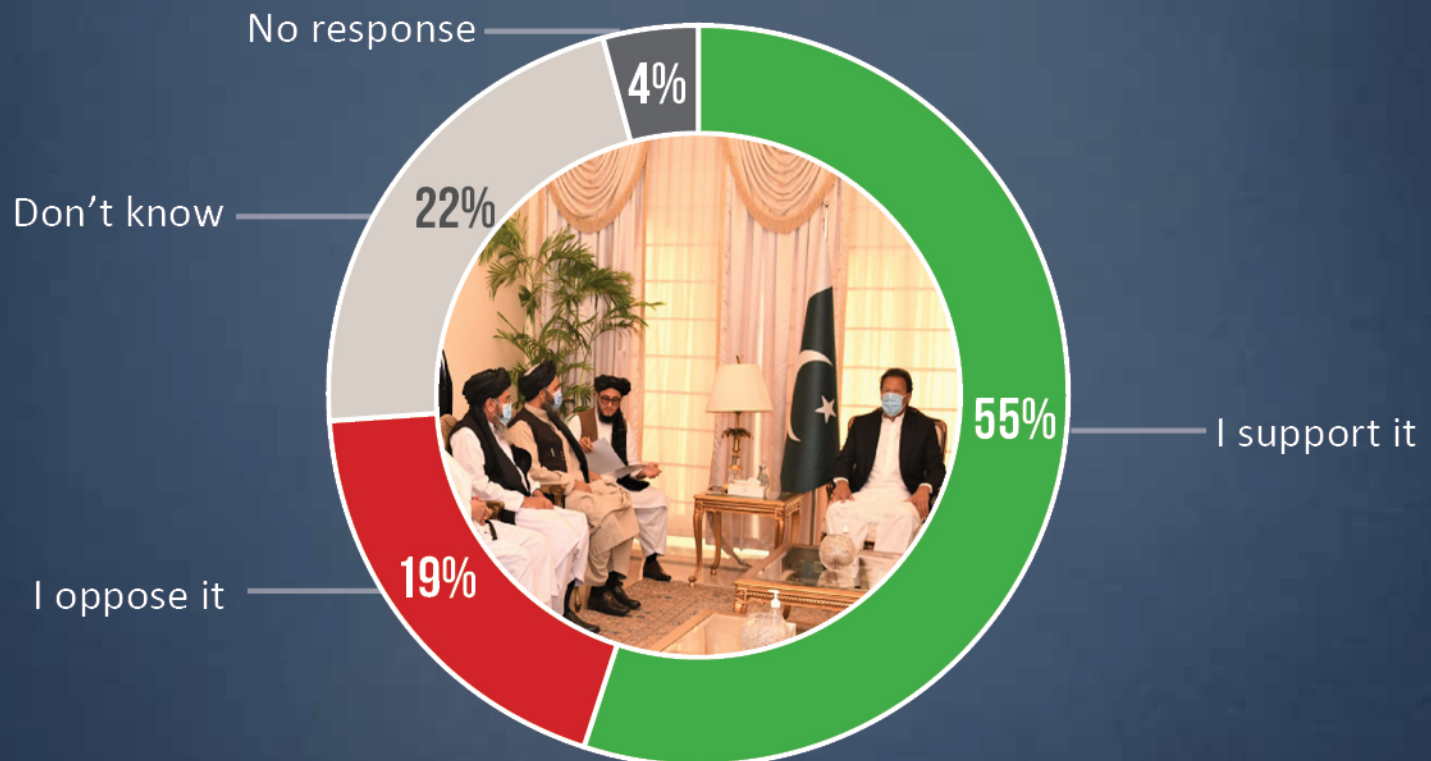

Over half (55%) of Pakistanis support Imran Khan government's policy on the Afghan conflict: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

(Islamabad), December 24, 2021

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, over half (55%) of Pakistanis support Imran Khan government's policy on the Afghan conflict.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, *"Some people agree with Imran Khan Government's policy on the Afghan conflict, whereas other people oppose it. What is your collective opinion on this?"* In response to this question, 55% said they support it, 19% said they oppose it, and 22% did not know. 4% provided no response.

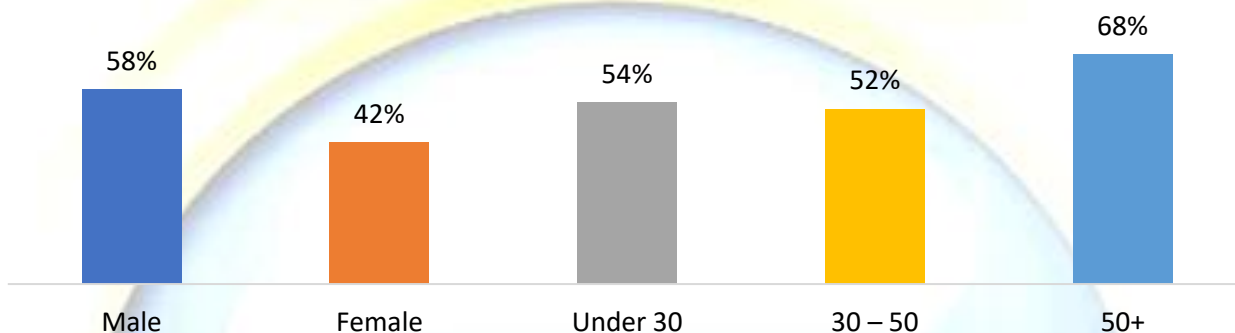

Breakdown

More males (58%) as compared to females (42%) support Imran Khan government's policy on the Afghan conflict. Age-wise, those over the age of 50 (68%) are more likely to support it as compared to those aged under 30 (54%) and between 30 – 50 years old (52%).

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1730 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during September 23, 2021 – October 8, 2021. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was CATI.
