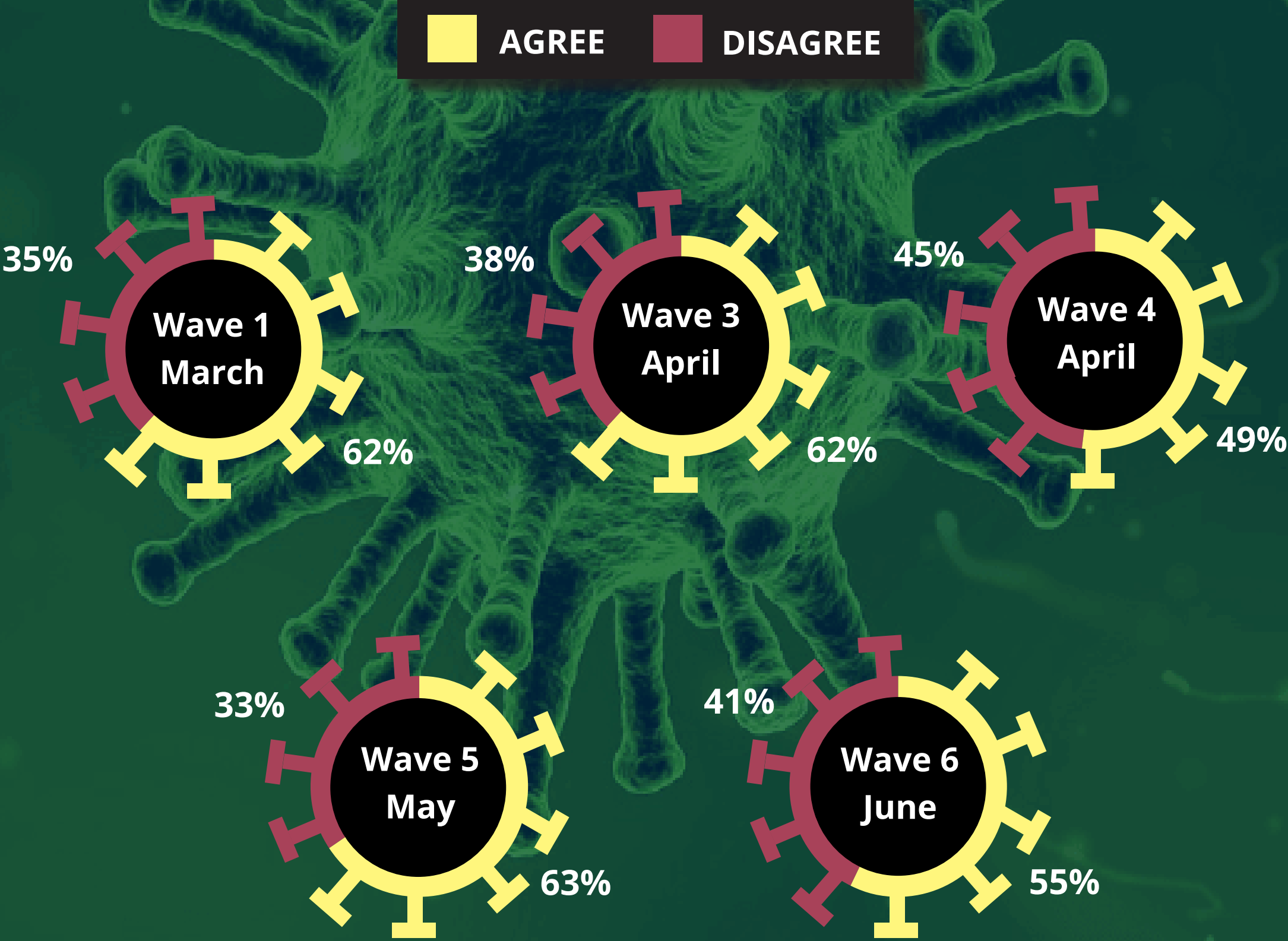


DECLINING BY 8% SINCE WAVE 5 IN MAY, 55% PAKISTANIS STILL CONSIDER THE THREAT FROM CORONAVIRUS TO BE EXAGGERATED (GALLUP & GILANI PAKISTAN)

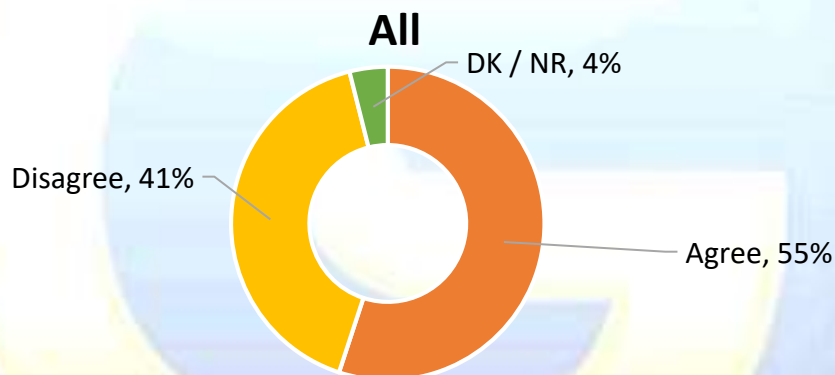
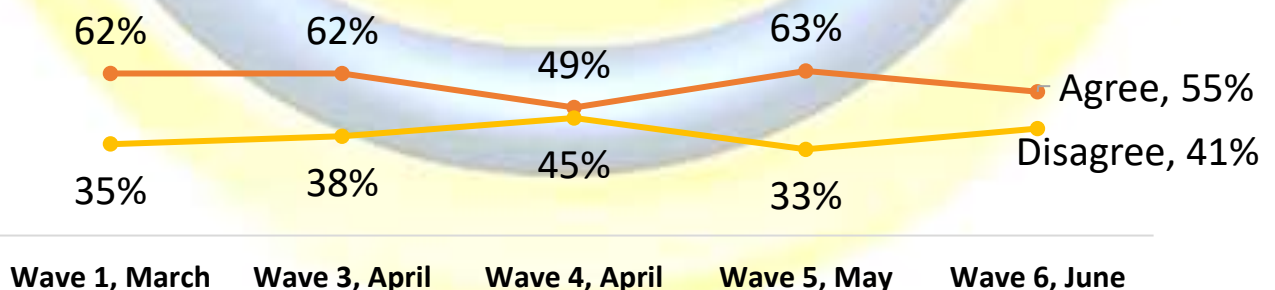
**CORONAVIRUS****Declining by 8% since Wave 5 in May, 55% Pakistanis still consider the threat from coronavirus to be exaggerated (Gallup & Gilani Pakistan Weekly Coronavirus Perception Tracker)**

Islamabad, June 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2020

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 55% Pakistanis still consider the threat from coronavirus to be exaggerated.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, *“To what extent do you agree/disagree that the threat of Coronavirus is being exaggerated?”* In response to this question, 55% Pakistanis say they agree that the threat is exaggerated, 41% believe the threat is not exaggerated and 4% say they do not know/did not respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out through telephonic interviews among a sample of 1,050 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during June 04 – June 13, 2020 as a part of Gallup Pakistan Coronavirus Attitude Tracker Survey 2020, Wave 6. The error margin is estimated to be approximately  $\pm 3$  percent at the 95% confidence level.
