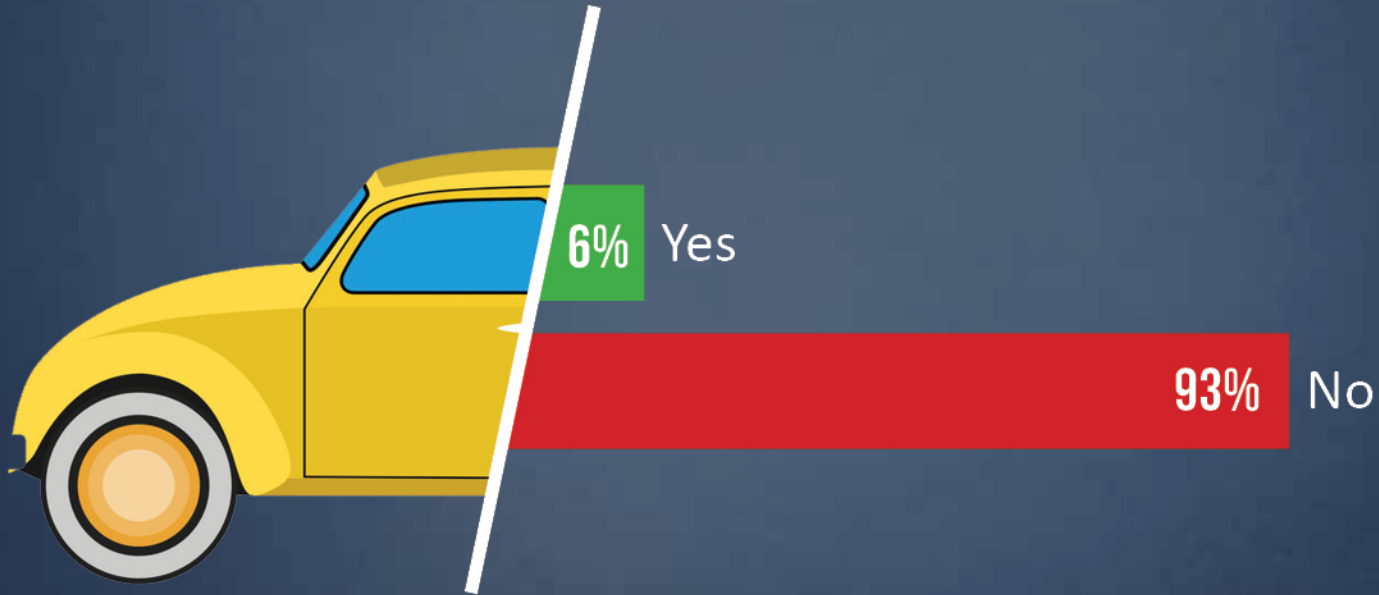

93% Pakistanis report they do not have a car in their home; more people from rural areas (95%) as compared to urban areas (87%) claim this: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 93% Pakistanis report they do not have a car in their home; more people from rural areas (95%) as compared to urban areas (87%) claim this.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, “Please tell us is there a car in your house?” In response to this question, 6% said yes, 93% said no, 1% didn’t know or gave no response.

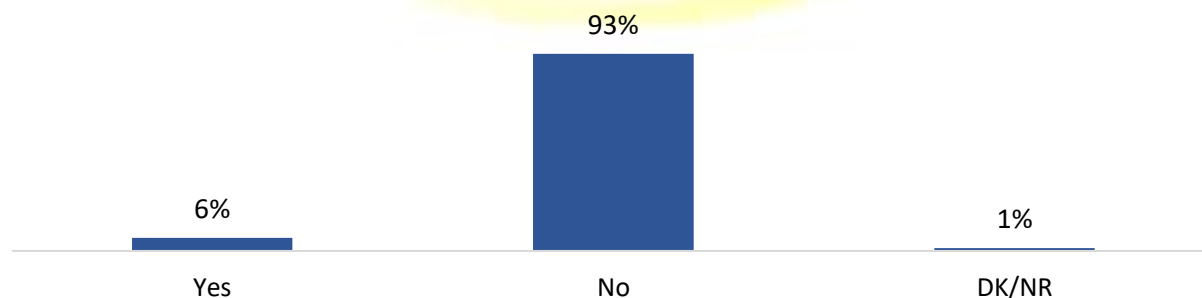
Data from the Pakistan Social and Living Standard Measurement’s (PSLM) survey (2019-2020) shows similar results, with 94% of Pakistanis stating that they do not own a car and only 6% stating they own a car. These figures were found to be similar to the results of the PSLM Survey of 2012-13, 2014-15 and 2018-19 as can be seen in the table below. 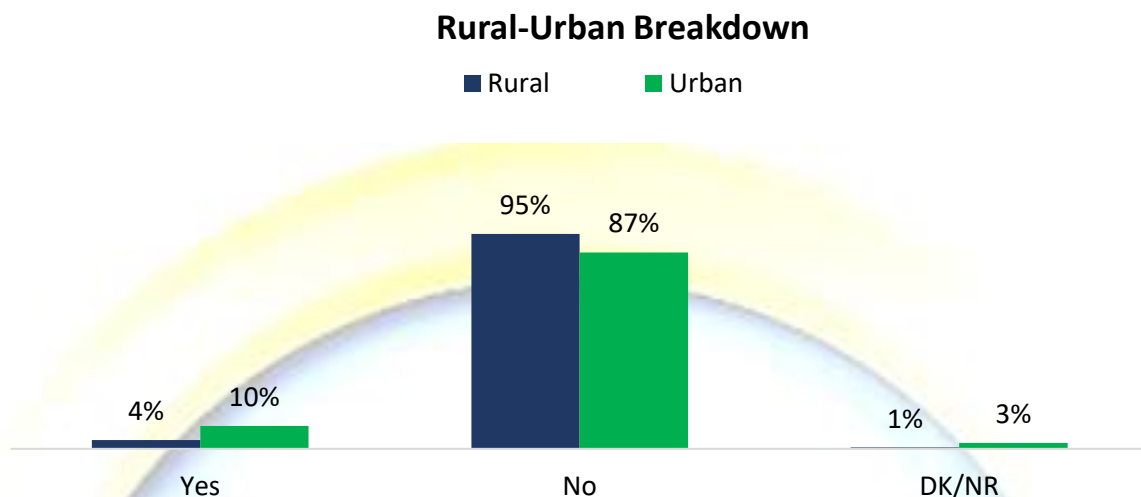

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1865 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, from December 22, 2021 - January 15, 2022. The error margin is estimated to be approximately ± 2 -3 percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was CATI.
