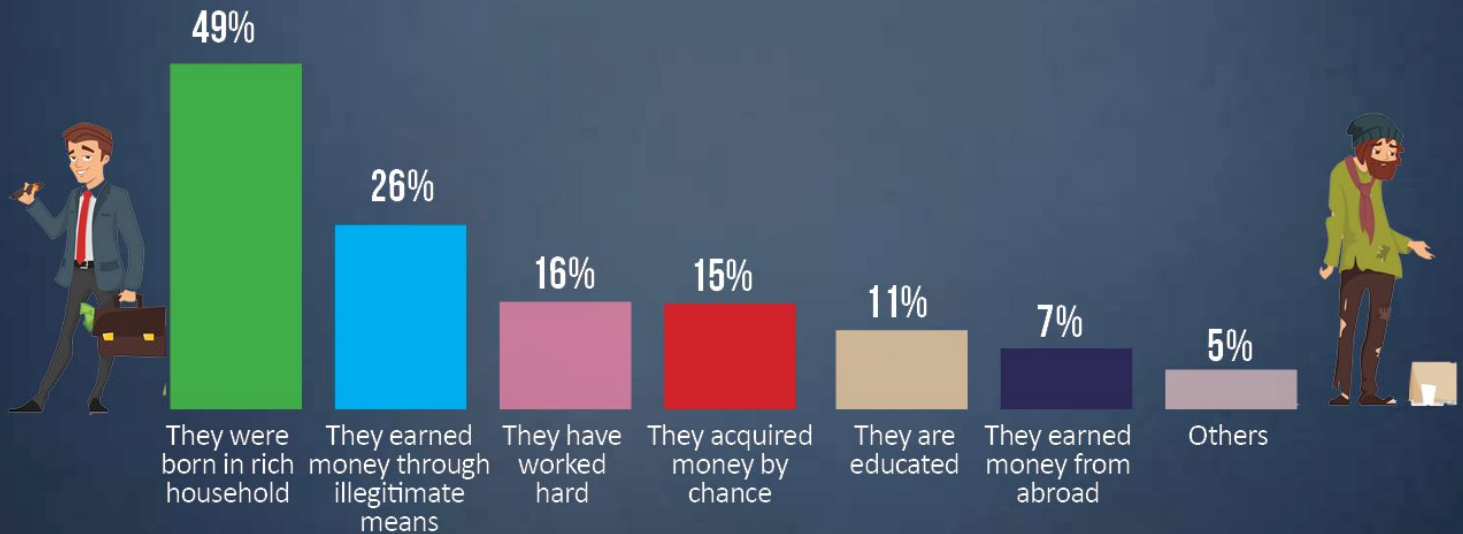

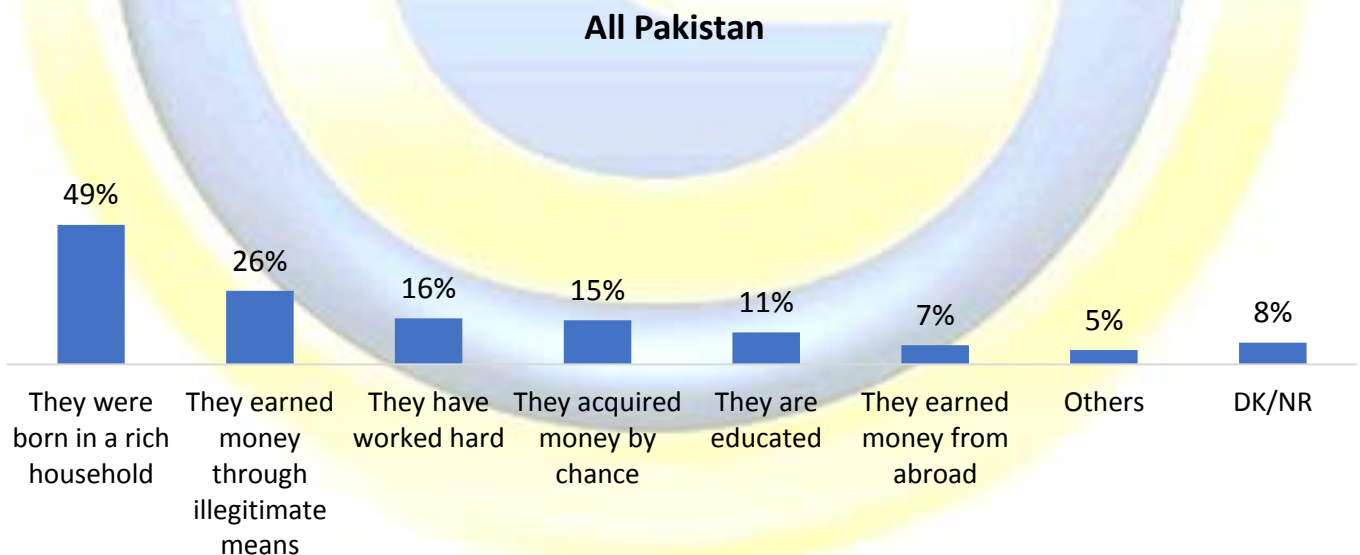

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, nearly half (49%) of Pakistanis believe that the usual reason for people being rich in the country is that they were born in a rich household; this response was more common among males (50%) as compared to females (41%).

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, “Like every country, there are some rich people and some poor people in our country as well. What is the usual reason for people being rich in your opinion?” In response to this question, 49% said they were born in a rich household, 26% said they earned money through illegitimate means, 16% said they have worked hard, 15% said they acquired money by chance, 11% said they are educated, 7% said they earned money from abroad while 5% said others. 8% did not know or provided no response.

Question: “Like every country, there are some rich people and some poor people in our country as well. What is the usual reason for people being rich in your opinion?”

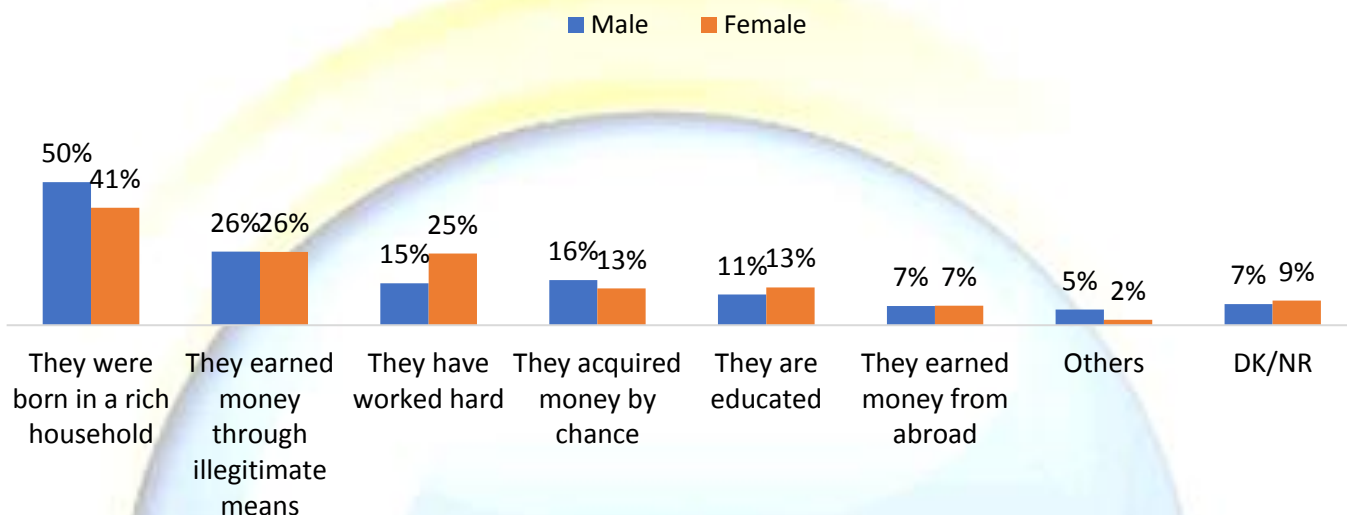

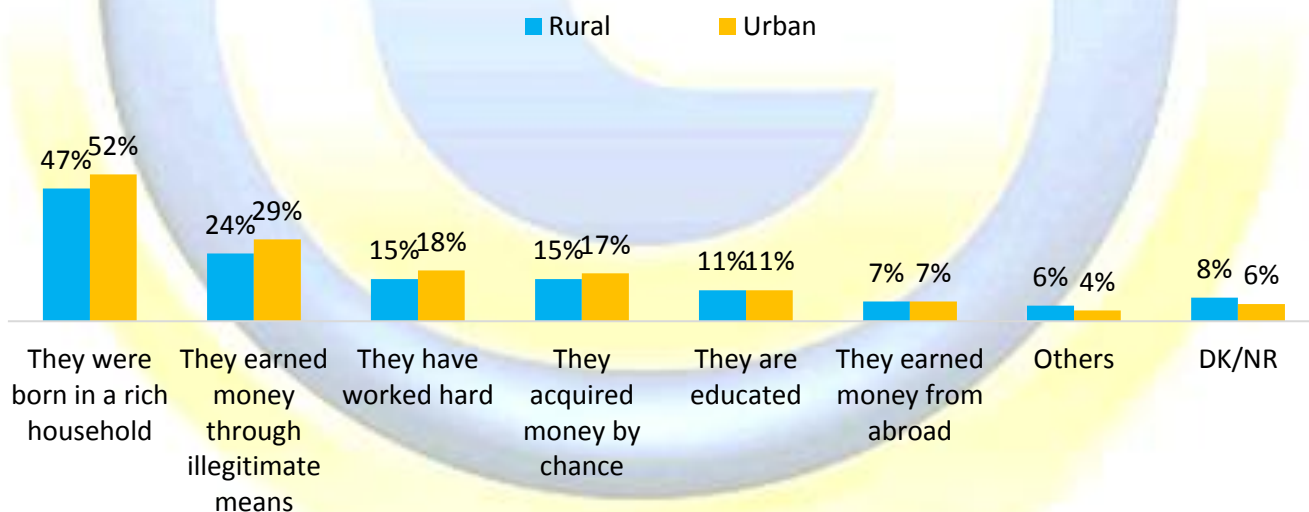
Breakdown

As compared to females (41%), more males (50%) hold the opinion that the usual reason for people being rich in the country is that they were born in a rich household. Location-wise, slightly more urban respondents (52%) hold a similar opinion as compared to rural respondents (47%).

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1730 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during September 23, 2021 – October 8, 2021. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was CATI.
