MORE THAN 8 IN 10 (85%) PAKISTANIS HAVE NOT SEEN OR HEARD OF A HEALTH DEPARTMENT OFFICIAL USING CONTACT TRACING METHOD TO GATHER INFORMATION TO PREVENT THE SPREAD OF COVID-19; MAJOR URBAN-RURAL DISPARITY ALSO EXISTS: GALLUP & GILANI PAKISTAN

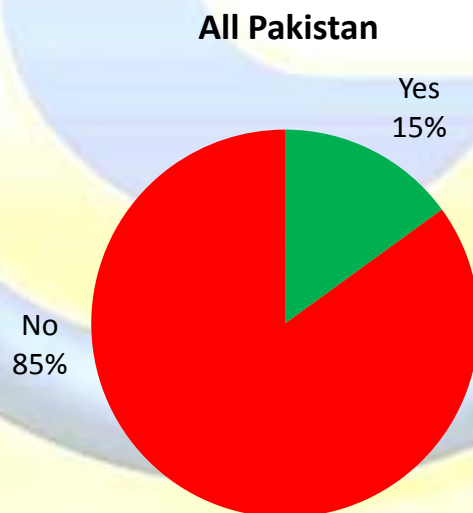
More than 8 in 10 (85%) Pakistanis have not seen or heard of a health department official using Contact Tracing method to gather information to prevent the spread of COVID-19; major urban-rural disparity also exists: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad), November 4, 2021

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, more than 8 in 10 (85%) Pakistanis have not seen or heard of a health department official using Contact Tracing method to gather information to prevent the spread of COVID-19; major urban-rural disparity also exists.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, “Please state whether you have seen or heard of a public health officer/health department official using a method called Contact Tracing to gather information to prevent the spread of diseases such as COVID-19?” In response to this question, 15% said yes while 85% said no.

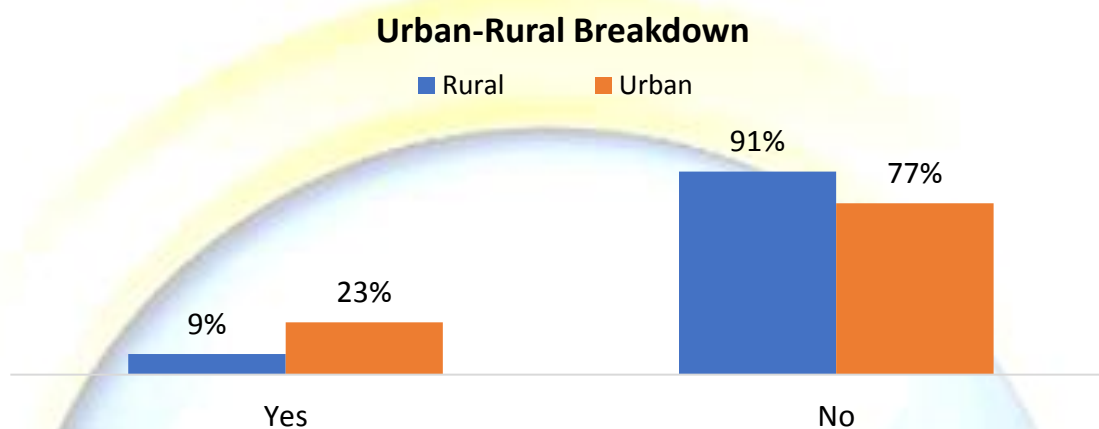

Urban-Rural Breakdown

Those living in rural areas (91%) are more unlikely to have seen or heard of a public health officer/health department official using a method called Contact Tracing to gather information to prevent the spread of diseases such as COVID-19 as compared to those living in urban areas (77%) indicating a major urban-rural disparity.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1727 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during August 13, 2021 – September 5, 2021. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was CATI.
