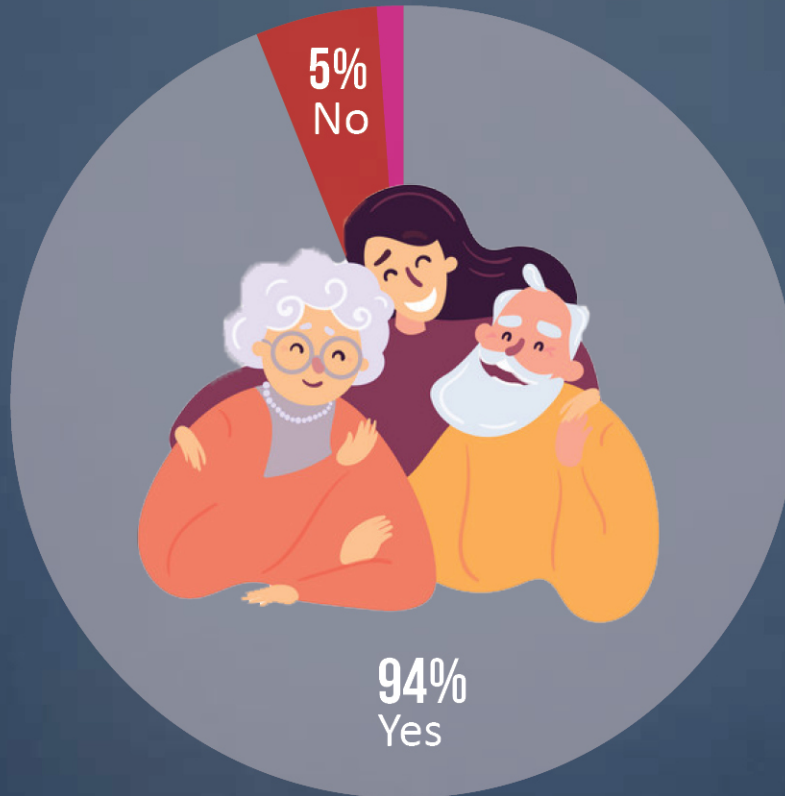

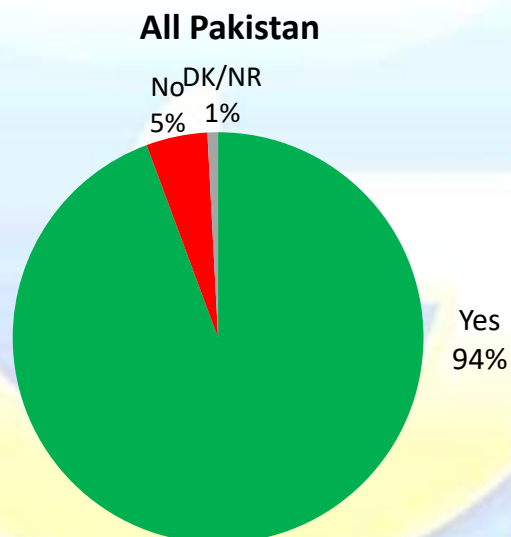
9 in 10 (94%) Pakistanis agree that daughters take more care of their parents than sons: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 9 in 10 (94%) Pakistanis agree that daughters take more care of their parents than sons.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, “Do you think daughters take more care of their parents than sons?” In response to this question, 94% said yes and 5% said no. 1% did not know or provided no response.

Question: “Do you think daughters take more care of their parents than sons?”

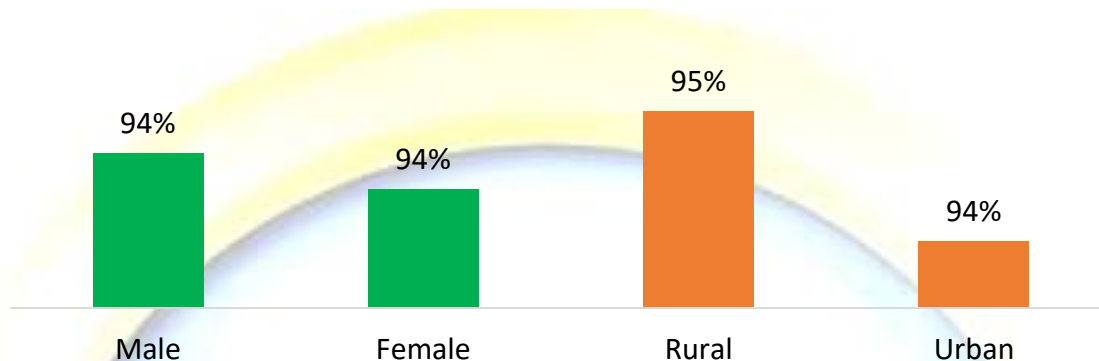

Breakdown

Males (94%) and females (94%) equally feel that daughters take more care of their parents than sons. This response was also equally common across rural (95%) and urban (94%) areas.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 552 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during October 25, 2021 – October 28, 2021. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was CATI.
