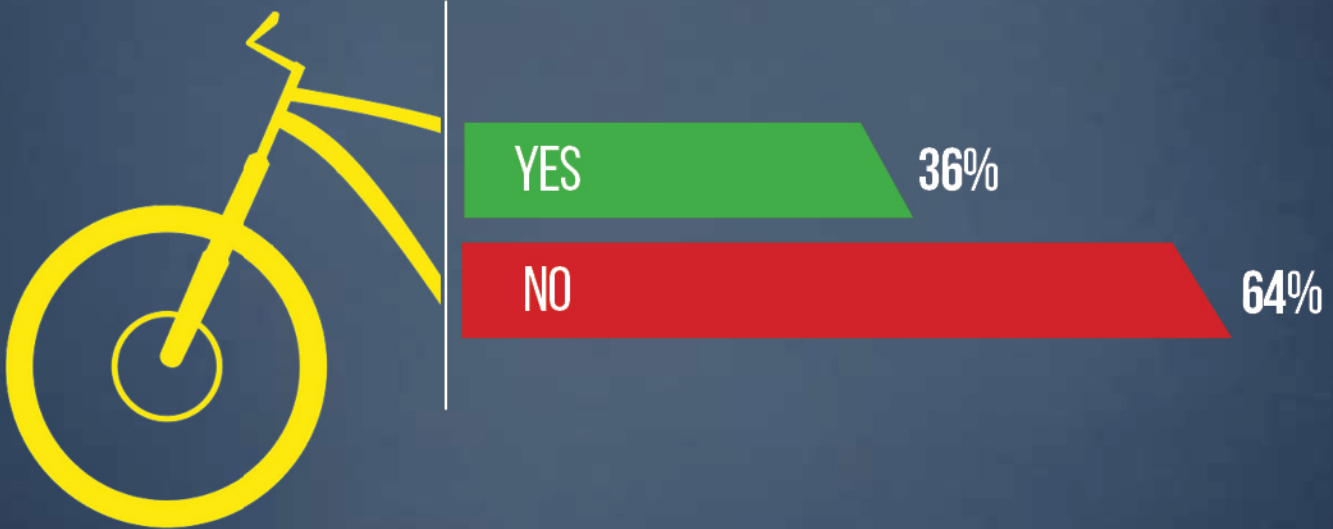

36 % of Pakistanis have a children's bicycle in their home: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

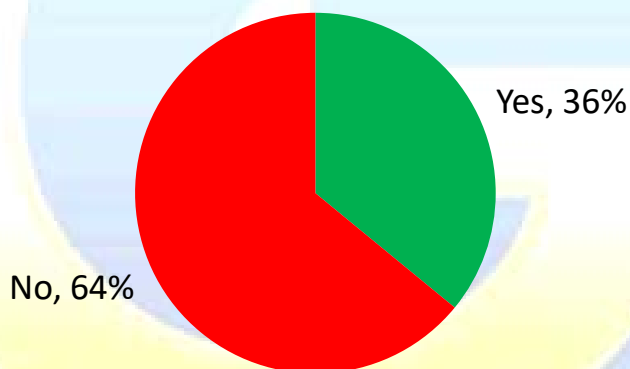

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 36% of Pakistanis have a children's bicycle in their home.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, "Would you please tell me if there is a children's bicycle in your home?" In response to this question, 36% said yes while 64% said no.

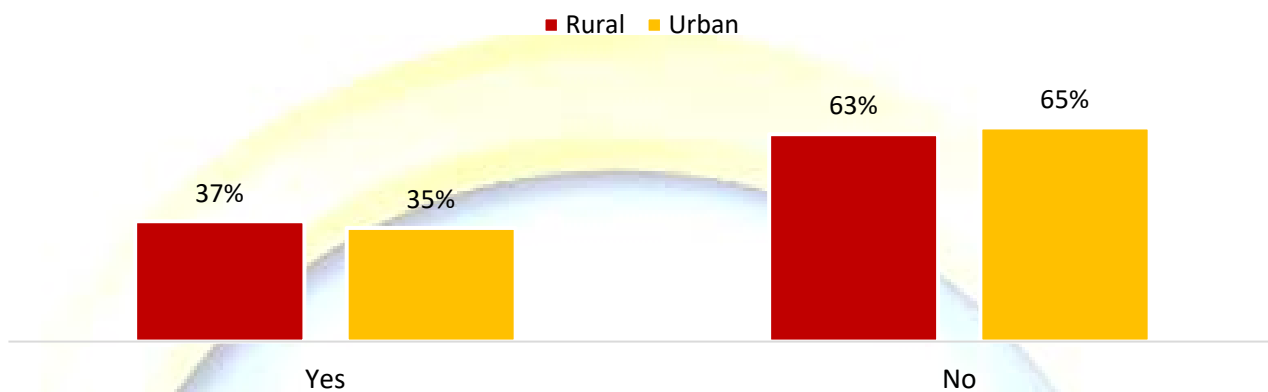

Urban-rural Breakdown

37% of people belonging to rural households and 35% of people belonging to urban households stated that they had a children's bicycle in their home.

Urban-rural Breakdown



The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1418 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during August 13, 2021 – September 05, 2021. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was CATI.
