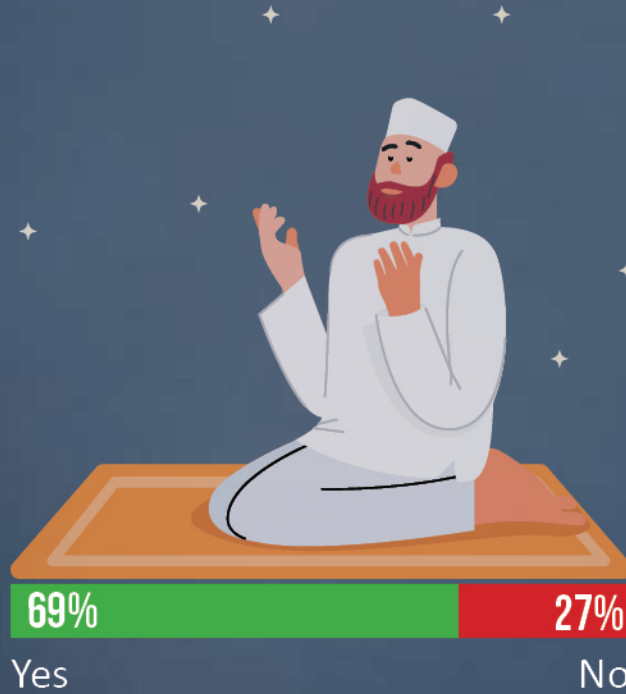

Nearly 7 in 10 (69%) Pakistanis hold the opinion that the number of people who pray has increased in the last year: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, nearly 7 in 10 (69%) Pakistanis hold the opinion that the number of people who pray has increased in the last year.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, “Do you think the number of people who pray has increased in the last year?” In response to this question, 69% said yes, 27% said no while 4% said don’t know.

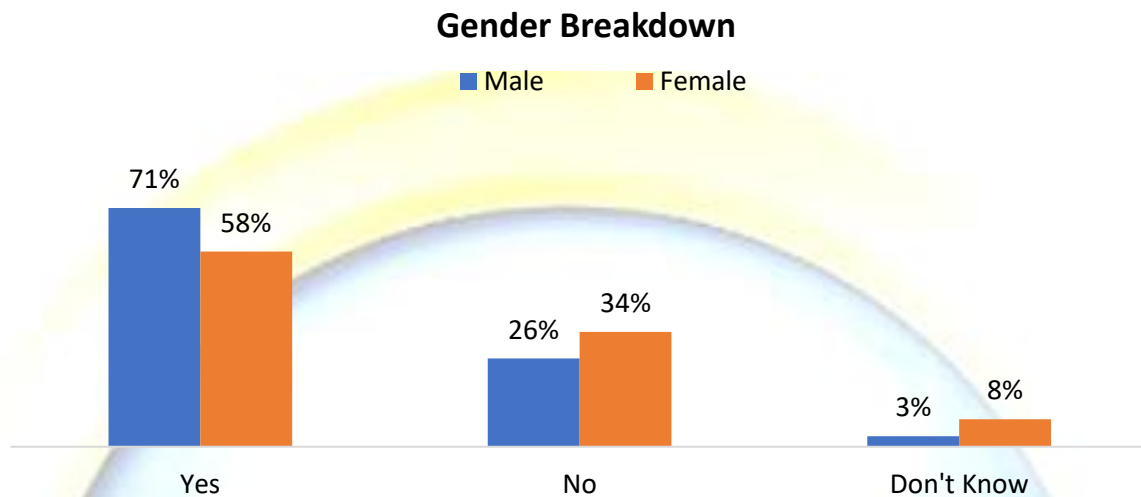
Question: “Do you think the number of people who pray has increased in the last year?”

Gender Breakdown

Considerably more males (71%) as compared to females (58%) feel that the number of people who pray has increased in the last year.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1730 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during September 23, 2021 – October 08, 2021. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2\text{-}3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was CATI.
