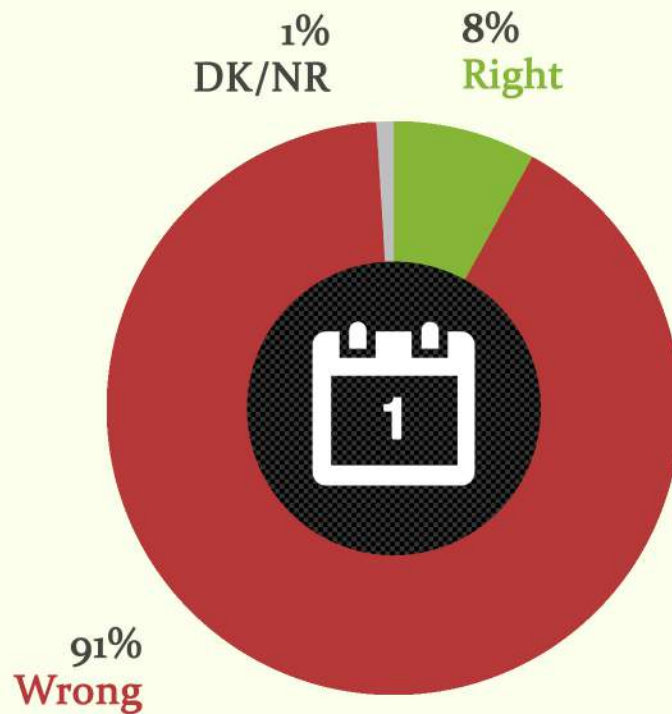


Do you think fooling somebody on April Fools' Day is right or wrong?

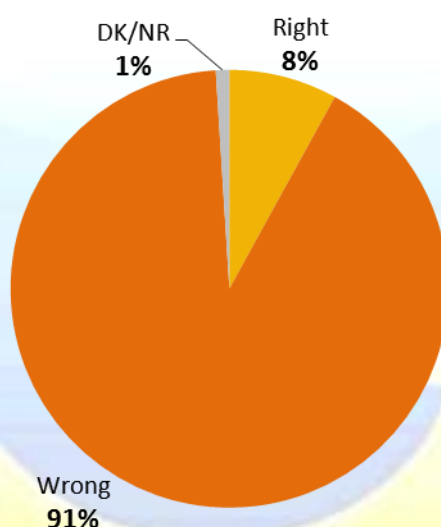
Overwhelming majority of Pakistanis believe that fooling somebody on April Fools' Day is wrong. GILANI RESEARCH FOUNDATION (GRF POLL)

Islamabad, June 2, 2015

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, 91% Pakistanis said that fooling somebody on April Fools' Day is wrong; 8% disagree.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women, from across the four provinces was asked, "Do you think fooling somebody on April Fools' Day is right or wrong?" In response to this question, 8% respondents said that fooling somebody on April Fools' Day is right, while 91% respondents said that fooling somebody on April Fools' Day is wrong, and 1% did not respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1639 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during March 23- March 30, 2015. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.

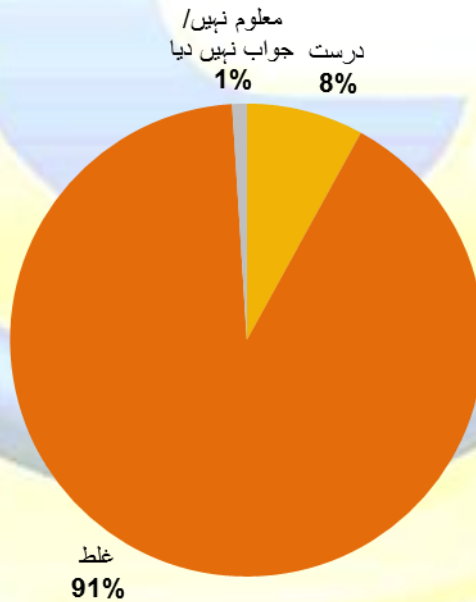

گیلانی ریسرچ فاؤنڈیشن کے حالیہ سروے کے مطابق، 91% پاکستانیوں کا کہنا ہے کہ "اپریل فول ڈے" پر کسی کو بھی فول بنانا غلط فعل ہے۔ 8% افراد اس سے غیر متفق ہیں۔

سروے میں ملک بھر سے شماریاتی طور پر منتخب خواتین و حضرات سے یہ سوال پوچھا گیا کہ "آپ کے خیال میں کسی کو اپریل فول بنانا درست فعل ہے یا غلط فعل ہے؟"۔ اس سوال کے جواب میں 8% جوابدہندگان کا کہنا ہے کہ "اپریل فول ڈے" پر کسی کو فول بنانا درست فعل ہے، جبکہ 91% جوابدہندگان کے مطابق کسی کو بھی اپریل فول ڈے پر فول بنانا ایک غلط فعل ہے، تاہم 1% افراد نے کسی رائے کا اظہار نہیں کیا۔

گیلانی ریسرچ فاؤنڈیشن کا حالیہ سروے گلیپ انٹرنیشنل سے منسلک گلیپ پاکستان کی مدد سے کیا گیا۔ یہ سروے پاکستان کے چاروں صوبوں کی دیہی اور شہری آبادی کے 1639 مرد و خواتین سے 23 مارچ تا 30 مارچ 2015 میں منعقد ہوا۔ غلطی کے امکان کا تخمینہ شماریاتی طور پر تقریباً $\pm 2-3\%$ لگایا گیا ہے۔
