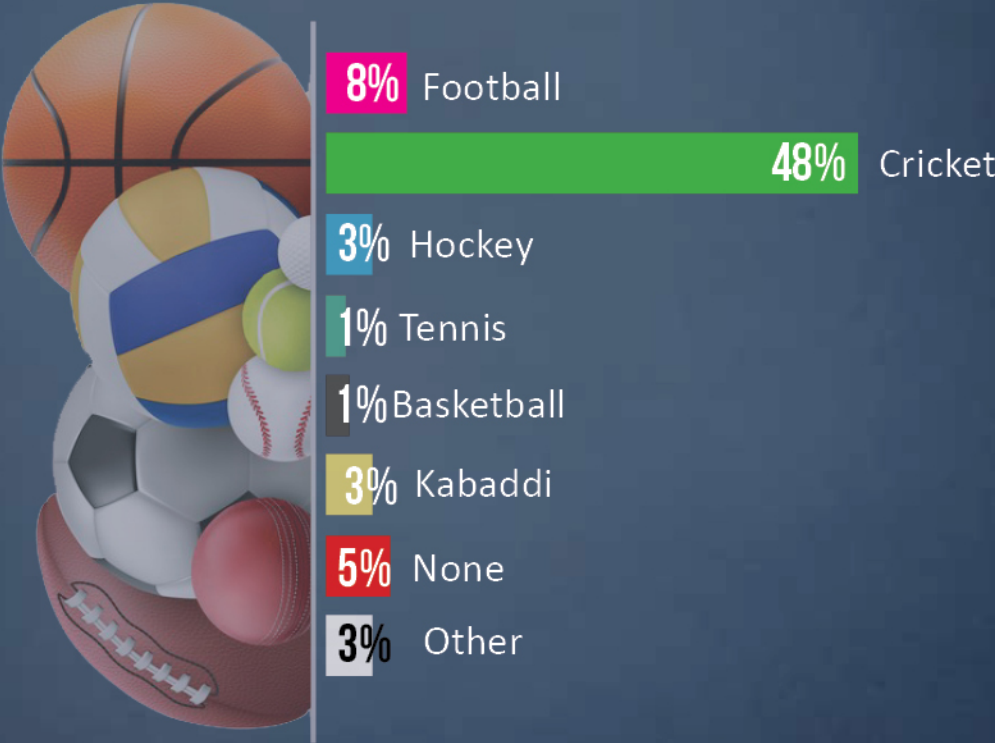

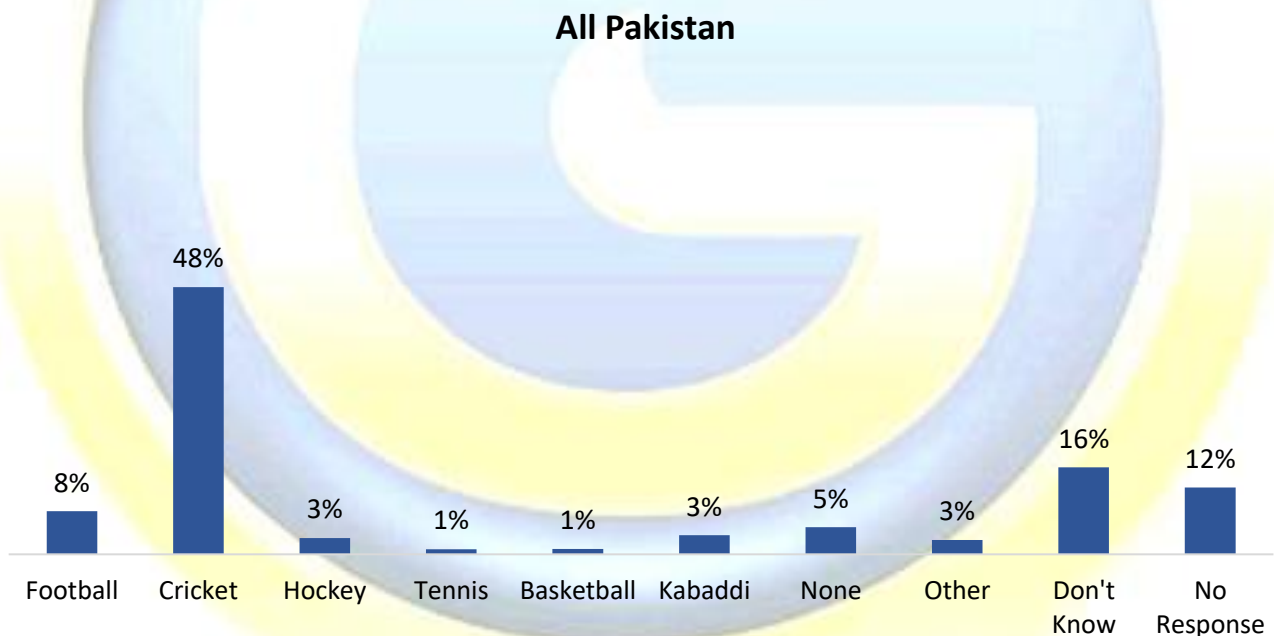
More males (57%) as compared to females (40%) claim that they are passionate about cricket: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, more males (57%) as compared to females (40%) claim that they are passionate about cricket.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, “Please tell us which sports are you most passionate about? (Meaning which sports do you like to play and watch)” In response to this question, 8% said football, 48% said cricket, 3% said hockey, 1% said tennis, 1% said basketball, 3% said kabaddi, 5% said none, 3% said other, 16% didn’t know and 12% gave no response.

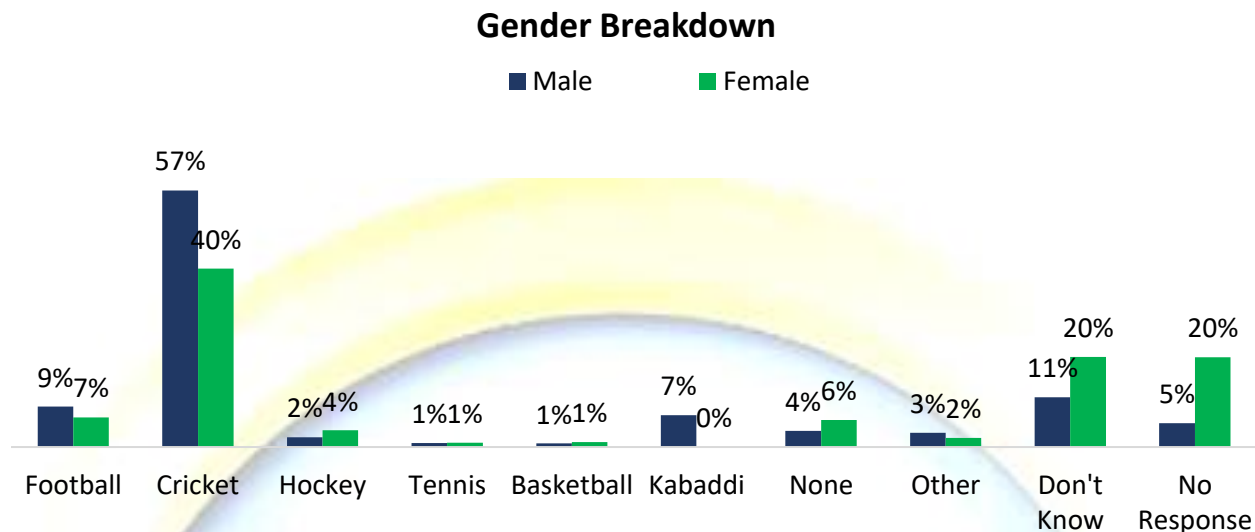
Question: “Please tell us which sports are you most passionate about? (Meaning which sports do you like to play and watch)”

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1865 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, from December 22, 2021 - January 15, 2022. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was CATI.
