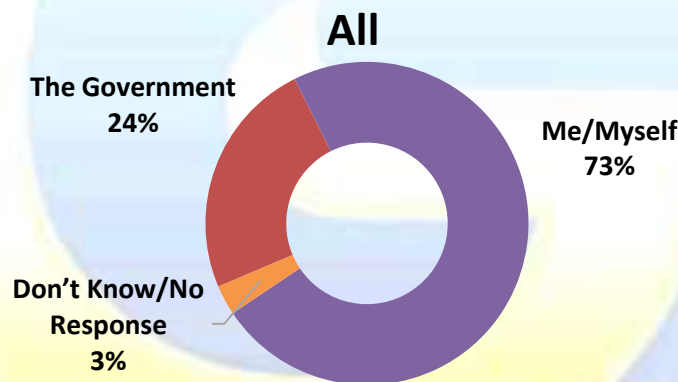

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 3 in 4 Pakistanis (73%) opine that decisions regarding their health are their own responsibility. 24% say it is the government's responsibility - 10% higher than global average.

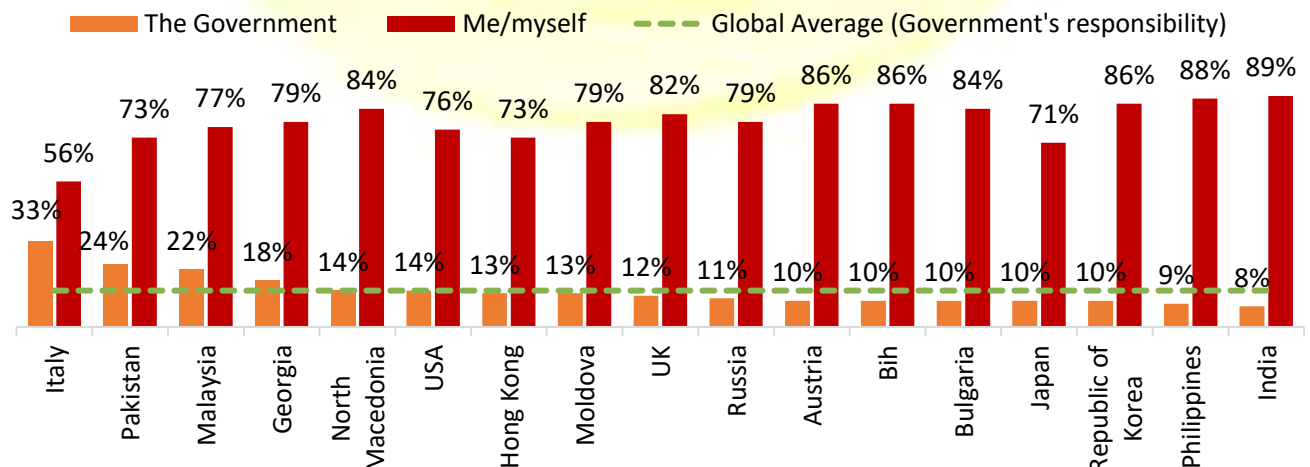
A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, "Ultimately who do you think is responsible for decisions about your health - the government or yourself?" In response to this question, 73% said they are responsible themselves, 24% said the government is responsible and 3% said they do not know/did not respond.

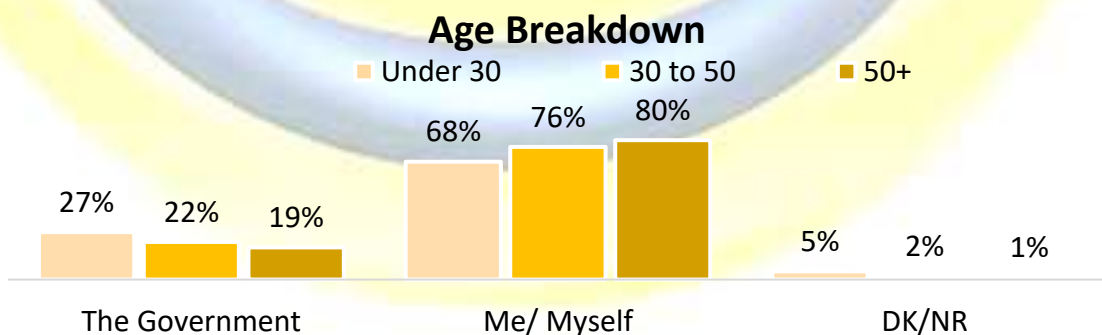
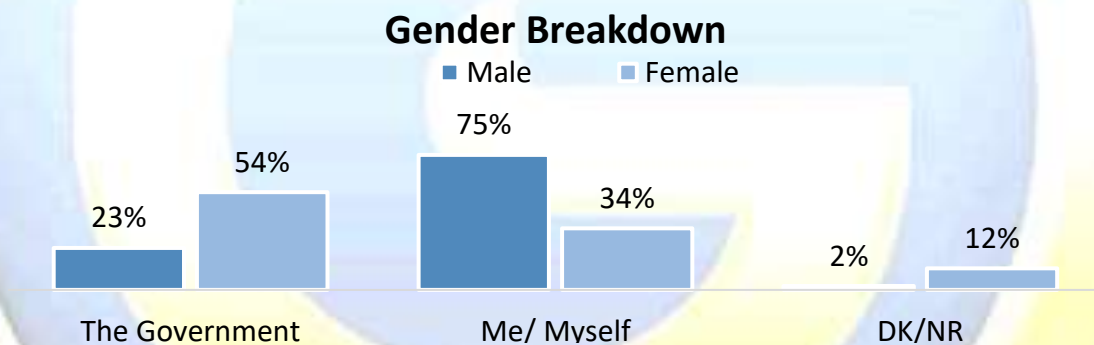
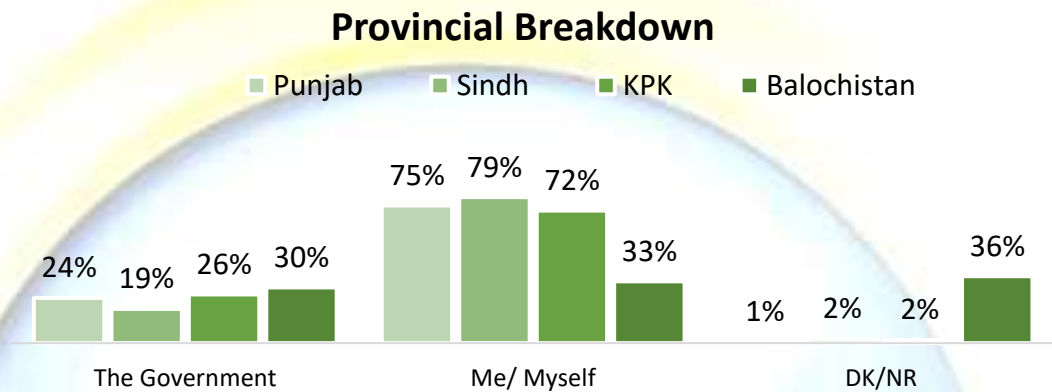
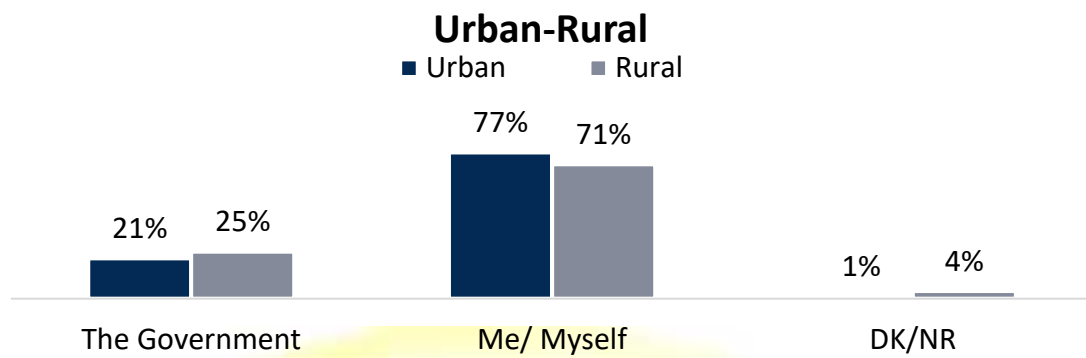
Question: "Ultimately who do you think is responsible for decisions about your health - the government or yourself?"

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out through telephonic interviews among a sample of 1,219 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during June 04 – June 13, 2020 as a part of Gallup Pakistan Coronavirus Attitude Tracker Survey 2020, Wave 6. The error margin is estimated to be approximately ± 3 percent at the 95% confidence level.
