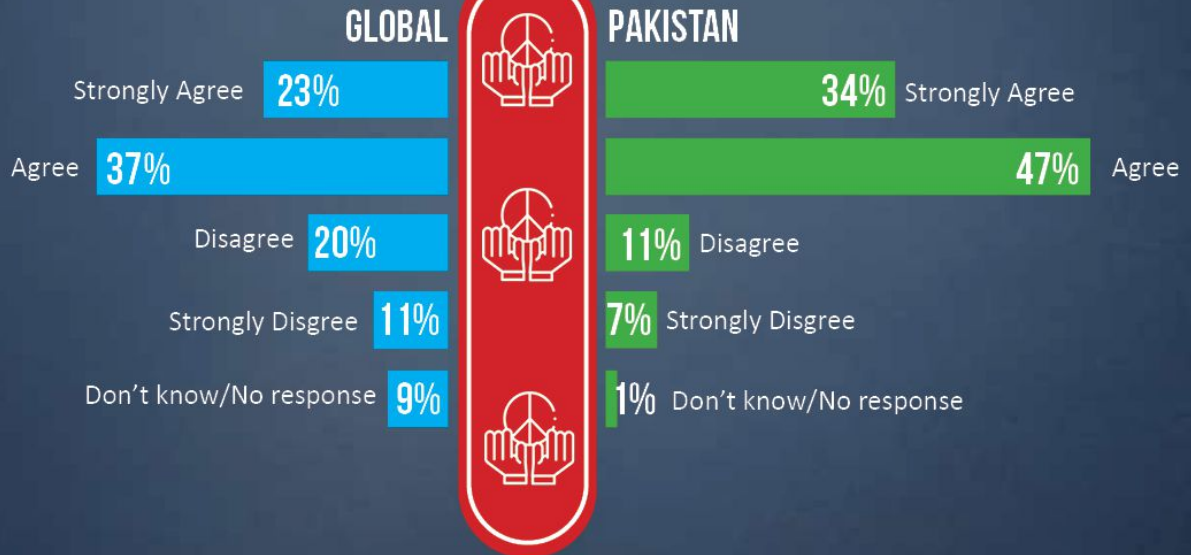

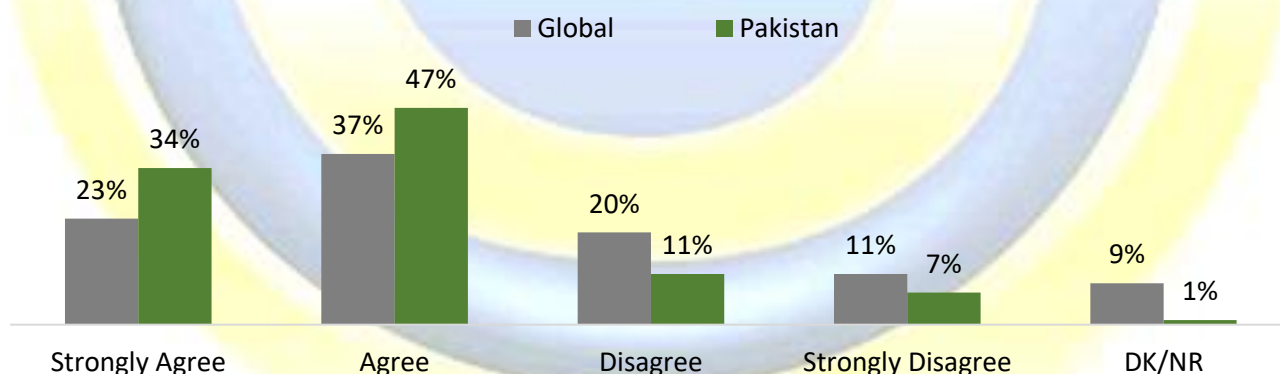

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 81% of Pakistanis report that they are willing to sacrifice some of their human rights if it helps prevent the spread of the virus; 60% of global respondents claim this.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, “Thinking specifically about the Coronavirus (COVID-19) how strongly do you agree or disagree with each of the following statements? - I am willing to sacrifice some of my human rights if it helps prevent the spread of the virus.” In response to this question in Pakistan, 34% said strongly agree, 47% said agree, 11% said disagree, 7% said strongly disagree, 1% didn’t know or gave no response.

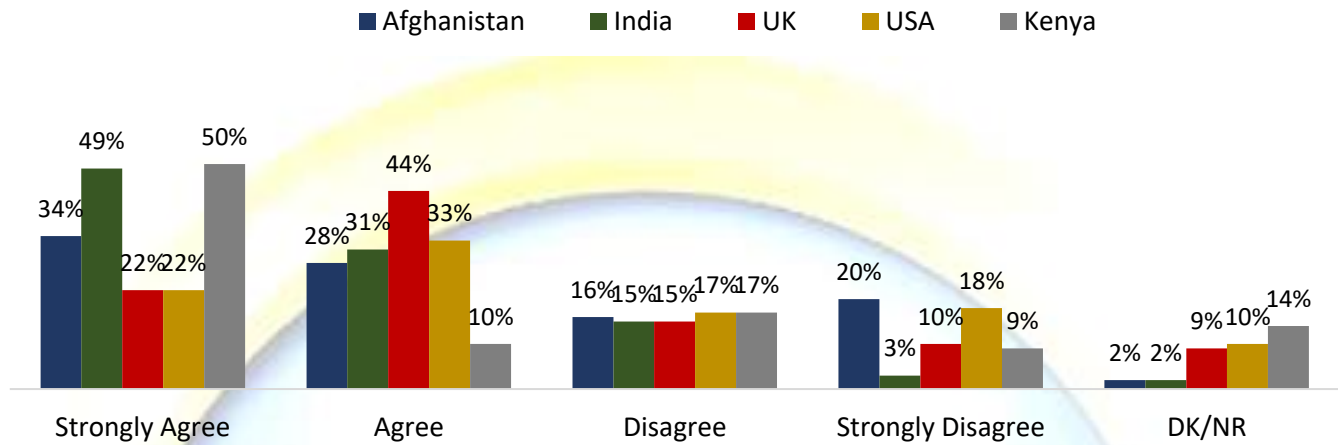

Country Breakdown

People from Afghanistan (20%) were the most hesitant to sacrifice their human rights for the eradication of the Coronavirus while people from India (49%) and Kenya (50%) showed their willingness the most.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1865 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, from December 22, 2021 - January 15, 2022. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was CATI.
