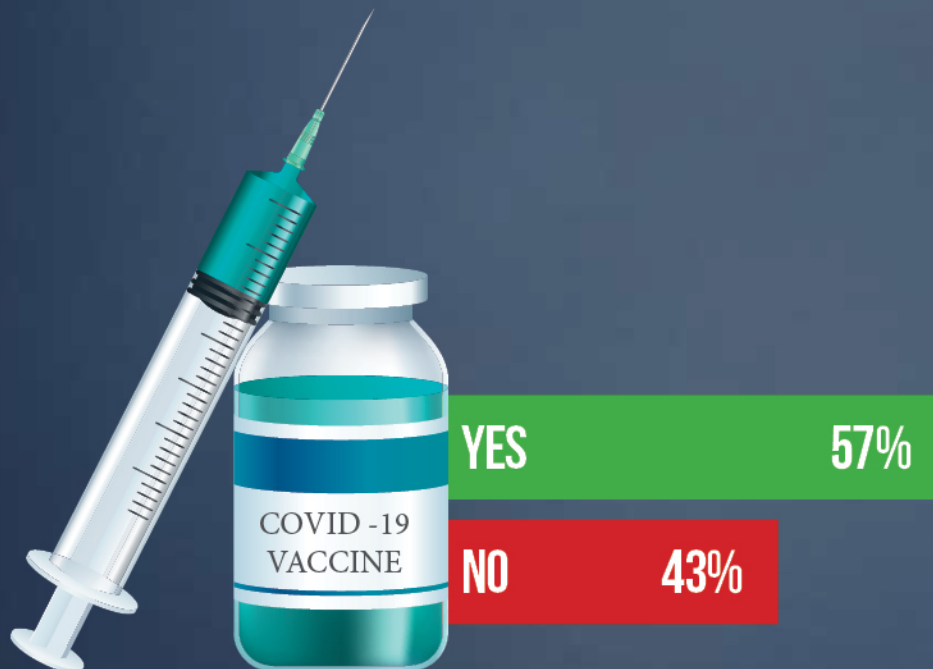

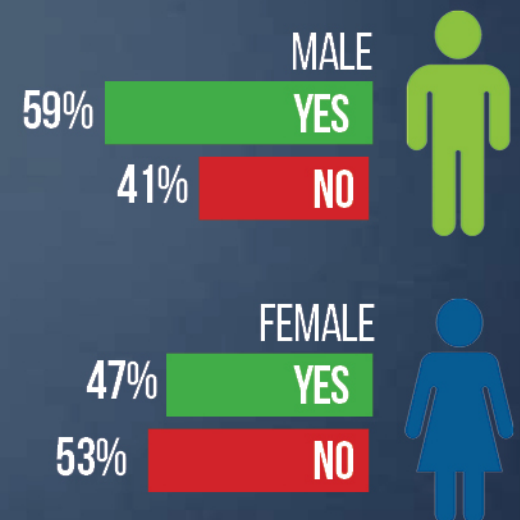
NEARLY 6 IN 10 (57%) PAKISTANIS HAVE RECEIVED AT LEAST ONE DOSE OF THE COVID-19 VACCINE; SIGNIFICANT GENDER DISPARITY EXISTS IN TERMS OF VACCINATION, NEEDING URGENT ATTENTION: GALLUP & GILANI PAKISTAN

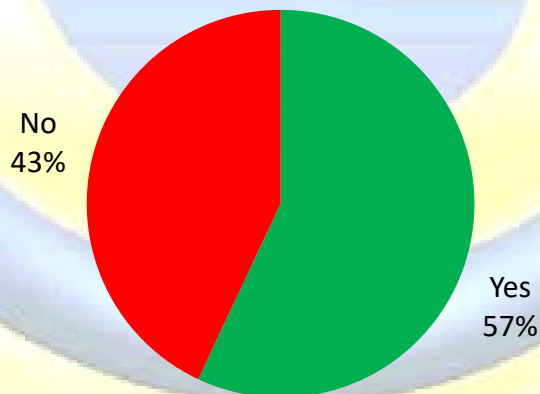
According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 57% of Pakistanis have received at least one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine. However, according the official NCOC website, around 64 to 65 million individuals are reported to having gotten at least one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine so far.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, “Have you gotten vaccinated for COVID-19 (even if it’s just one dose)?” In response to this question, 57% said yes while 43% said no.

Question: “Have you gotten vaccinated for COVID-19 (even if it’s just one dose)?”

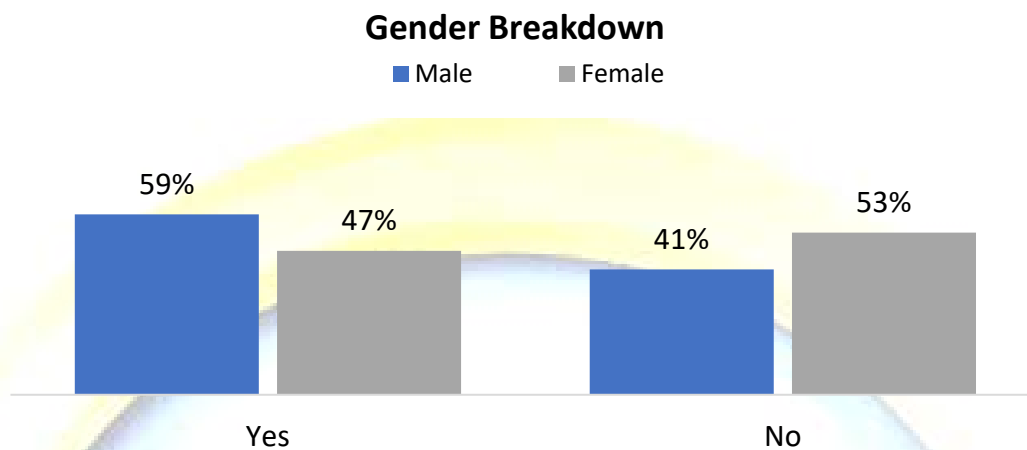

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1727 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during August 13, 2021 – September 5, 2021. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was CATI.
