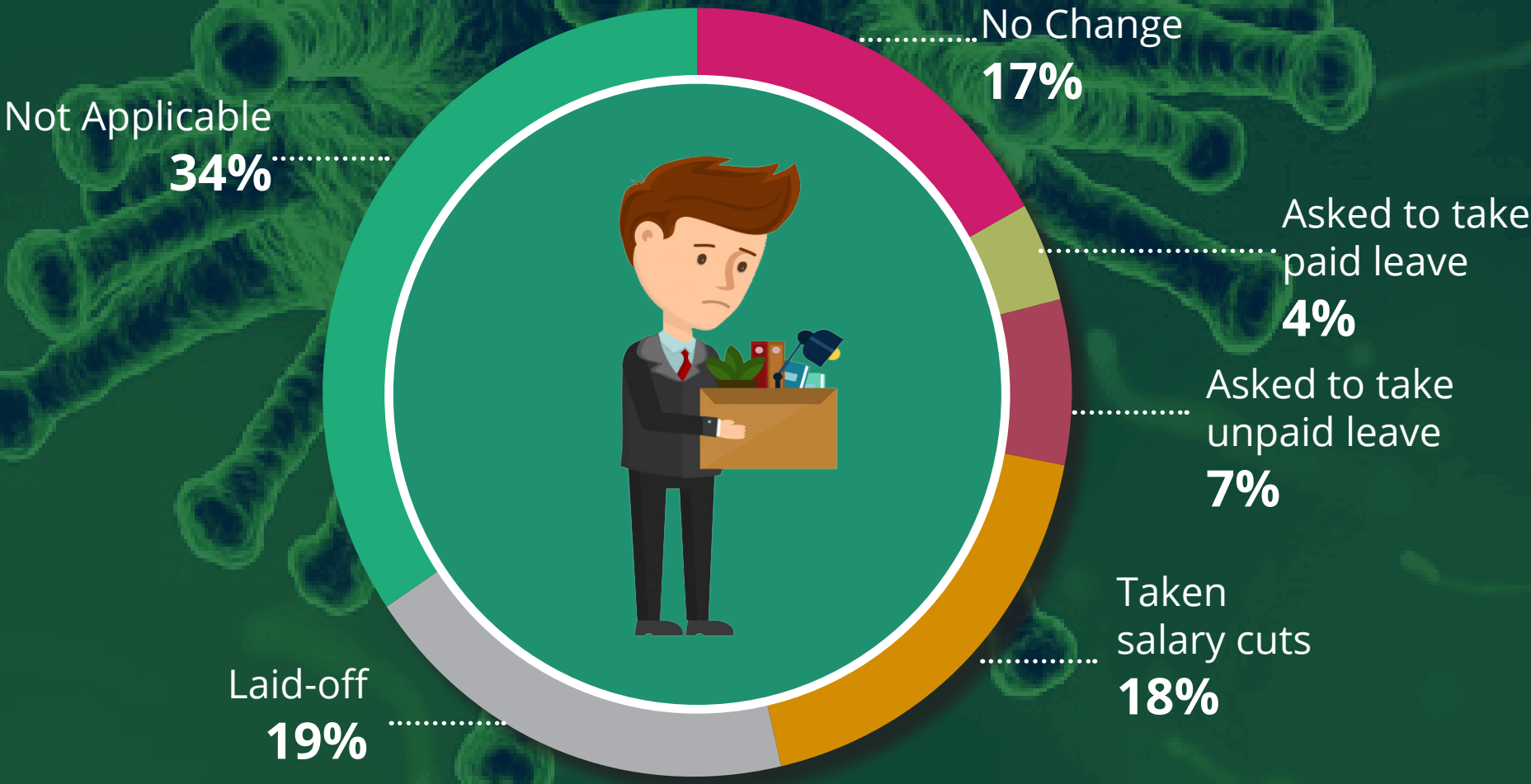

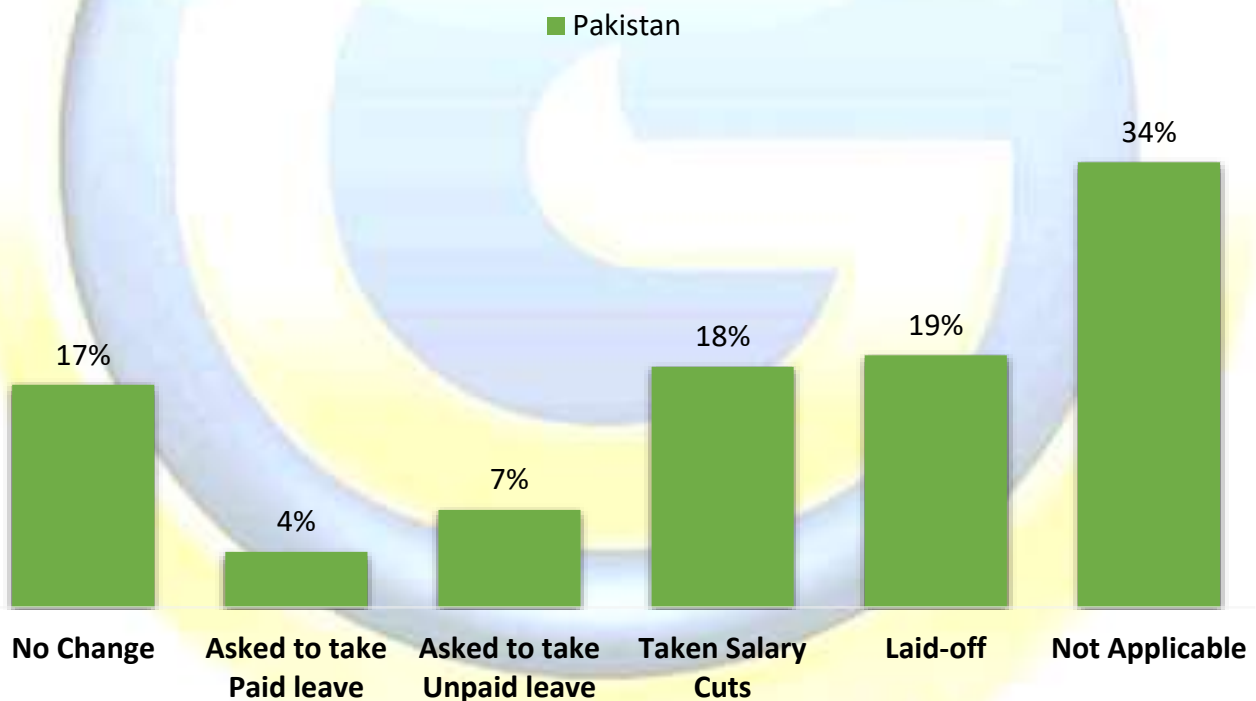

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 37% Pakistanis report either being laid off from their jobs or pay cuts amid the Coronavirus crisis. 17% report no change in their income.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, “How has the COVID-19 situation impacted your income? (Salaried individuals)” In response to this question, 17% Pakistanis reported no change, 4% say they were asked to take paid leave, 7% claim they were asked to take unpaid leave, 18% report taking salary cuts, 19% were laid off and 34% say this question is not applicable to them.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out through telephonic interviews among a sample of 1,050 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during June 04 – June 13, 2020 as a part of Gallup Pakistan Coronavirus Attitude Tracker Survey 2020, Wave 6. The error margin is estimated to be approximately ± 3 percent at the 95% confidence level.
