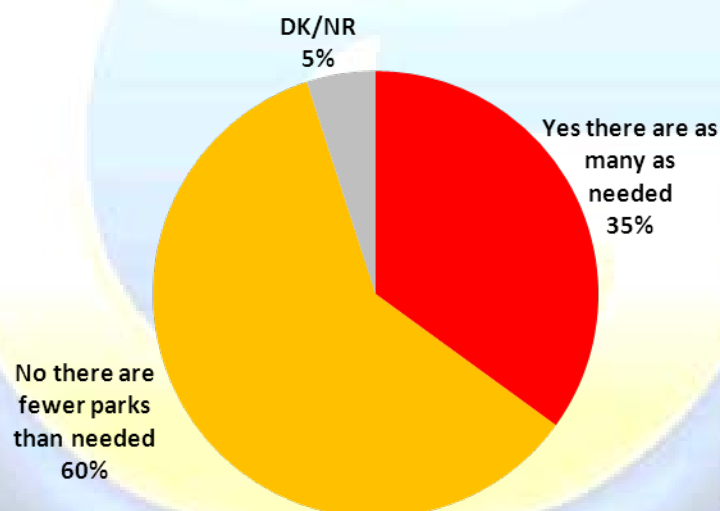
Majority Pakistanis (60%) believe that there are fewer parks in their city than needed. (GRF POLL)

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, 60% Pakistanis believe that there are not enough parks in their city.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women, from across the four provinces was asked, “In your opinion are there enough parks in your city as needed?” In response, 60% of the respondents said that there fewer parks in their city than needed while 35% said that there are enough parks according to need. 5% did not respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1899 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during June 22 – June 29, 2015. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.

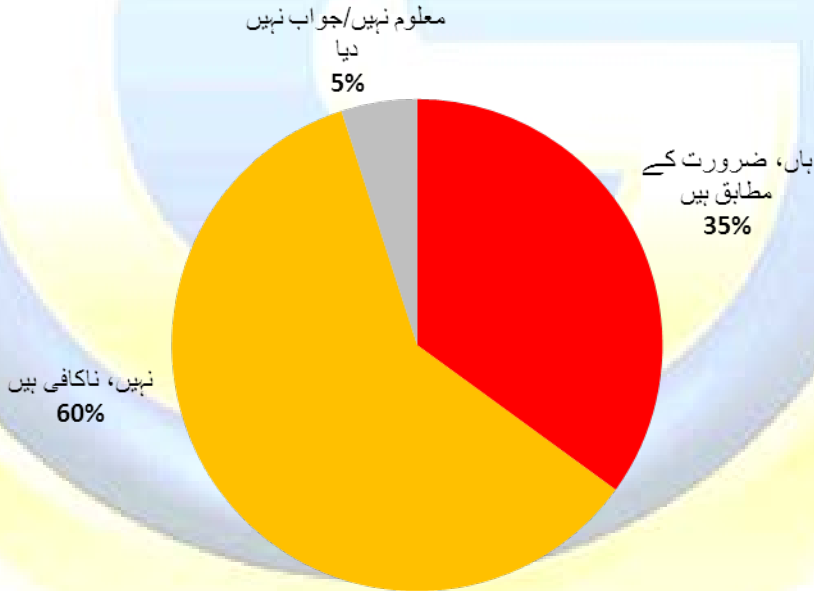
پاکستانیوں کی اکثریت (60%) کے مطابق اُن کے شہر میں تفریحی پارک ضرورت سے کم ہیں:

گیلانی ریسرچ فاؤنڈیشن کے ایک حالیہ سروے کے مطابق، 60% پاکستانیوں کے مطابق اُن کے شہر میں تفریحی پارک ضرورت سے کم ہیں۔ سروے میں ملک بھر سے شاریاتی طور پر منتخب مرد و خواتین سے یہ سوال پوچھا گیا کہ، "آپ کے خیال میں آپ کے شہر میں تفریحی پارک ضرورت کے مطابق ہیں یا نہیں؟"، اس سوال کے جواب میں 60% جوابدہندگان کا کہنا ہے کہ اُن کے شہر میں تفریحی پارک ناکافی ہیں، جبکہ 35% افراد کے مطابق اُن کے شہر میں تفریحی پارک ضرورت کے مطابق ہیں، تاہم 5% نے کسی رائے کا اظہار نہیں کیا۔
