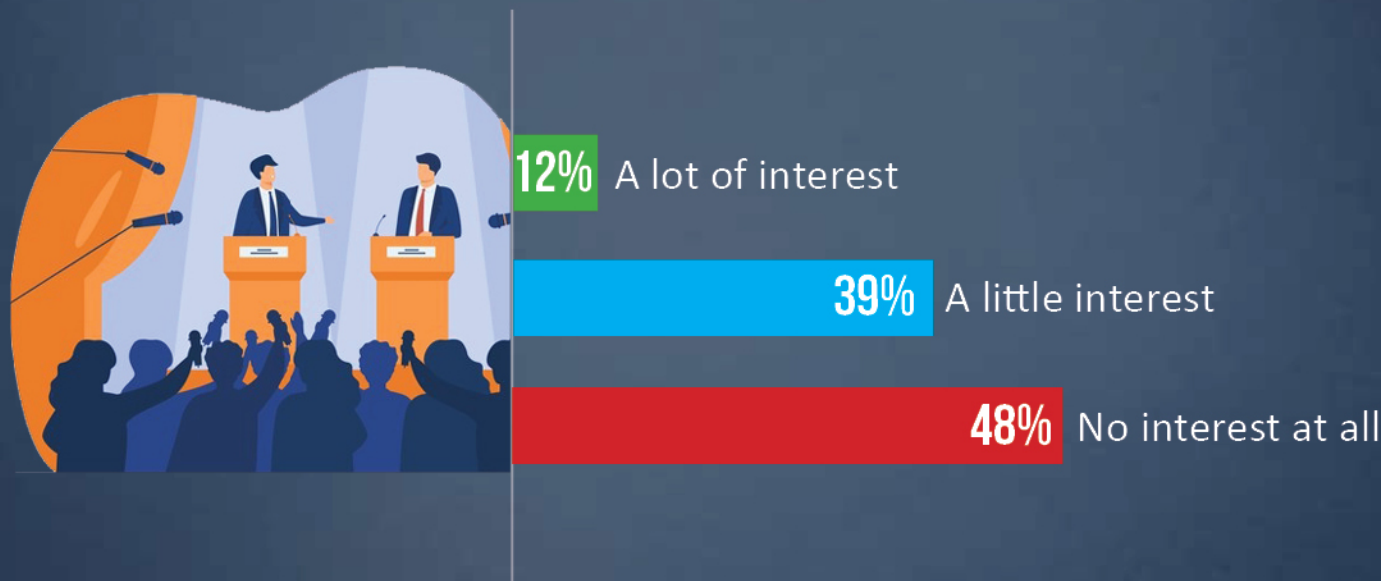

## Opinion Poll General Political Opinions

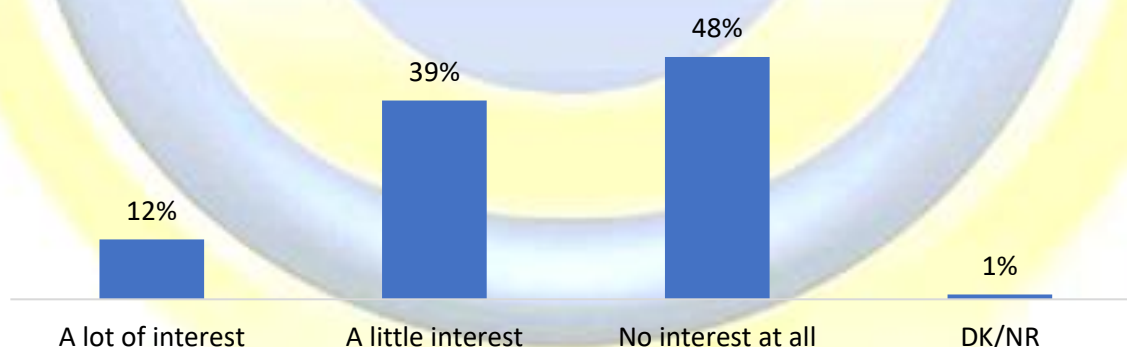

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, nearly half (48%) of Pakistanis say that they take no interest at all in the country's politics; this response was more common among females (56%) as compared to males (47%).

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, *"How much interest do you take in the country's politics?"* In response to this question, 12% said they take a lot of interest, 39% said a little interest while 48% said no interest at all. 1% did not know or provided no response.

**Question: "How much interest do you take in the country's politics?"**

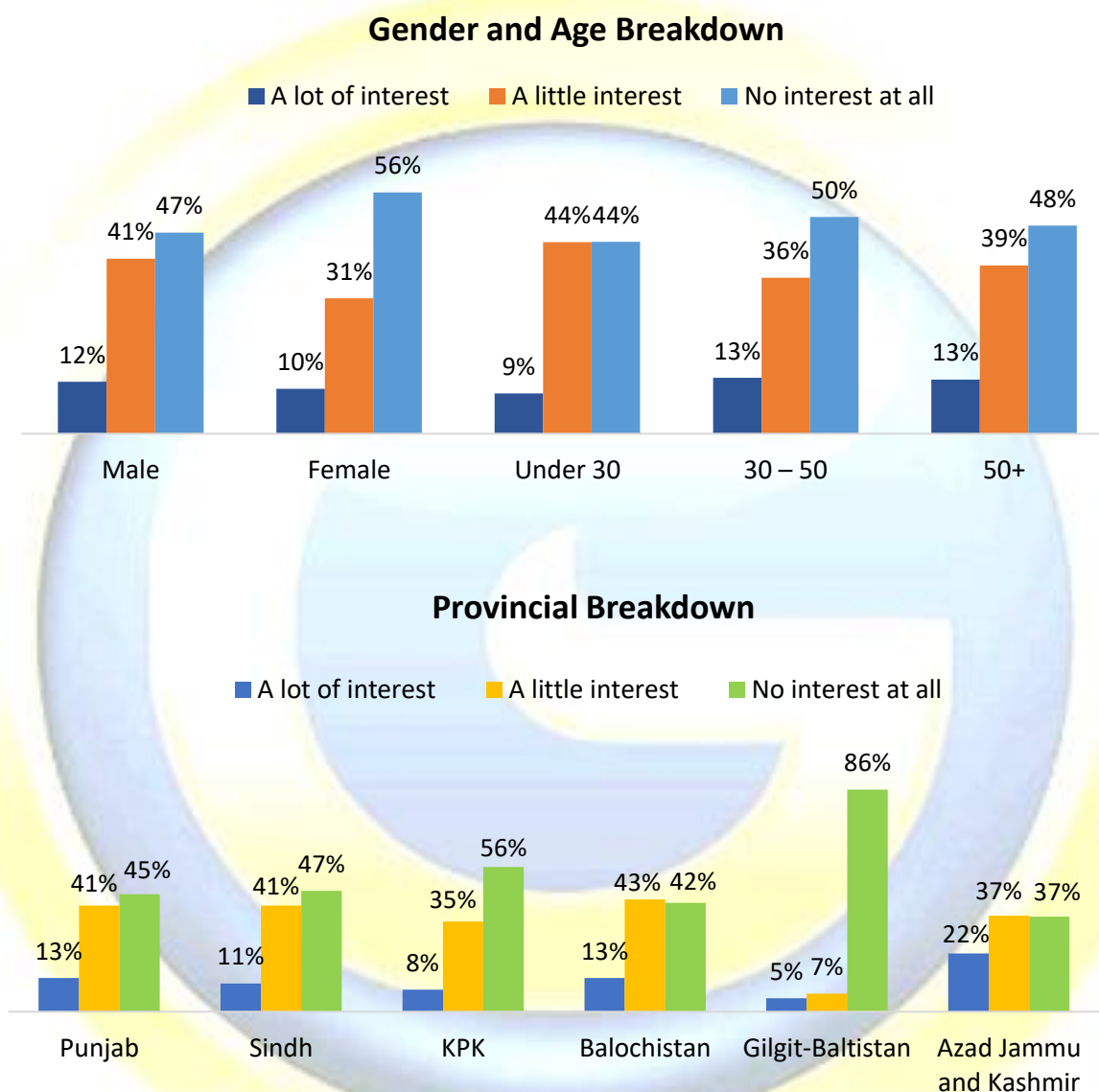

## Breakdown

As compared to males (47%), more females (56%) report that they take no interest at all in the country's politics. Age-wise, those aged between 30 – 50 years (50%) are slightly more likely to say the same as compared to those under 30 years (44%) and above 50 years (48%). Provincially, those belonging to Gilgit-Baltistan (86%) are likely to show the least interest in politics as compared to other provinces.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1730 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during September 23, 2021 – October 8, 2021. The error margin is estimated to be approximately  $\pm 2$ -3 percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was CATI.
