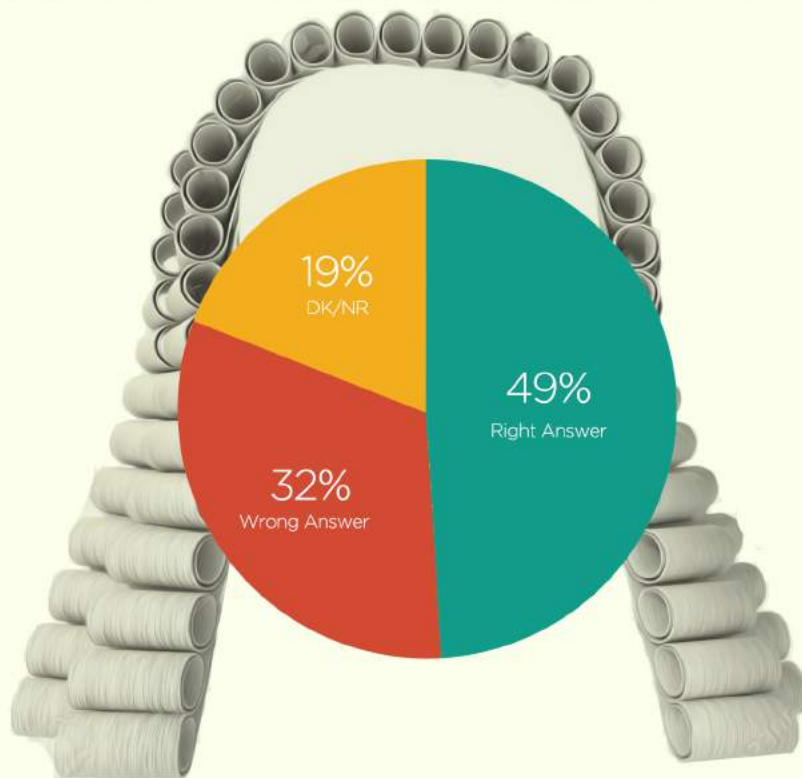


Please tell us the name of the current Chief Justice of Pakistan?

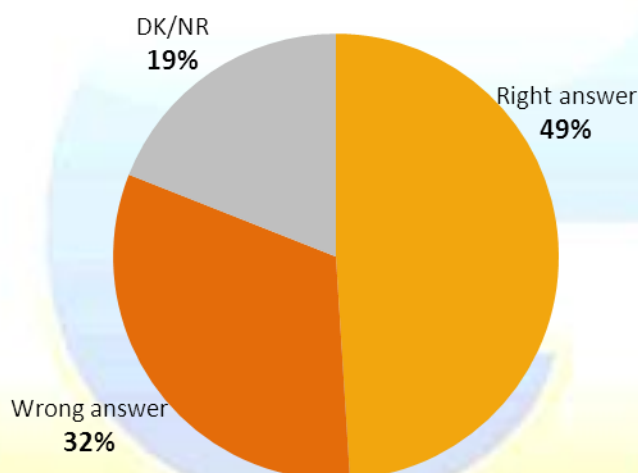
Less than half Pakistanis gave the right answer when asked to name the current Chief Justice of Pakistan. GILANI RESEARCH FOUNDATION (GRF POLL)

Islamabad, June 30, 2015

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, 49% Pakistanis gave the right answer when asked to name the current Chief Justice of Pakistan; 32% gave the wrong answer.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women, from across the four provinces was asked, "Please tell us the name of the current Chief Justice of Pakistan?" In response to this question, 49% respondents gave the right answer (Nasir-ul-Mulk), while 32% respondents gave the wrong answer, and 19% respondent did not respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1783 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during May 04 - May 11, 2015. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.

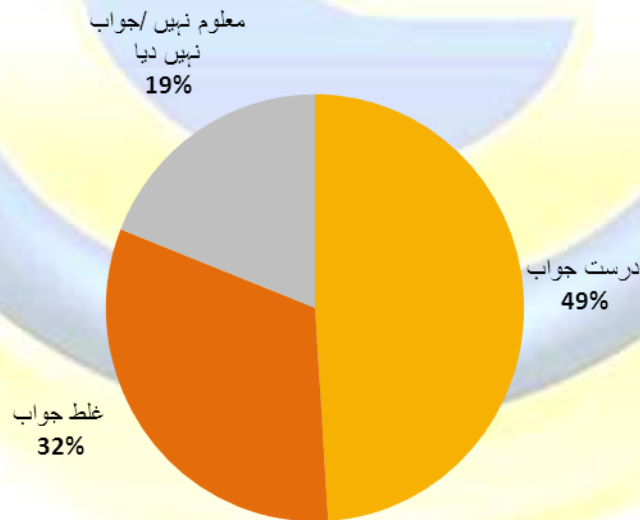

گیلانی ریسرچ فاؤنڈیشن کے حالیہ سروے کے مطابق، 49% پاکستانیوں نے پاکستان کے موجودہ چیف جسٹس کا درست نام بتایا جب ان سے پاکستان کے موجودہ چیف جسٹس کا نام پوچھا گیا، جبکہ 32% افراد نے غلط جواب دیا۔

سروے میں ملک بھر سے شماریاتی طور پر منتخب خواتین و حضرات سے یہ سوال پوچھا گیا کہ "برائے مہربانی پاکستان کے موجودہ چیف جسٹس کا نام بتائیں؟"۔ اس سوال کے جواب میں 49% جوابدہندگان نے پاکستان کے موجودہ چیف جسٹس (ناصر الملک) کا درست نام بتایا، جبکہ 32% افراد نے پاکستان کے موجودہ چیف جسٹس کا نام غلط بتایا، تاہم 19% افراد نے کسی رائے کا اظہار نہیں کیا۔
