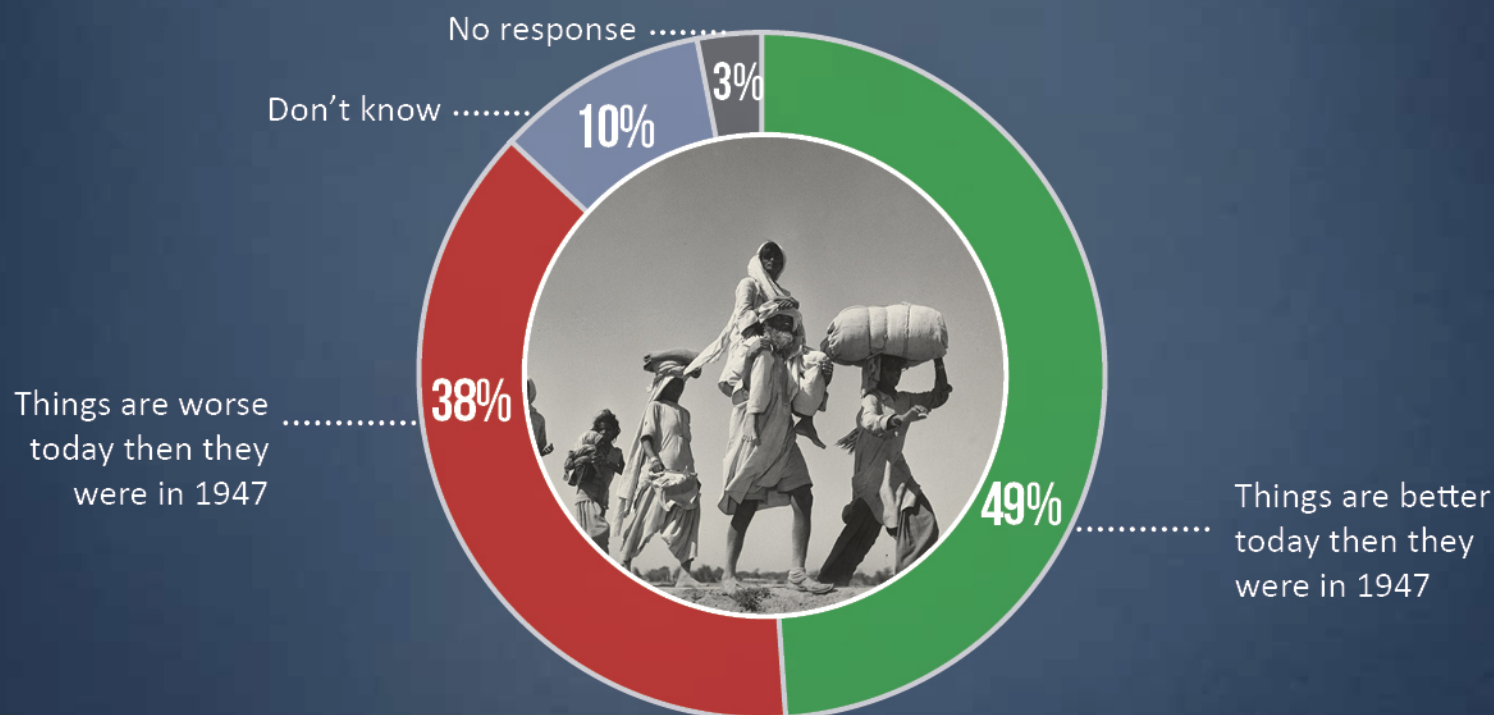

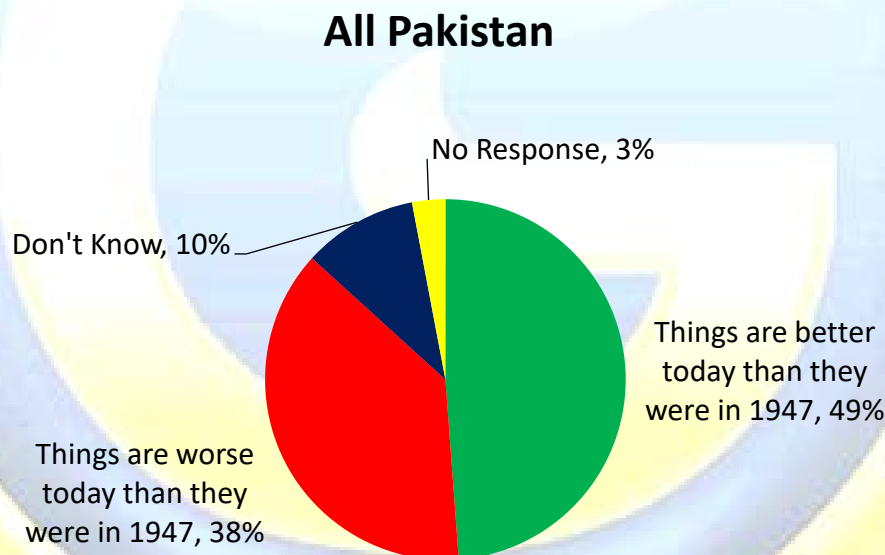
Nearly half of Pakistanis (49 %) believe that the situation in the country is better today than it was in 1947: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad), October 6, 2021

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 49% of Pakistanis believe that the situation in the country is better today than it was in 1947.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, “Some people think that Pakistan has made a lot of progress since 1947, while others think that the situation in Pakistan today is worse than 1947. What is your opinion?” In response to this question, 49% said that things are better today than they were in 1947, 38% said that things are worse today than they were in 1947 while 10% did not know and 3% did not respond.

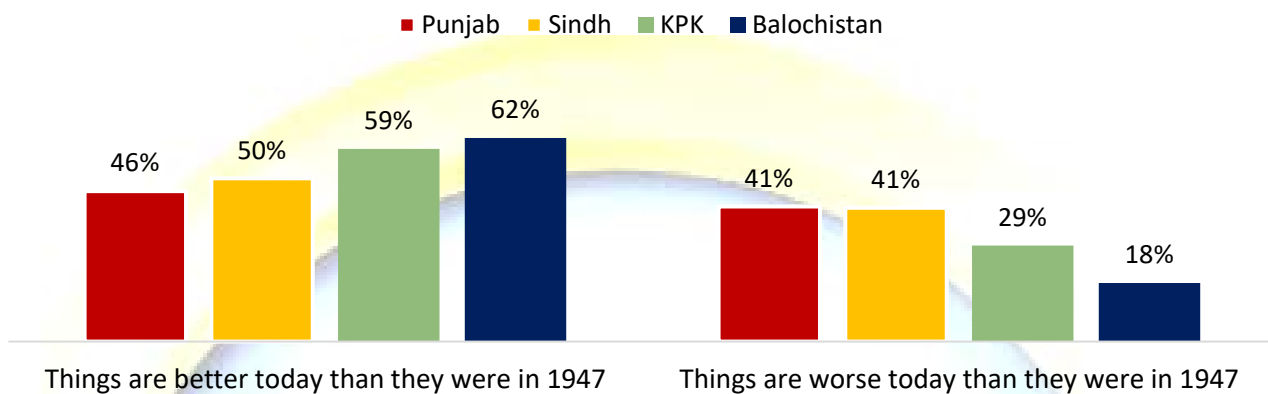

Provincial Breakdown

Relatively more people from Balochistan (62%) believe that things are better today than they were in 1947 as compared to the rest of the provinces.

Provincial Breakdown



The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1418 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during August 13, 2021 – September 05, 2021. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was CATI.
