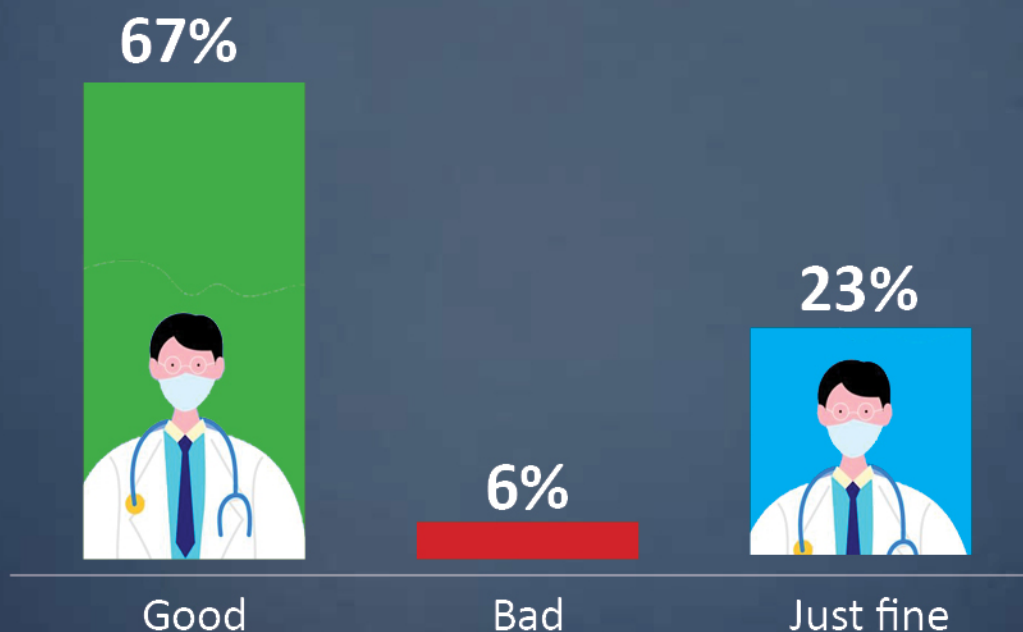

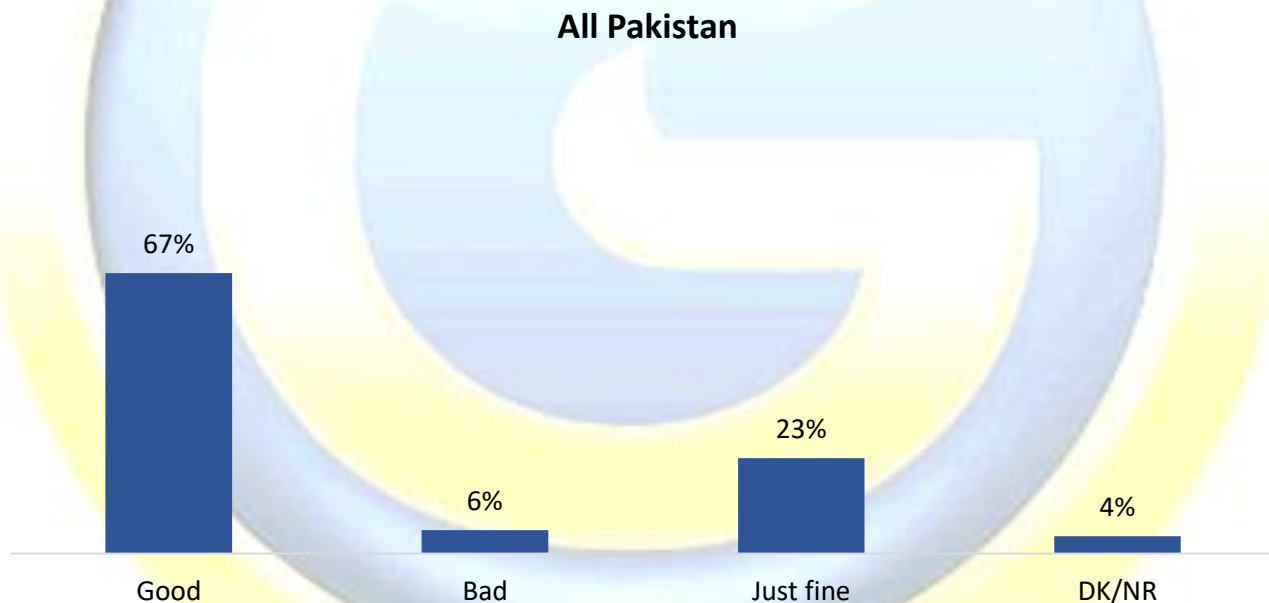

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, high Satisfaction with doctors was found as nearly two-thirds (67%) of Pakistanis stated that the behavior of their doctor during their last consultation was good.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, “How was the doctor's behavior with you during your last consultation” In response to this question, 67% replied good, 6% replied bad, 23% replied just fine and 4% didn’t know or gave no response.

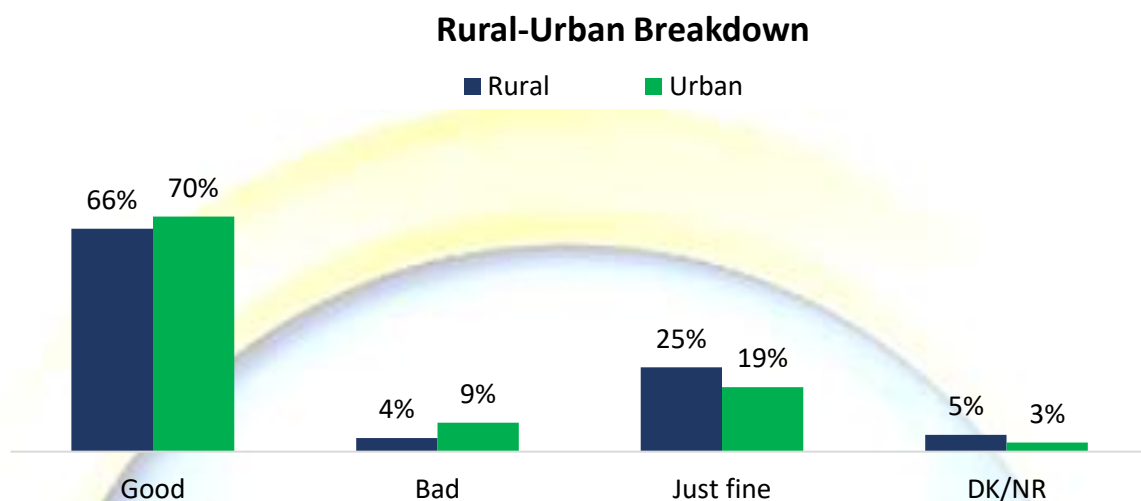
Question: “How was the doctor's behavior with you during your last consultation?”

Rural-Urban Breakdown

70% of people from urban areas as compared to 66% of people from rural areas were satisfied with their doctor's behavior during their last consultation.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1440 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, from December 22, 2021 - January 15, 2022. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was CATI.
