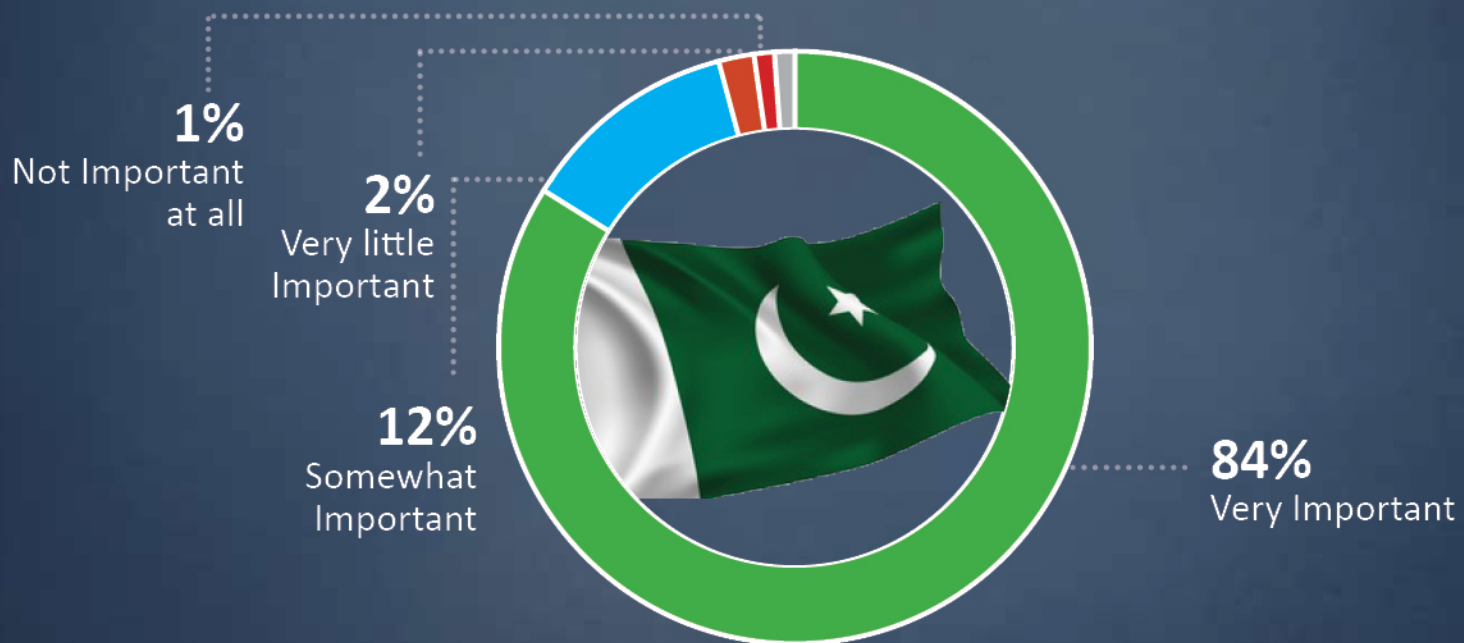

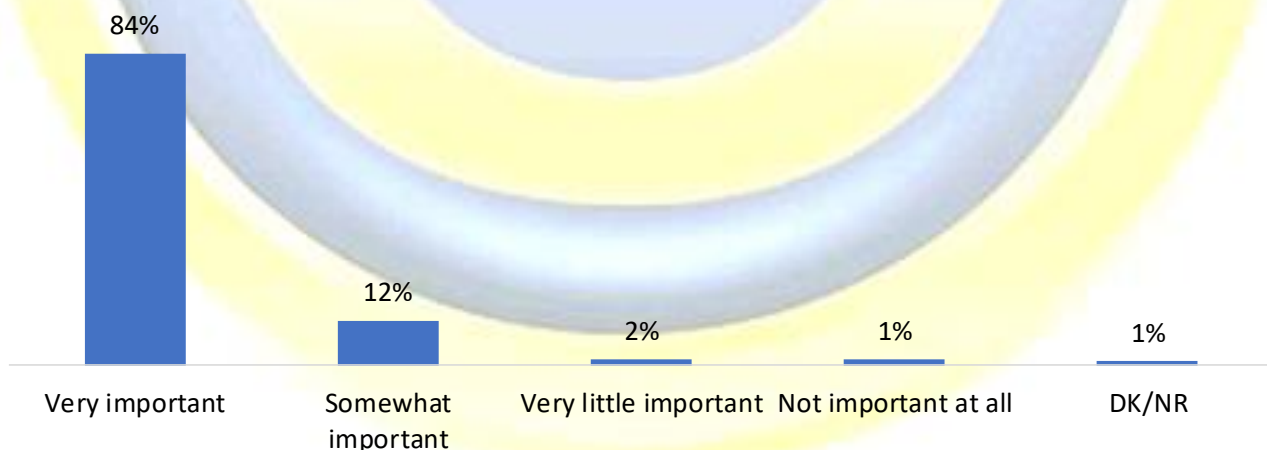

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 84% of Pakistanis feel that in order to be a true Pakistani, it is very important to respect the country's institutions and laws.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, *"Some people think it is important to have following points to be a true Pakistani whereas other people think these are not as important. To what extent do you agree? (Respecting the country's institutions and laws)."* In response to this question, 84% said very important, 12% said somewhat important, 2% said very little important, and 1% said not important at all. 1% did not know or provided no response.

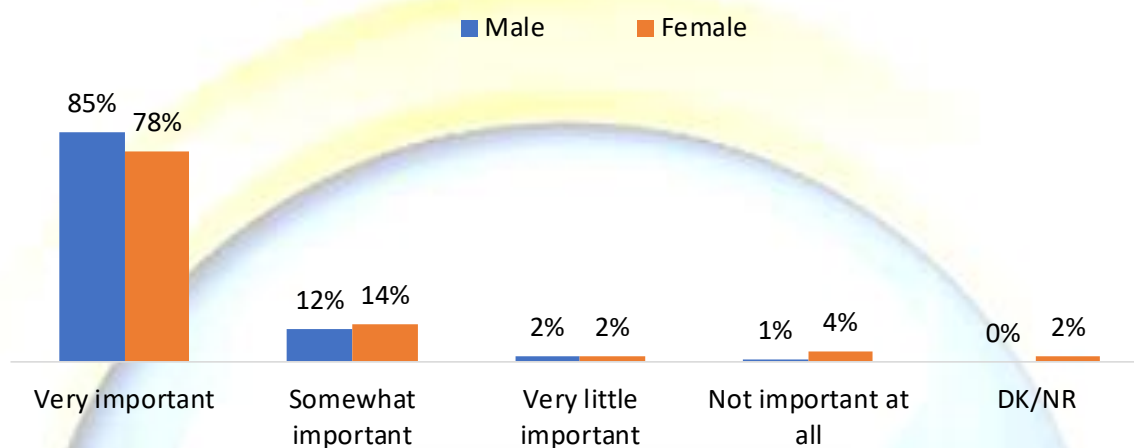

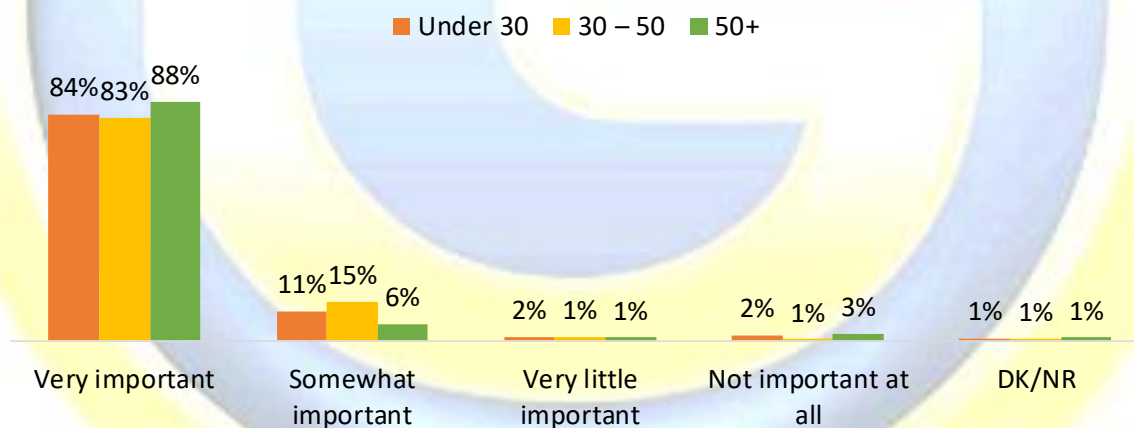
Breakdown

More males (85%) feel that in order to be a true Pakistani, it is very important to respect the country's institutions and laws as compared to females (78%). Those aged 50+ years (88%) are slightly more likely to say the same as compared to those under 30 years (84%) of age and between 30 – 50 years (83%).

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1730 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during September 23, 2021 – October 8, 2021. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was CATI.
