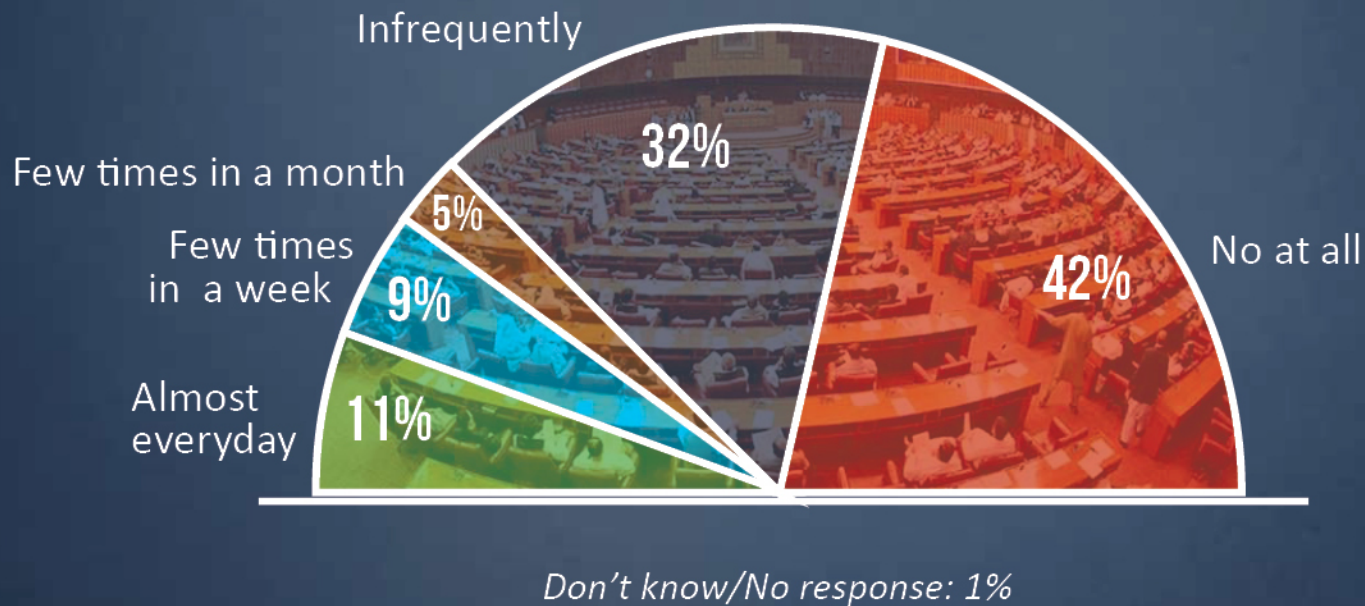

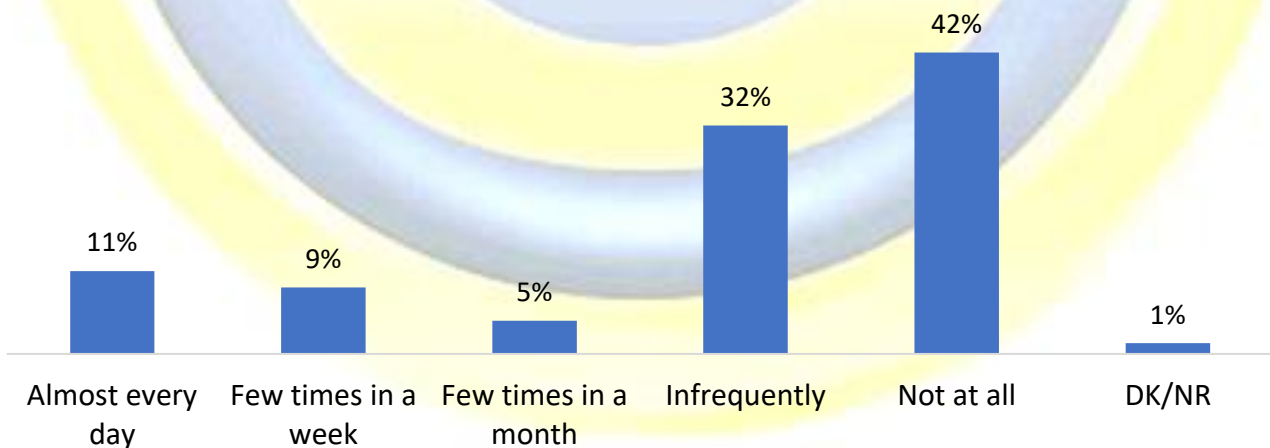

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, only 11% Pakistanis say that they talk to other people about the government and politics in general almost every day; vast majority says they do not talk to others about politics.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, “*Kindly state, how regularly do you talk to other people about the government and politics in general (in-person/on the phone/on social media)?*” In response to this question, 11% said almost every day, 9% said few times in a week, 5% said few times in a month, 32% said infrequently while 42% said not at all. 1% did not know or provided no response.

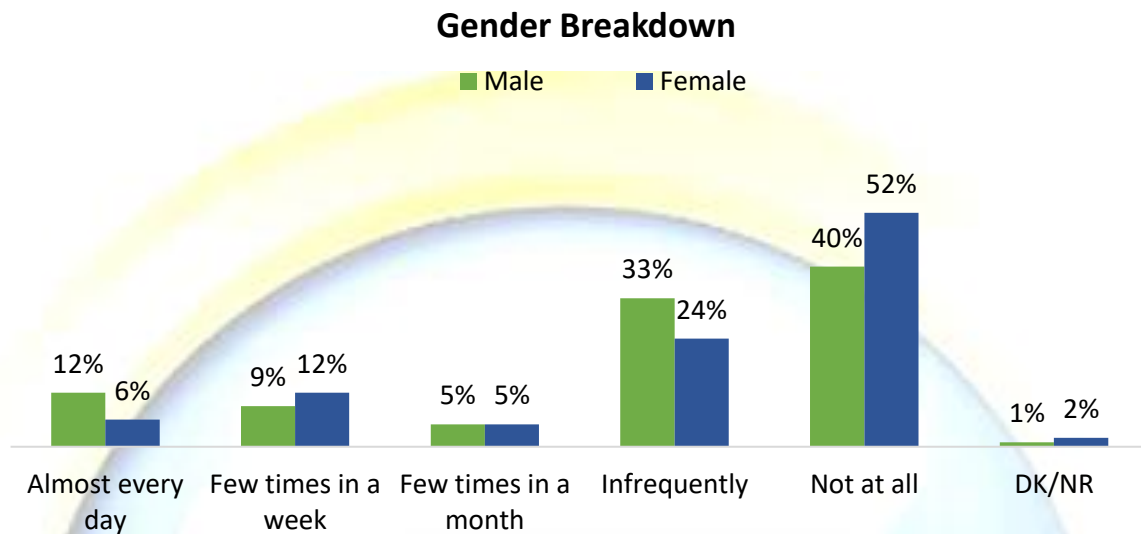

Males (12%) are more likely to talk to other people the government and politics in general almost every day as compared to females (6%).

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1730 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during September 23, 2021 – October 08, 2021. The error margin is estimated to be approximately ± 2 -3 percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was CATI.
