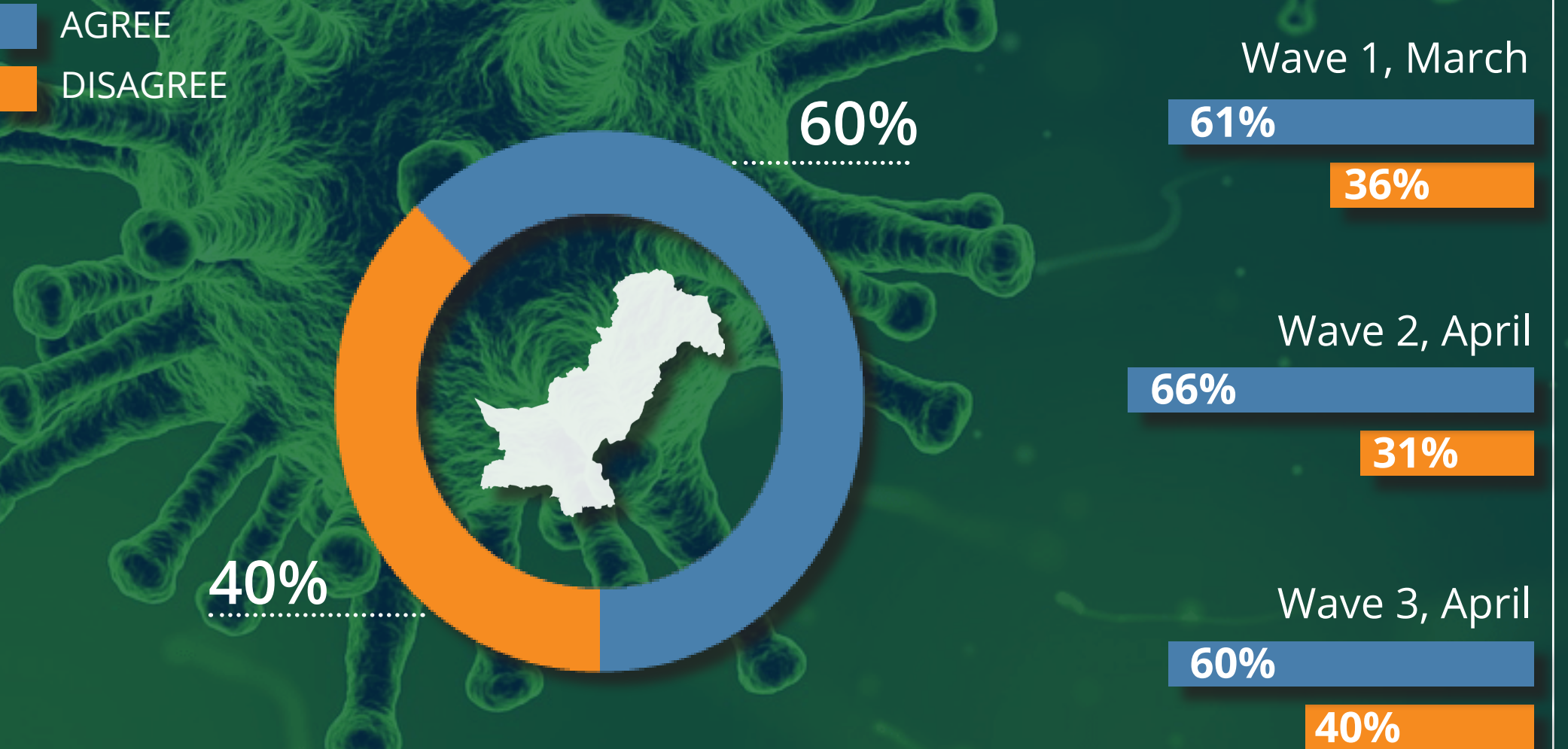


THE FEAR OF CONTRACTING CORONAVIRUS HAS DECREASED BY 6% SINCE WAVE 2 WITH 3 IN 5 (60%) PAKISTANIS NOW CLAIMING THEY ARE AFRAID THAT THEY OR A FAMILY MEMBER MAY GET INFECTED BY THE VIRUS. PAKISTAN RANKS 16TH OUT OF 17 COUNTRIES IN TERMS OF BEING FEARFUL ABOUT CATCHING THE INFECTION

CORONAVIRUS

The fear of contracting coronavirus has decreased by 6% since Wave 2 with 3 in 5 (60%) Pakistanis now claiming they are afraid that they or a family member may get infected by the virus. 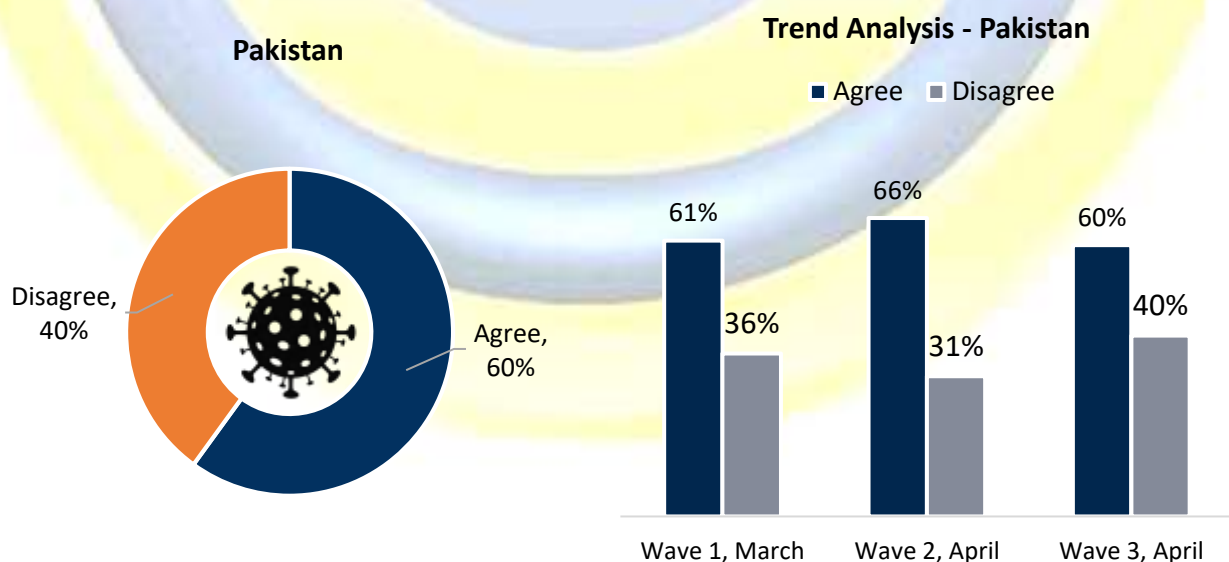
According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the fear of contracting coronavirus has decreased by 6% since Wave 2 with 3 in 5 (60%) Pakistanis now claiming they are afraid that they or a family member may get infected by the virus.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, *“How strongly do you agree or disagree with the following statement: “I am afraid that either I or someone in my family may actually catch the Coronavirus”?”* In response to this question, 60% Pakistanis agreed that they are afraid, 40% said that they are not afraid that the Coronavirus will infect them or someone in their family.

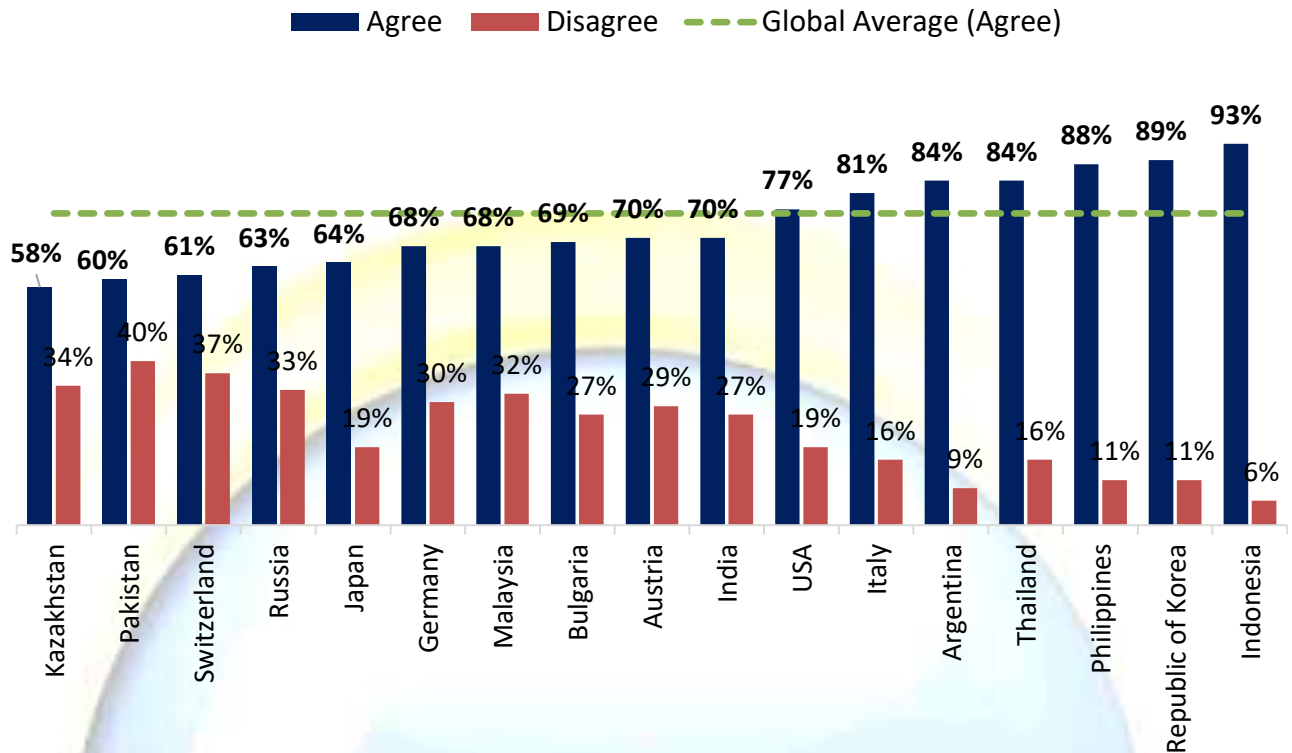
Global result: Respondents from Indonesia (93%) are the most fearful about catching the infection. Pakistan ranks 16th out of 17 countries in terms of being fearful about catching the infection.

Globally, 76% agreed that they are afraid of being infected by the Coronavirus. Comparing Pakistan's figure with the global average figure, Pakistan only ranks higher than Kazakhstan but lower than 16 other countries such as USA, India, Thailand, Italy and many others where the threat of infection is perceived to be much higher than Pakistan.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out through telephonic interviews among a sample of 1,014 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during April 04 – April 10, 2020 as a part of Gallup Pakistan Coronavirus Attitude Tracker Survey 2020, Wave 3. Gallup International conducted international fieldwork in a study comprised internationally of 24,652 respondents covering different ethnicities, regions, religions, age and gender. The error margin is estimated to be approximately ± 3 percent at the 95% confidence level.
