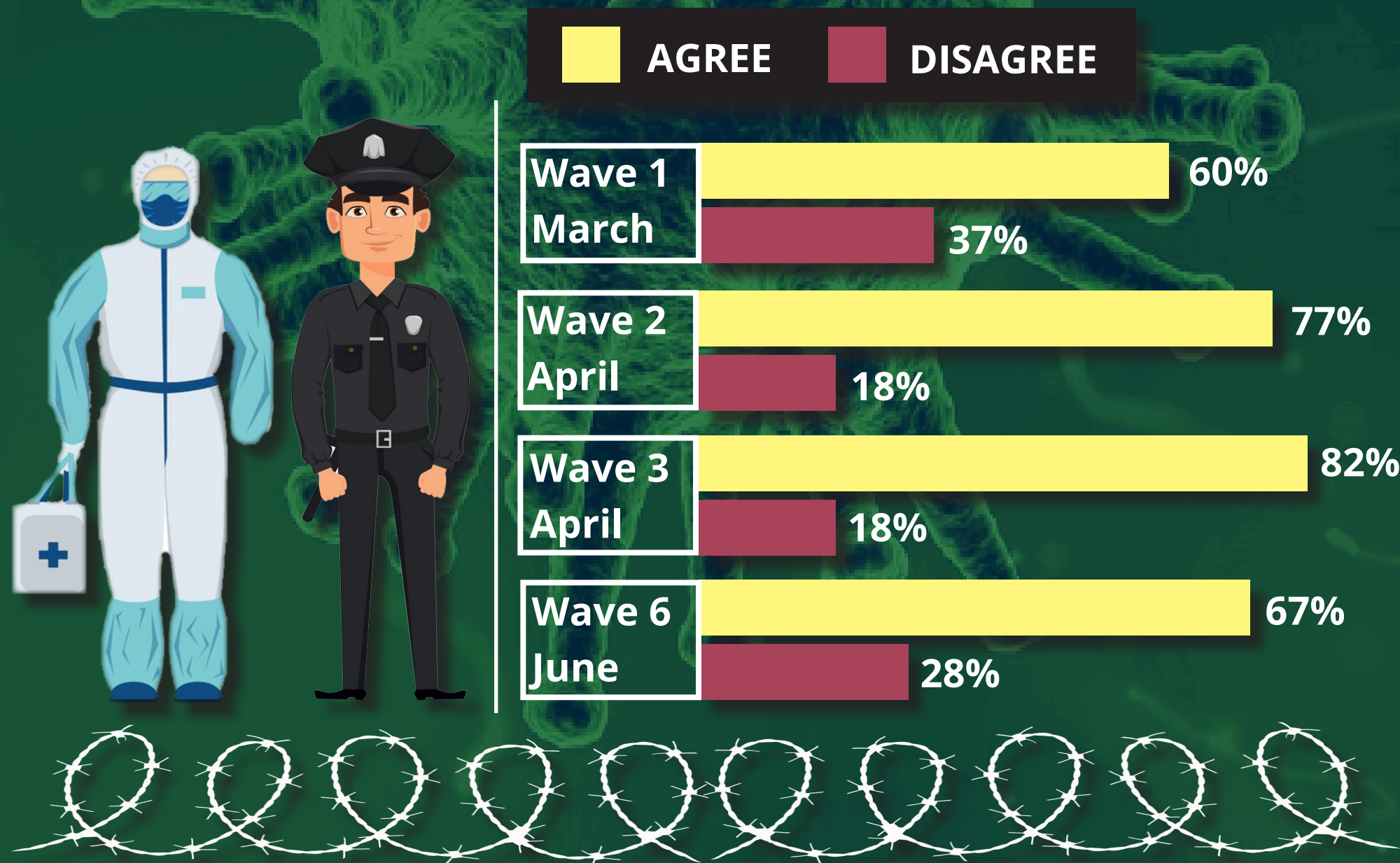

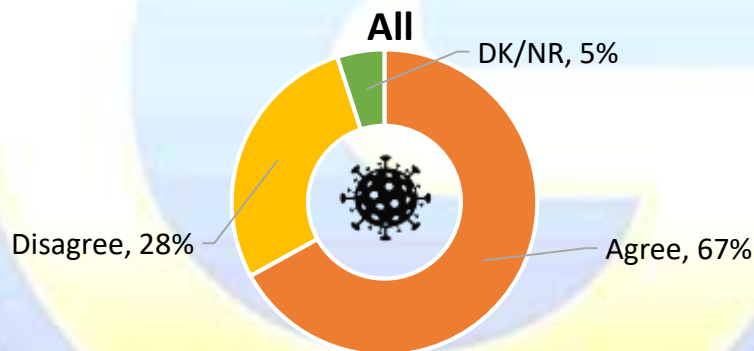

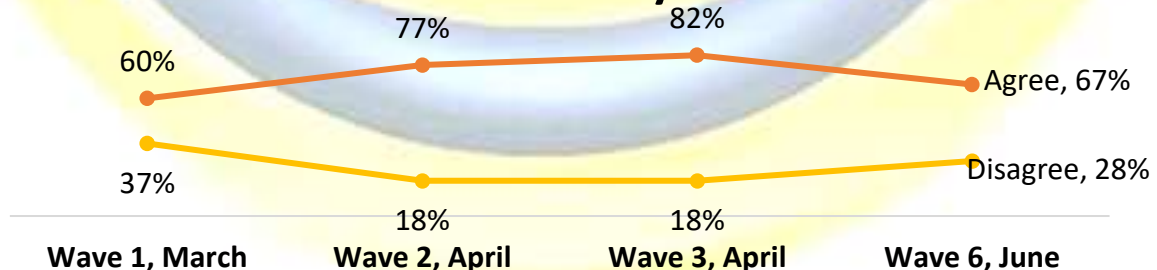
According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, since April, there has been a significant 15% decline in the proportion of Pakistanis who opine that the federal government of Pakistan is controlling the coronavirus situation very well. 67% continue to agree while 28% disagree

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, *“To what extent do you agree/disagree that the Federal Government of Pakistan is controlling the Coronavirus situation very well?”* In response to this question, 67% Pakistanis agree and 28% disagree.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out through telephonic interviews among a sample of 1,050 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during June 04 – June 13, 2020 as a part of Gallup Pakistan Coronavirus Attitude Tracker Survey 2020, Wave 6. The error margin is estimated to be approximately ± 3 percent at the 95% confidence level.
