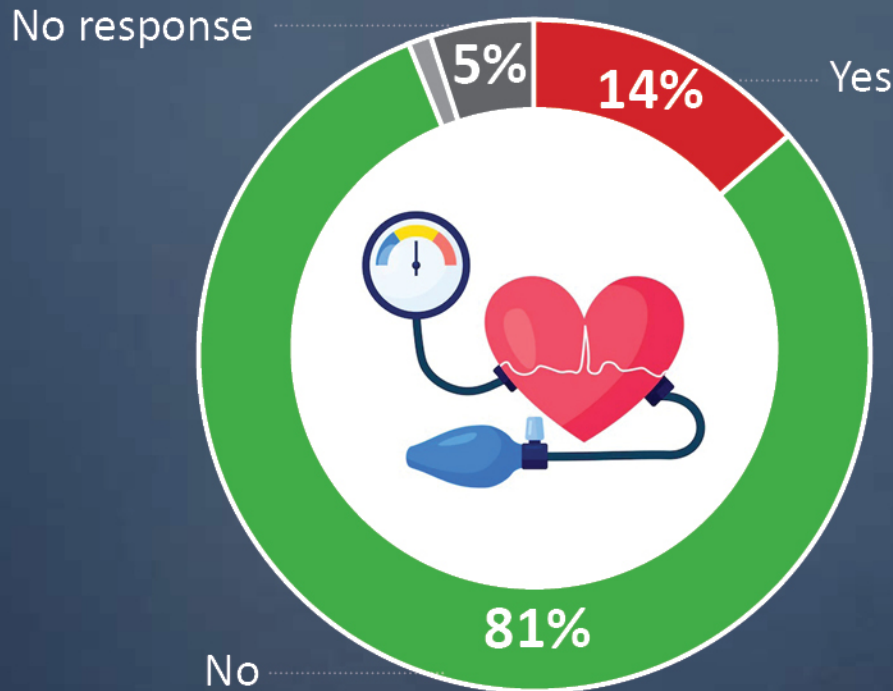

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 14% Pakistanis report that they or someone in their household suffers from low blood pressure; more rural residents (15%) as compared to urban residents (12%) claim this.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, *“Please tell us, God forbid, whether you or anyone in your household is suffering from the following diseases? - Low blood pressure? (Please give only one answer)?”* In response to this question, 14% said yes, 81% said no, 1% didn’t know and 5% gave no response.

Question: “Please tell us, God forbid, whether you or anyone in your household is suffering from the following diseases? - Low blood pressure”

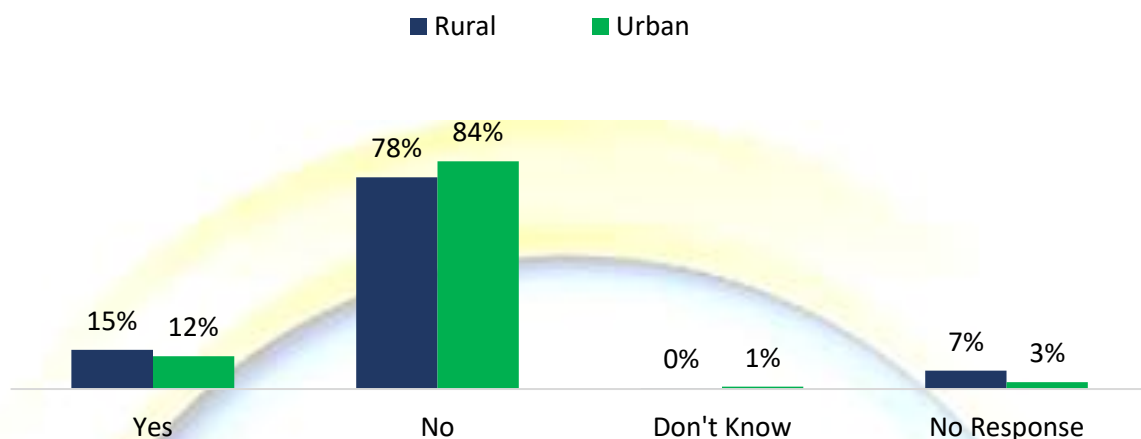

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1865 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, from December 22, 2021 - January 15, 2022. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was CATI.
