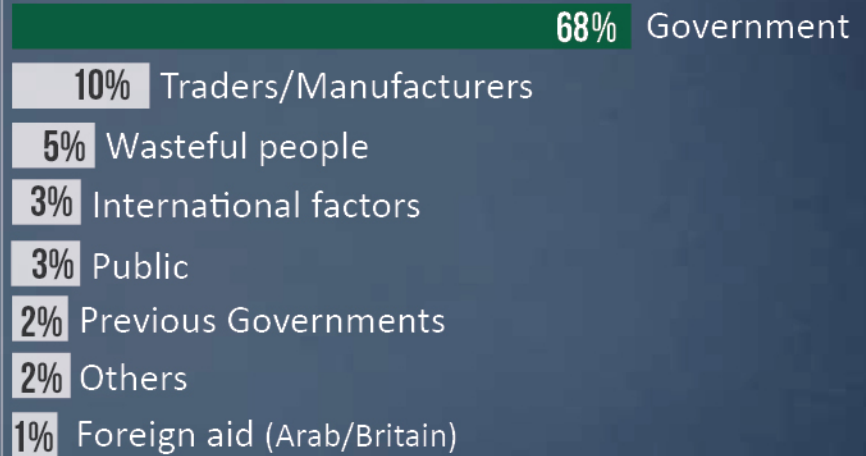

The majority (68%) of Pakistanis blame the government for inflation: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

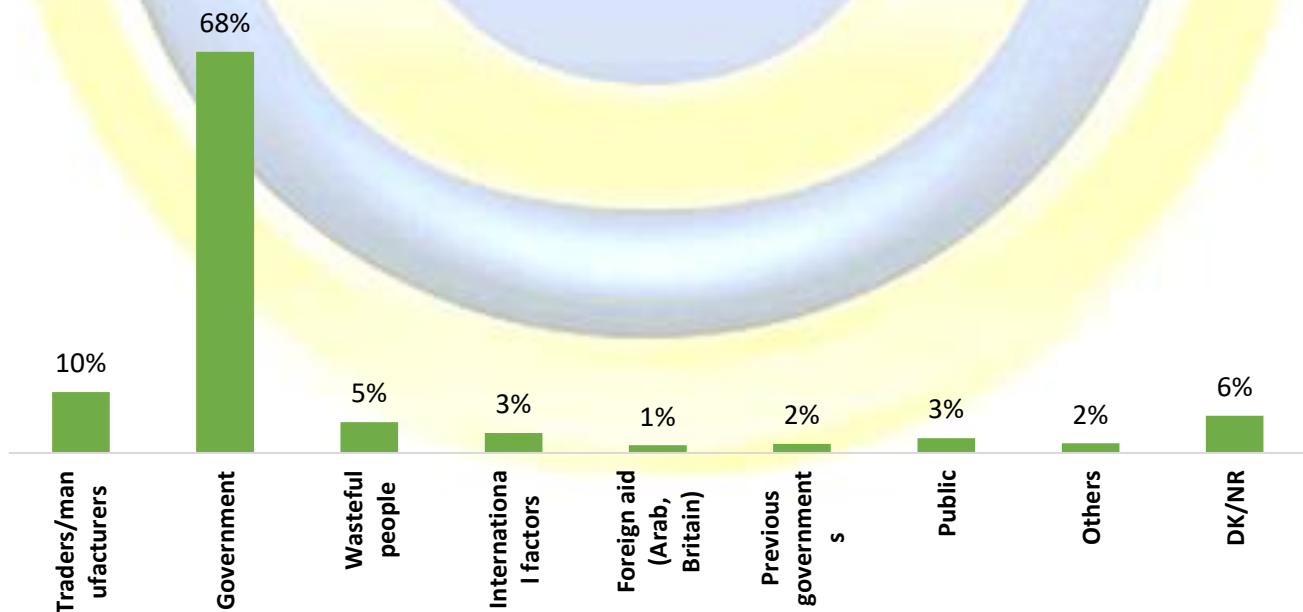

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the majority (68%) of Pakistanis blame the government for inflation.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, “Who do you think is responsible for inflation?” In response to this question, 10% said traders/manufacturers, 68% said government, 5% said wasteful people, 3% said international factors, 1% said foreign aid (Arab, Britain), 2% said previous governments, 3% said public, and 2% said others. 6% did not know or provided no response.

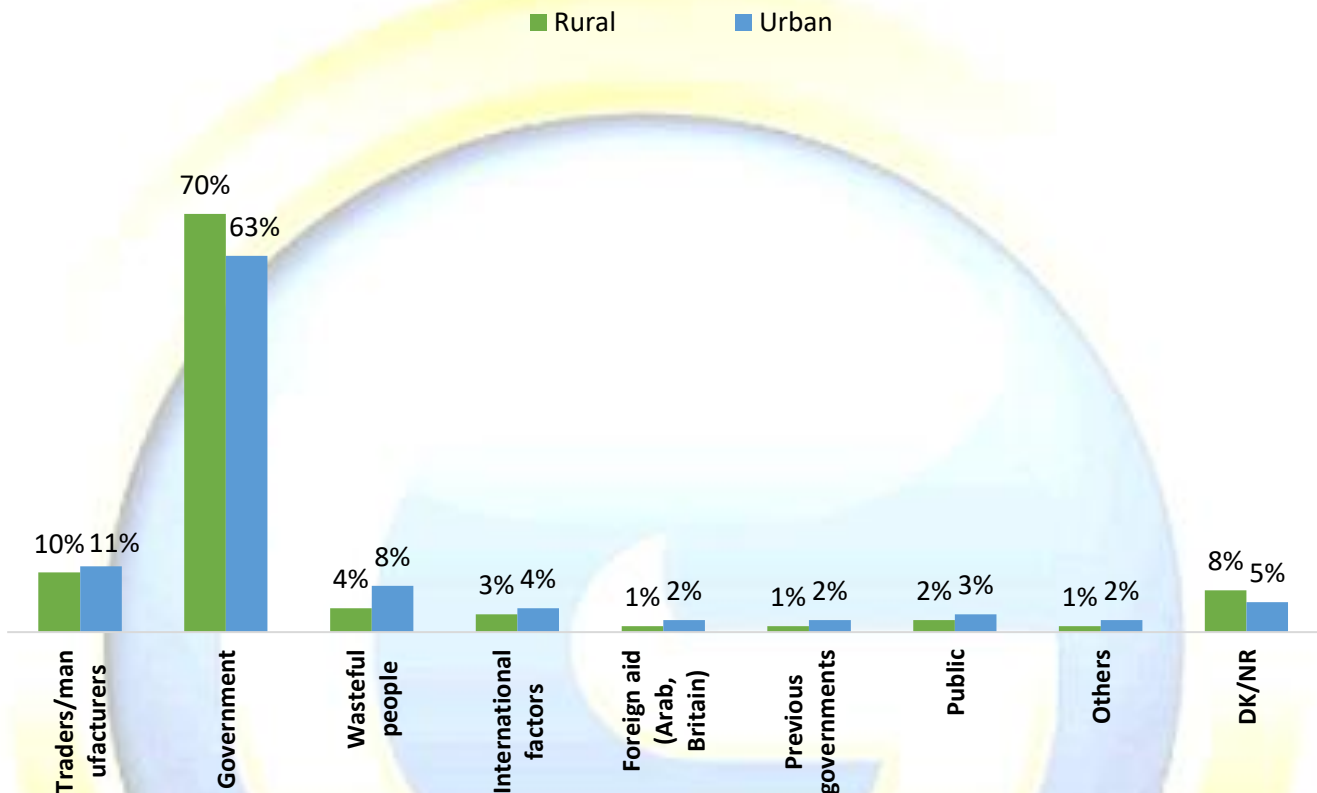

Urban-Rural Breakdown

As compared to urban residents (63%), rural residents (70%) are more likely to hold the government responsible for inflation.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1730 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during September 23, 2021 – October 08, 2021. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was CATI.
