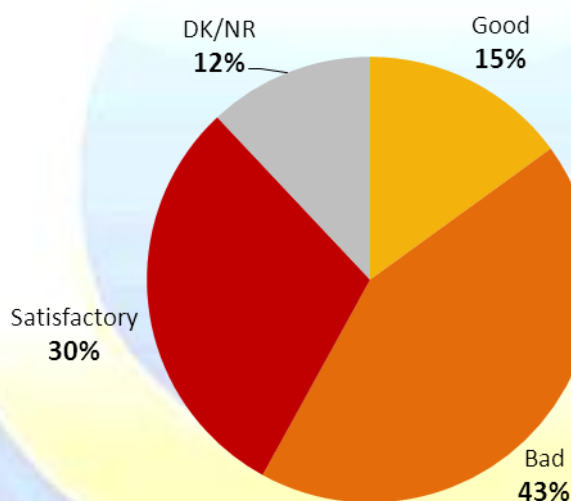
43% Pakistanis have a negative opinion about the budget presented for 2015-2016. GILANI RESEARCH FOUNDATION (GRF POLL)

Islamabad, July 22, 2015

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, 43% Pakistanis said that the budget presented for 2015-2016 is bad overall; 15% said it is good.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women, from across the four provinces was asked, "A few days ago, budget for 2015-2016 was presented. In your opinion, was this a good, bad or a satisfactory budget overall?" In response to this question, 15% respondents said that the budget presented for 2015-2016 is good, 43% respondents said the budget is bad, while 30% respondents believe the budget is satisfactory, and 12% did not respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1854 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during June 15 - June 22, 2015. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.

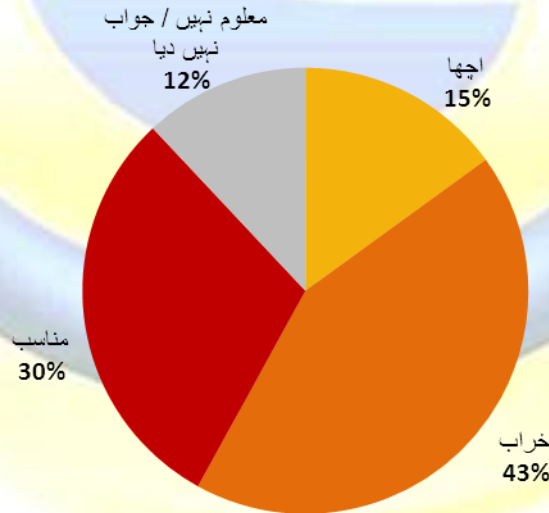

گیلانی ریسرچ فاؤنڈیشن کے ایک حالیہ سروے کے مطابق، 43% پاکستانیوں کا کہنا ہے کہ 2015-2016 کے لیے پیش کیا جانے والا بجٹ خراب ہے، جبکہ 15% افراد کے مطابق یہ بجٹ اچھا ہے۔

سروے میں ملک بھر سے شاریاتی طور پر منتخب مرد و خواتین سے یہ سوال پوچھا گیا کہ، "گذشتہ دنوں (2015-2016) کا بجٹ پیش کیا گیا۔ آپ کے خیال میں مجموعی طور پر یہ بجٹ اچھا ہے، خراب ہے یا مناسب؟"، اس سوال کے جواب میں 15% جوابدہندگان کا کہنا ہے کہ گذشتہ دنوں 2015-2016 کے لیے پیش کیا جانے والا بجٹ اچھا ہے، 43% افراد کے مطابق خراب، جبکہ 30% جوابدہندگان کا کہنا ہے کہ 2015-2016 کے لیے پیش کیا جانے والا بجٹ مناسب ہے، تاہم 12% جوابدہندگان نے کسی رائے کا اظہار نہیں کیا۔
