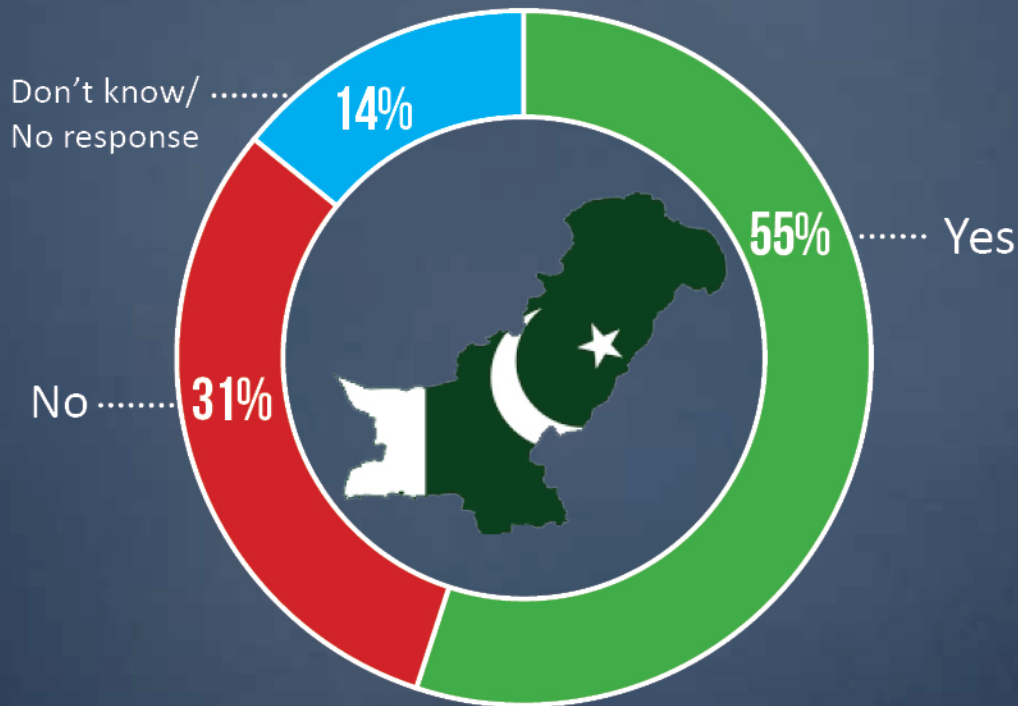

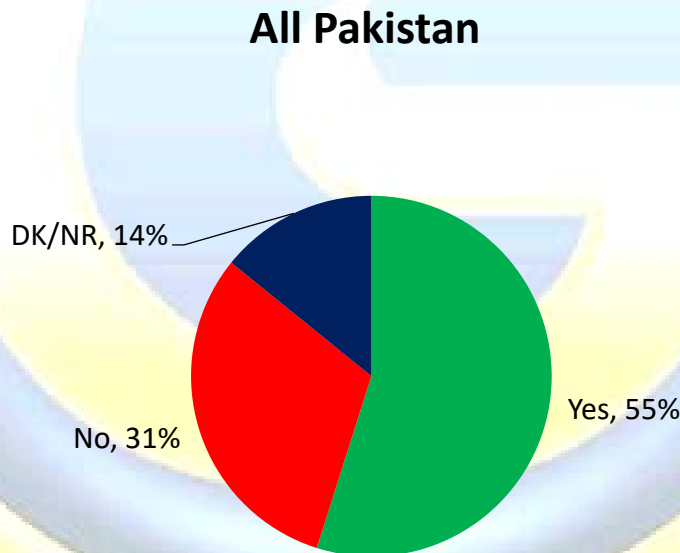

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, nearly 1 in 3 Pakistanis (31%) state that they do not want the type of Islamic government in Pakistan that the Taliban have brought in Afghanistan.

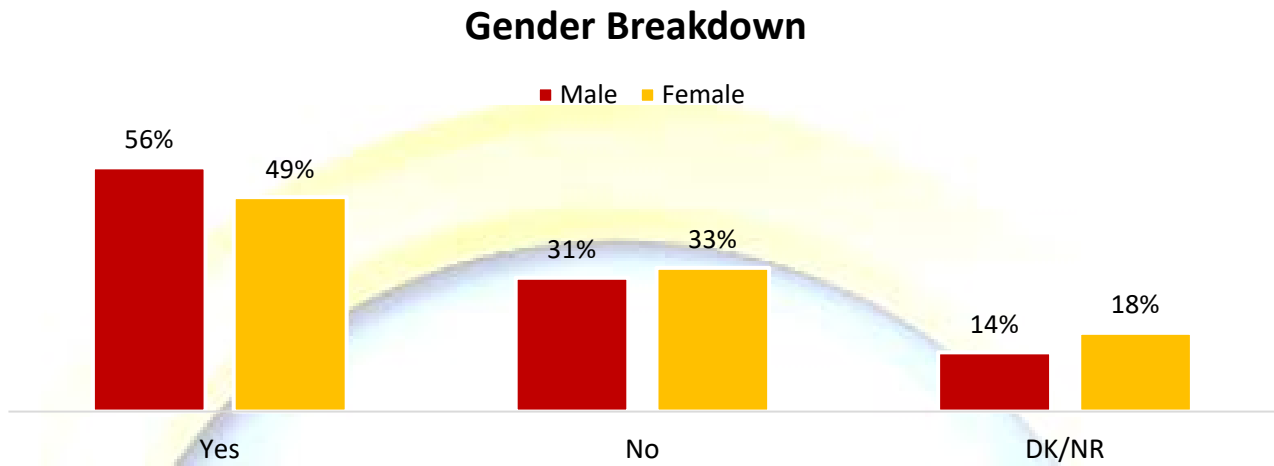
A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, “Do you want the kind of Islamic government that the Taliban have brought to Afghanistan in Pakistan as well?” In response to this question, 55% said yes, 31% said no while 14% did not know or did not respond.

Question: “Do you want the kind of Islamic government that the Taliban have brought to Afghanistan in Pakistan as well?”



Gender Breakdown

33% females and 31% males are against a Taliban-style Islamic government, similar to the one in Afghanistan to be brought about in Pakistan.



The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 2170 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during August 13, 2021 – September 05, 2021. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was CATI.
