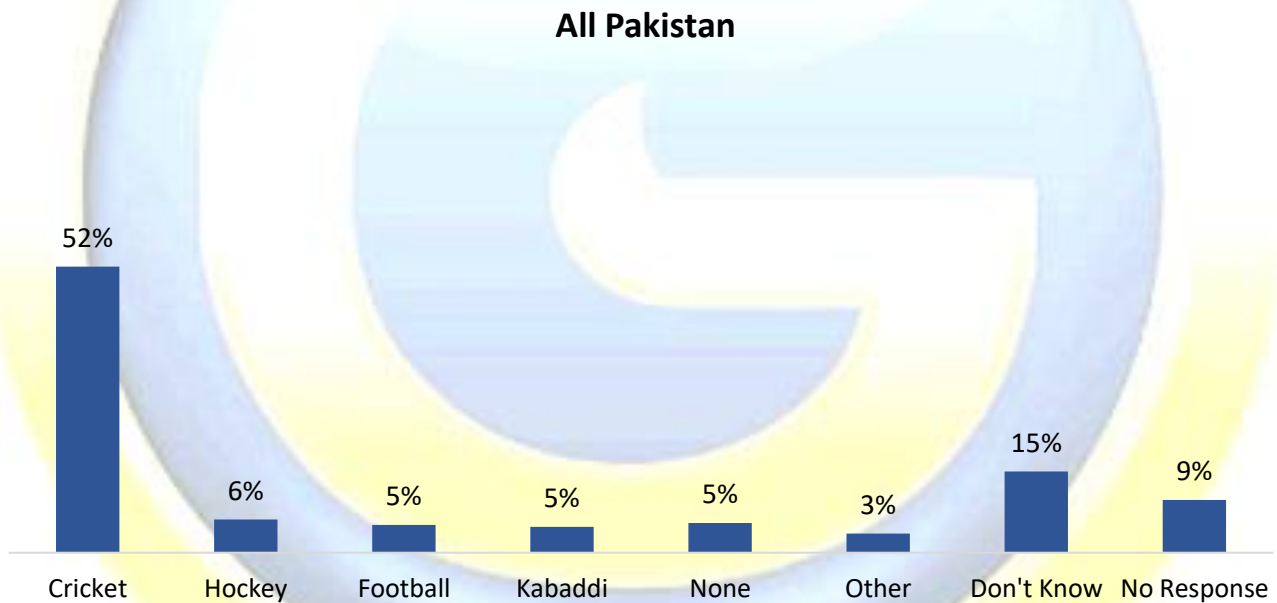
More than half (52%) Pakistanis like to watch cricket: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, more than half (52%) Pakistanis like to watch cricket: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, “*What sports do you personally like watching the most?*” In response to this question, 52% said cricket, 6% said hockey, 5% said football, 5% said kabaddi, 5% said none, 3% said other, 15% didn’t know and 9% gave no response.

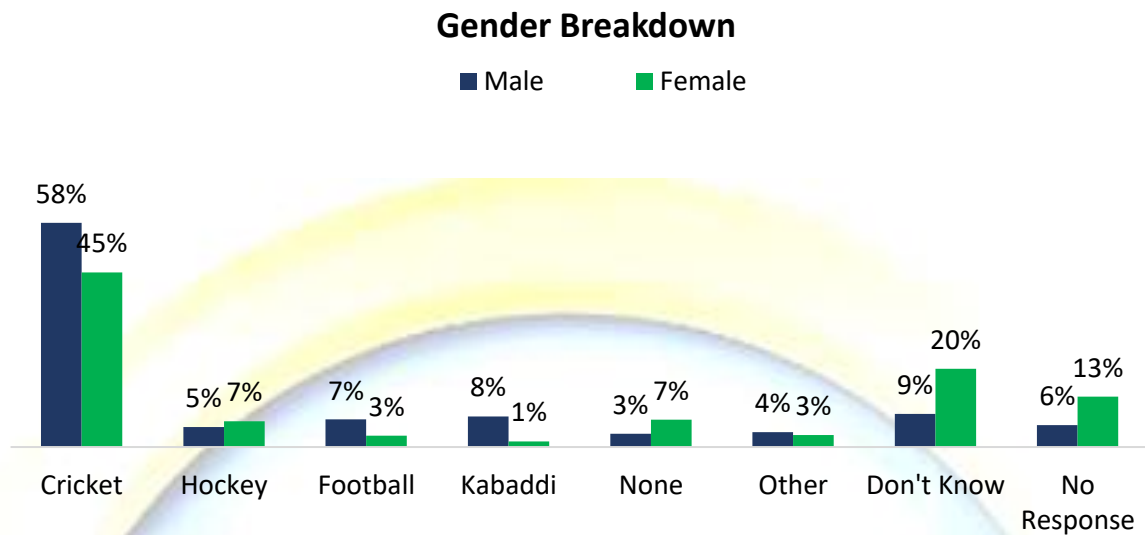
Question: “What sports do you personally like watching the most?”

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1865 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, from December 22, 2021 - January 15, 2022. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was CATI.
