7 KEY FINDINGS

FINDING 1: 2 in 5 IslamabadIs (41%) believe that CDA is an efficient organization

FINDING 2: When asked if they were appointed as the chairman of CDA, 19% of respondents said that the first thing they will do is improve the governance

FINDING 3: Parks (74%) is the top-rated facility in Islamabad followed by cleanliness (67%), air pollution and security (61%), streetlights (60%), clean drinking water (49%), and public transport (48%)

SECTION I: Political Climate in Islamabad

- PTI (31%) and PML-N (15%) appear to be the popular parties in Islamabad
- Support for PTI is more prevalent among the urban residents (33%), older population (50%), and the educated (35%)

SECTION II: Performance of City's Managers and Institutions

- 2 in 5 Islamabad residents (41%) believe that CDA is an efficient organization
- Urban respondents (43%) and people within the age bracket of 18 to 29 years believe that CDA is an efficient organization
- 2 in 5 (40%) Islamabad residents report that municipal corporation is an efficient organization; this response is more common among the females (44%) and the educated (39%)

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

- Almost half (49%) Islamabad residents believe that the police is efficient in the city
- Elderly - 65+ years (75%), females (51%) and the highly educated (49%) respondents are of the opinion that police is efficient within the federal capital
- 59% Islamabad residents claim that IESCO is efficient in the capital
- More females (65%) and rural residents (67%) are of the opinion that IESCO is an efficient organization
- According to the respondents, the highest-rated performance was by IESCO (59%) followed by Police (49%), CDA (41%), and Municipal Corporation (40%)
- 7 in 10 Islamabad residents (68%) believe that the performance of CDA has improved in the past 10 years
- CDA performance is better rated by the urban residents (69%) and the elderly (75%)

- Almost half (46%) of Islamabad residents consider natural beauty to be the best thing about Islamabad
- Parks (74%) is the top-rated facility in Islamabad followed by cleanliness (67%), air pollution and security (61%), streetlights (60%), clean drinking water (49%), and public transport (48%)
- More females (56%) and urban residents (53%) consider cleanliness to be the best feature of Islamabad
- Security is considered a good facility within Islamabad by the females (36%) and the younger population (38%)

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

- Parks (23%), Monal (15%), and Margalla Hills (15%) are the top recreational spots among respondents in Islamabad
- A significantly higher proportion (78%) of respondents believe that it was a bad thing to close the zoo in the recent times

- 4 in 5 (80%) Islamabad residents claim that it is easy to walk around the capital
- More males (80%) and the younger generation (81%) believe it is easy to walk around Islamabad
- Metro bus (54%) and the public transport (52%) appeared as the most used modes of transportation around Islamabad

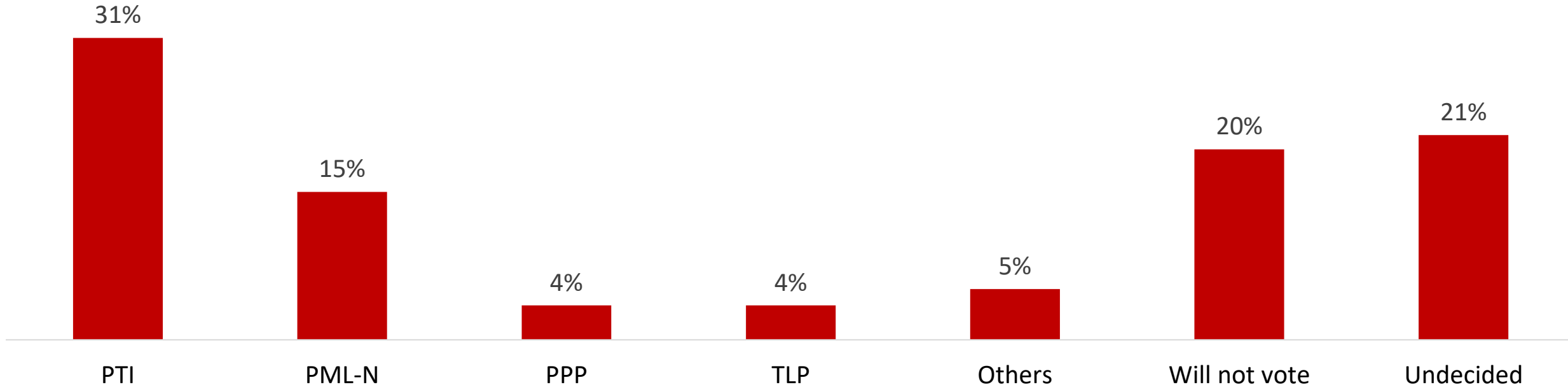
EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

- The usage of metro bus and public transport is more commonly reported among males as compared to the females
- 4 in 5 (80%) Islamabad residents believe that the federal capital is in need of a good transport system
- More males (44%) compared to females (27%) believe that the federal capital is in need of a good public transport system
- The average expenditure on public transport remained relatively low in Islamabad

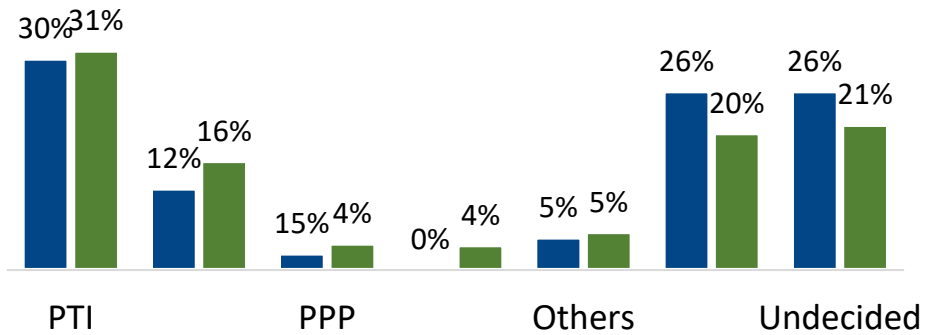

Question: If there are elections in Islamabad, which party would you vote for?

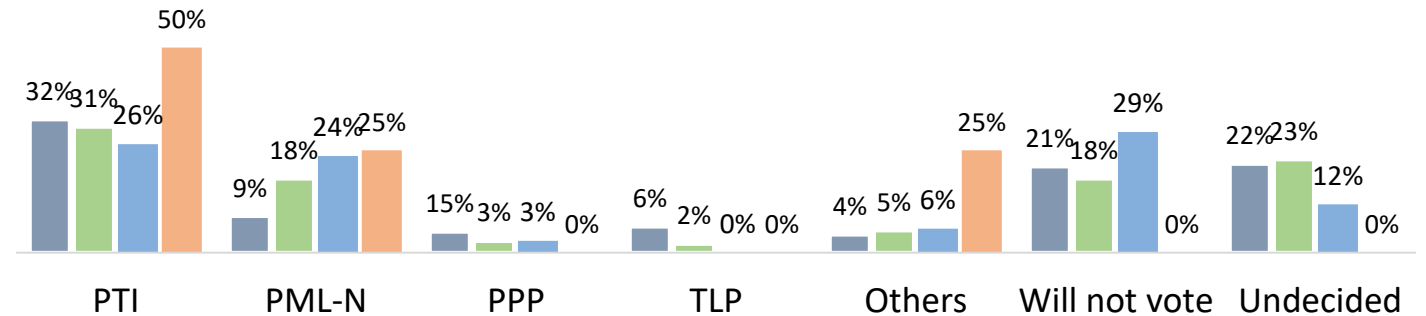

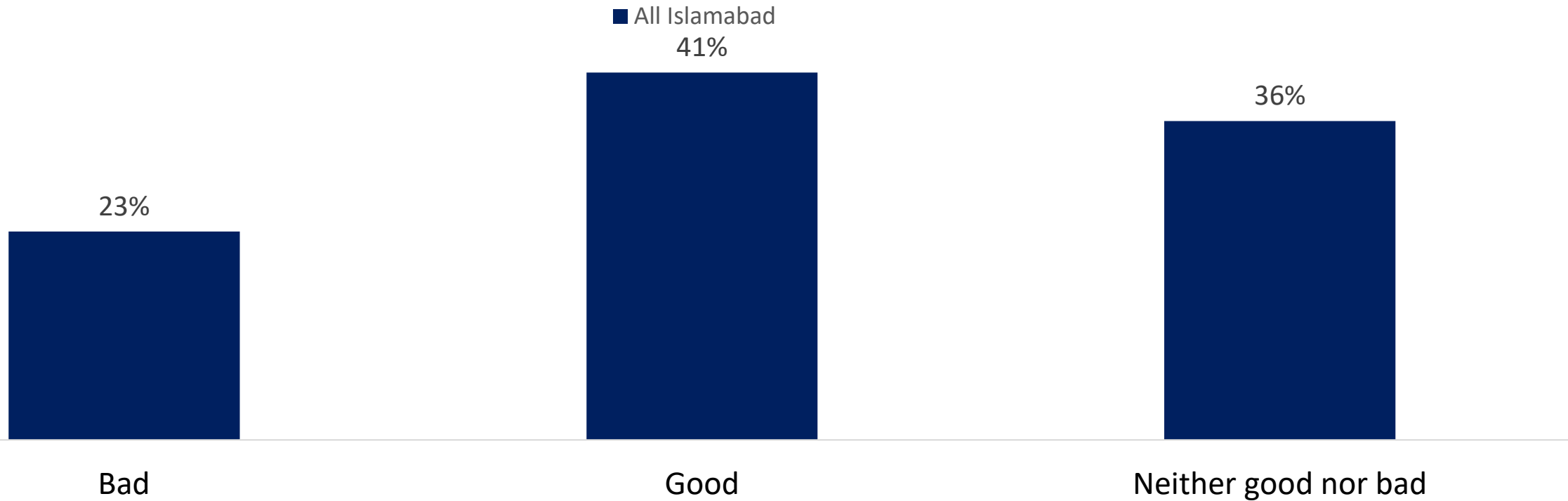

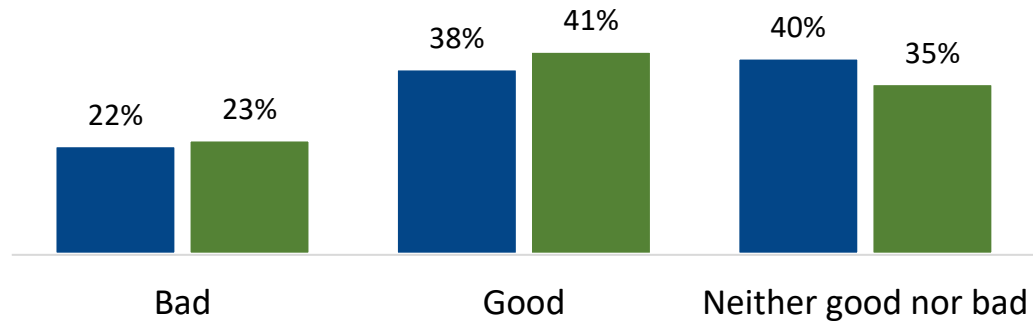

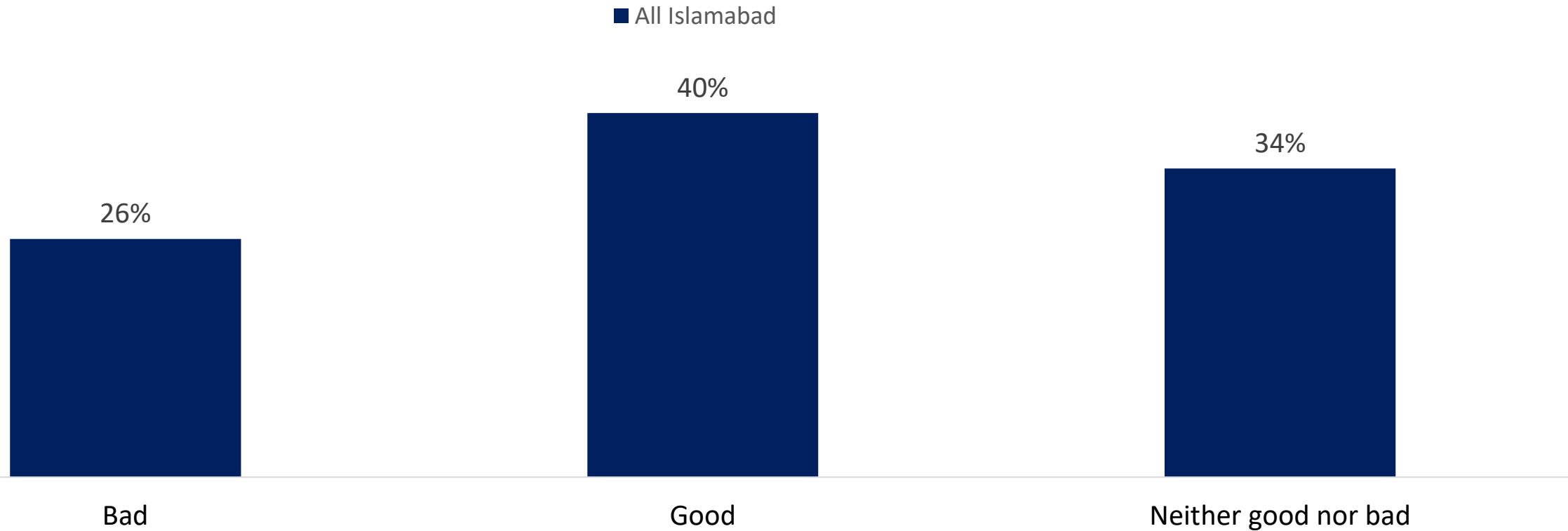

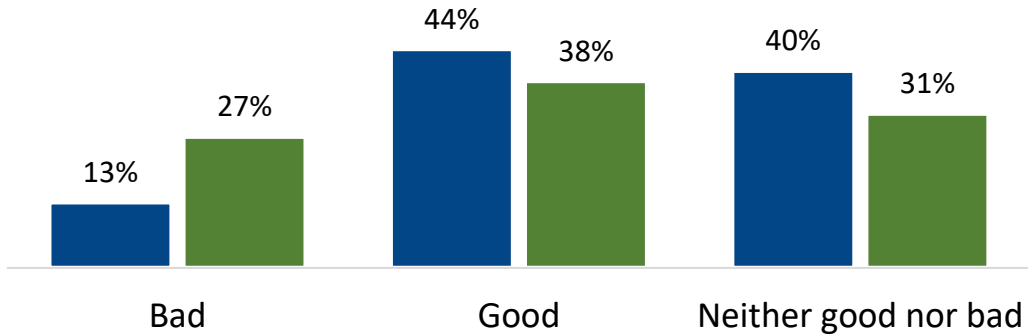

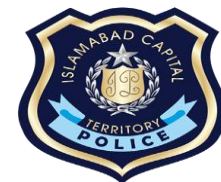

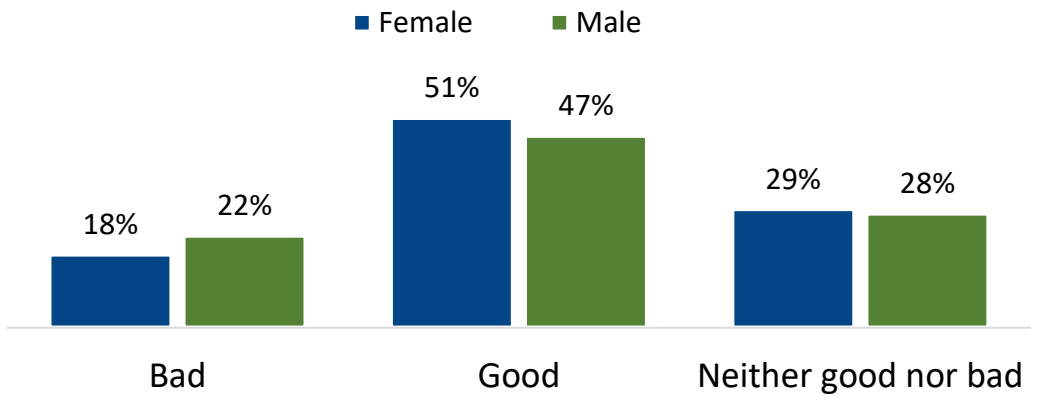

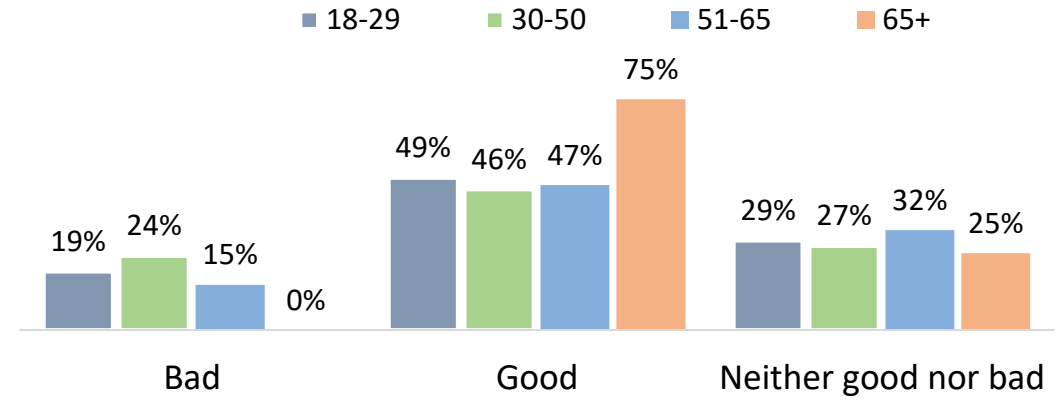

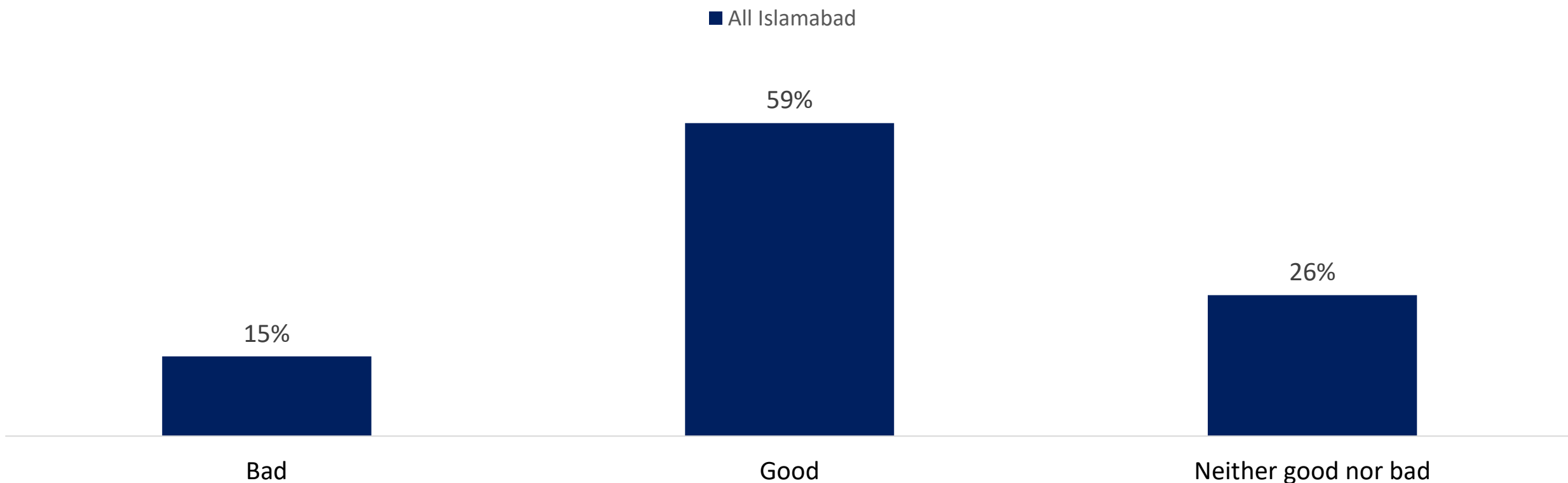

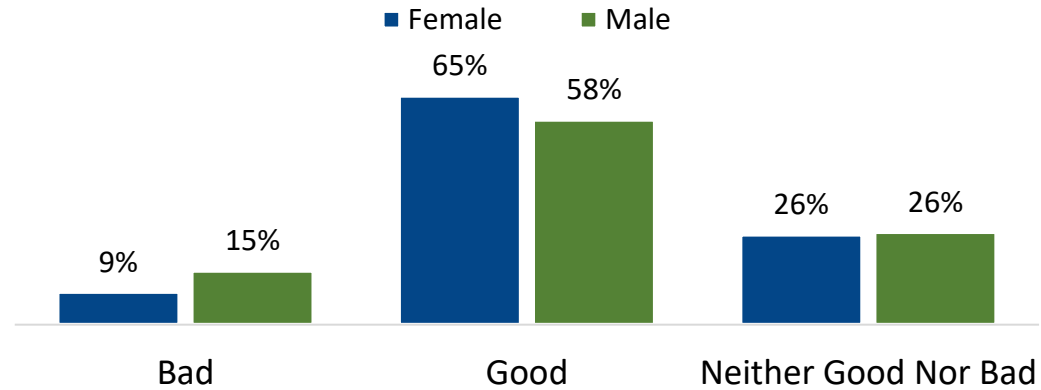

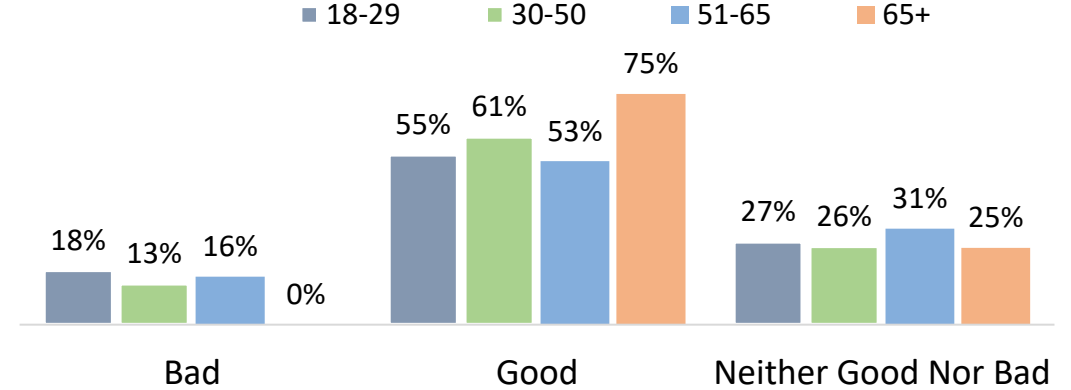

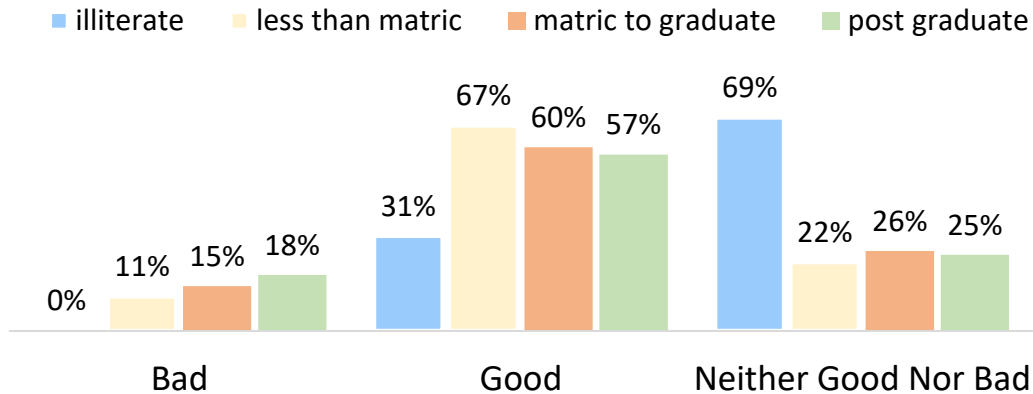

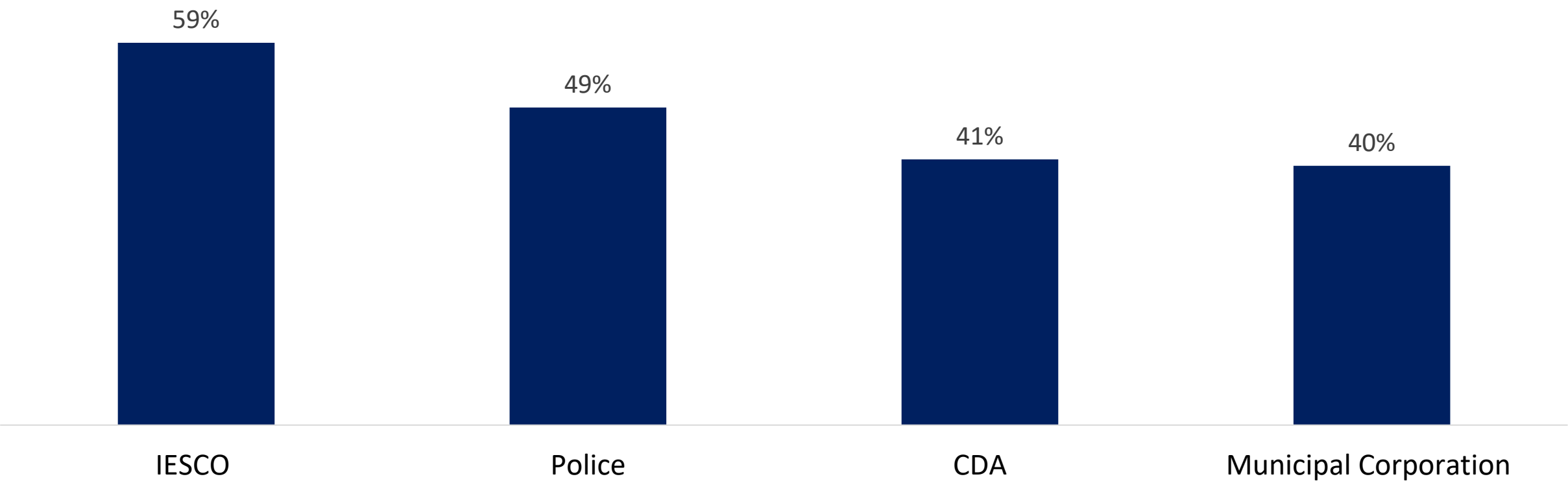

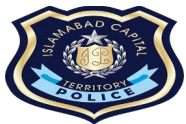

Question: In your opinion, how will you rate the performance of the following institutions? - Good



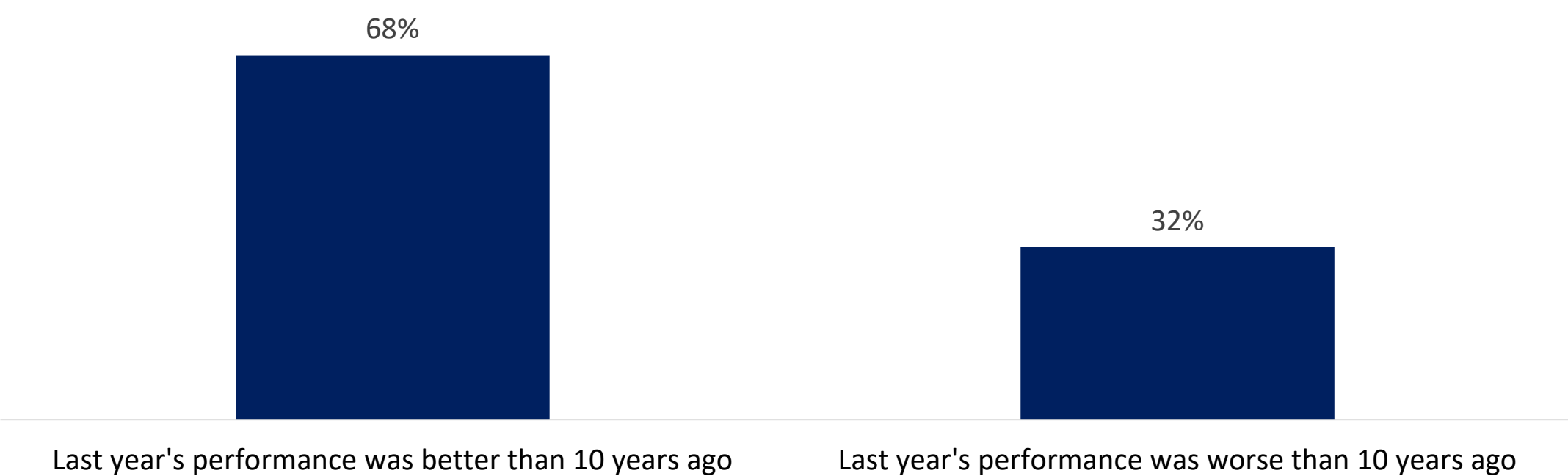

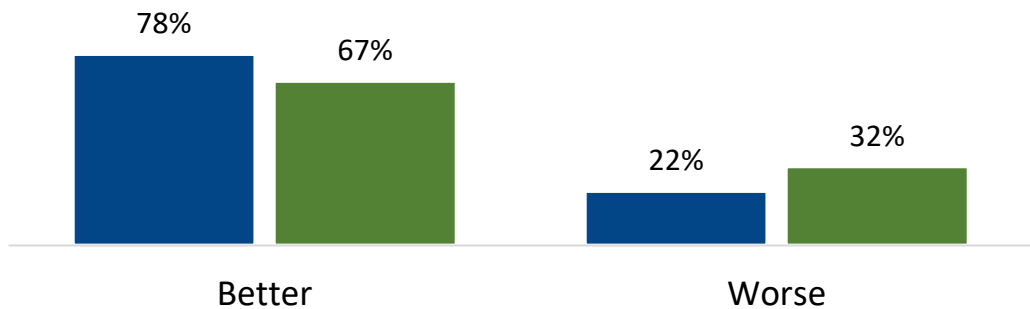

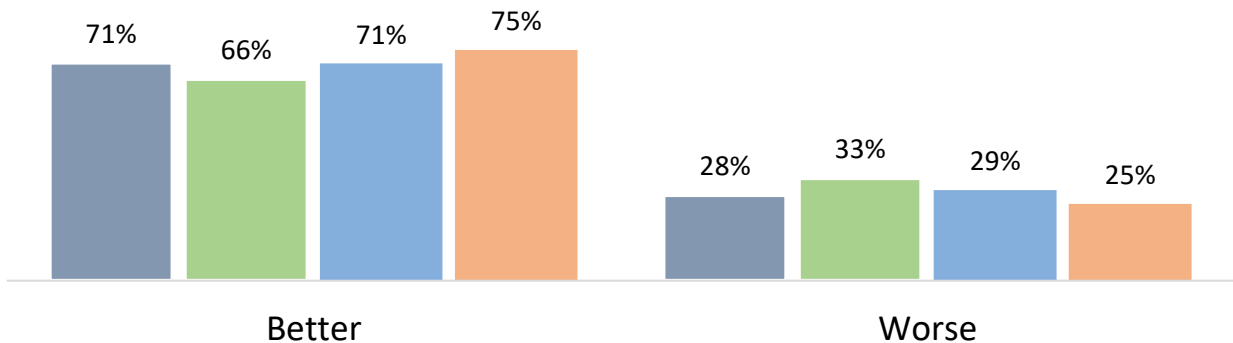

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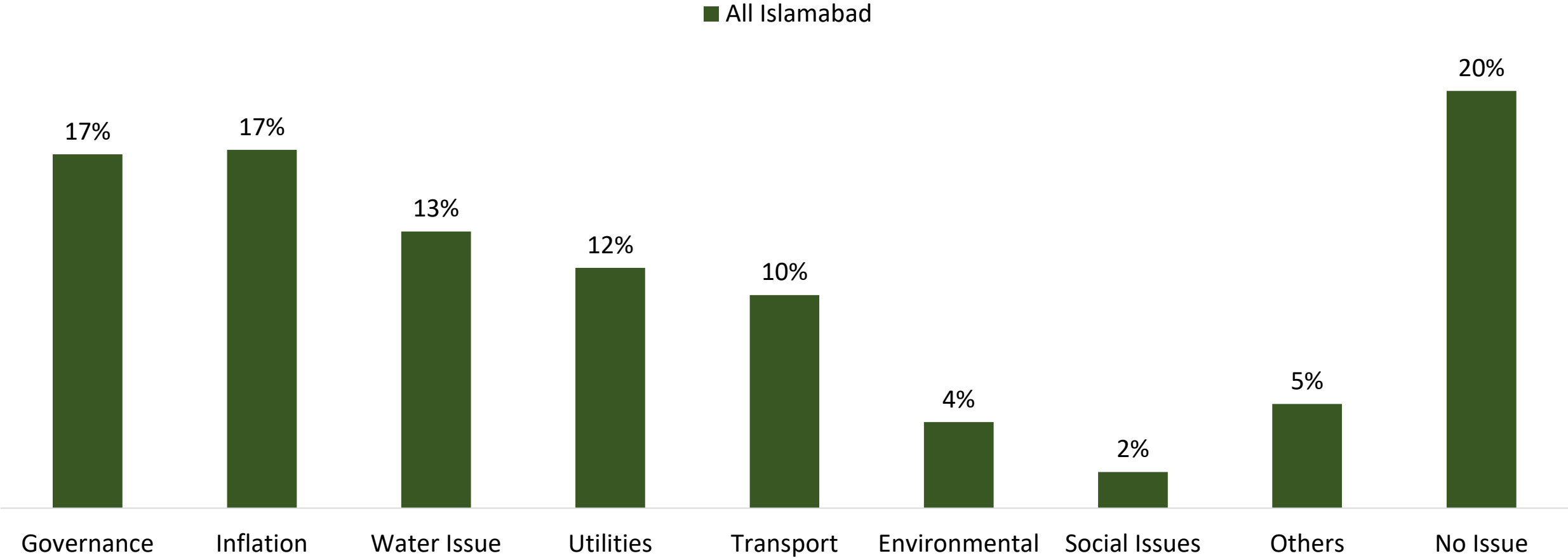

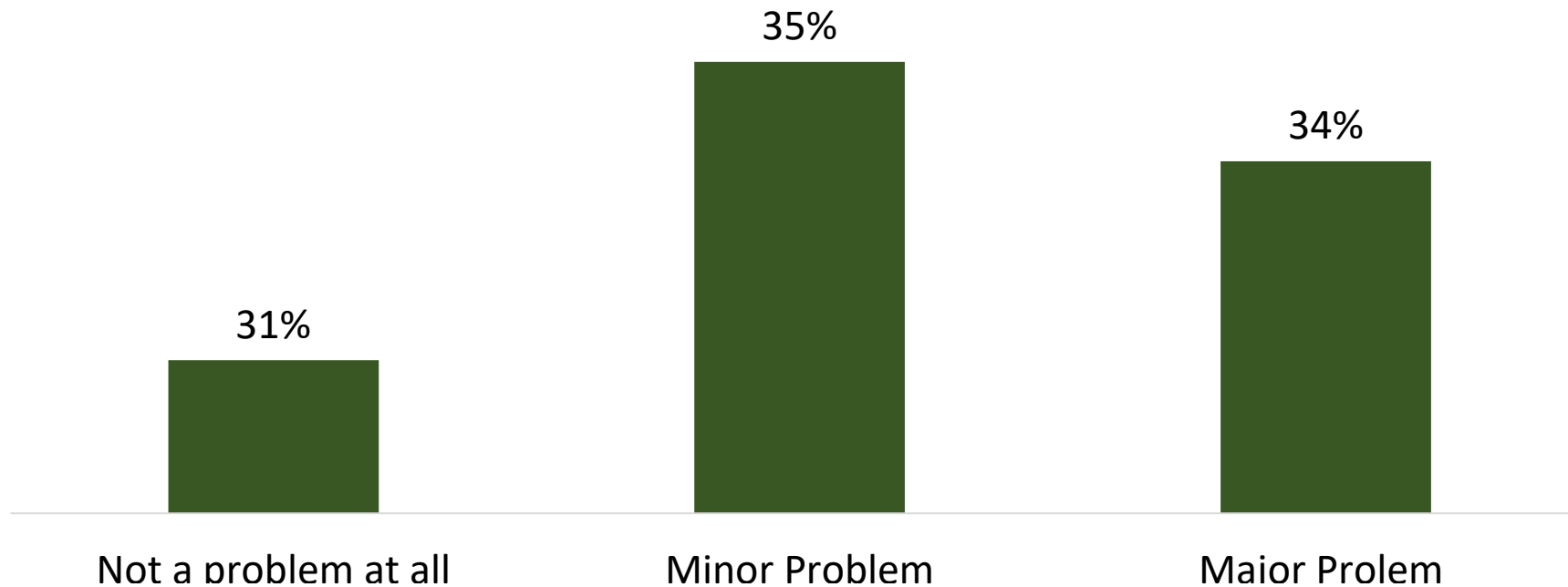
Question: What is the biggest problem that Islamabad faces?

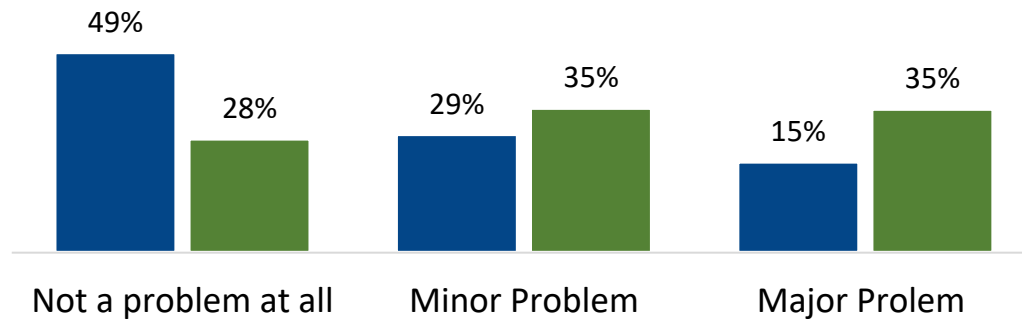

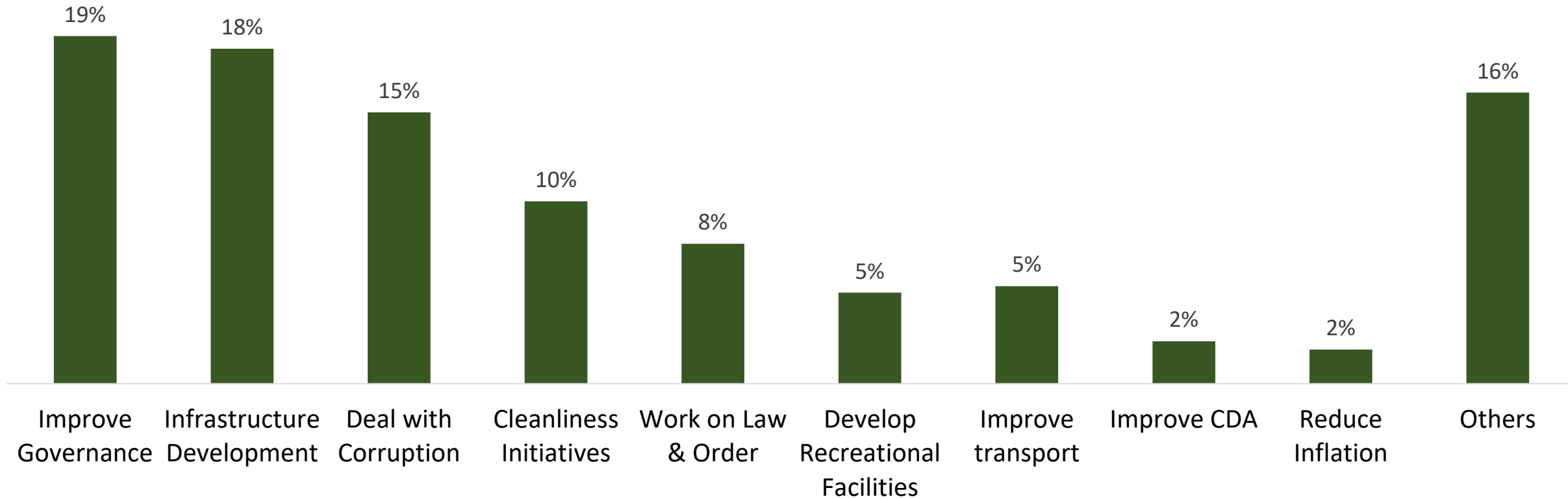

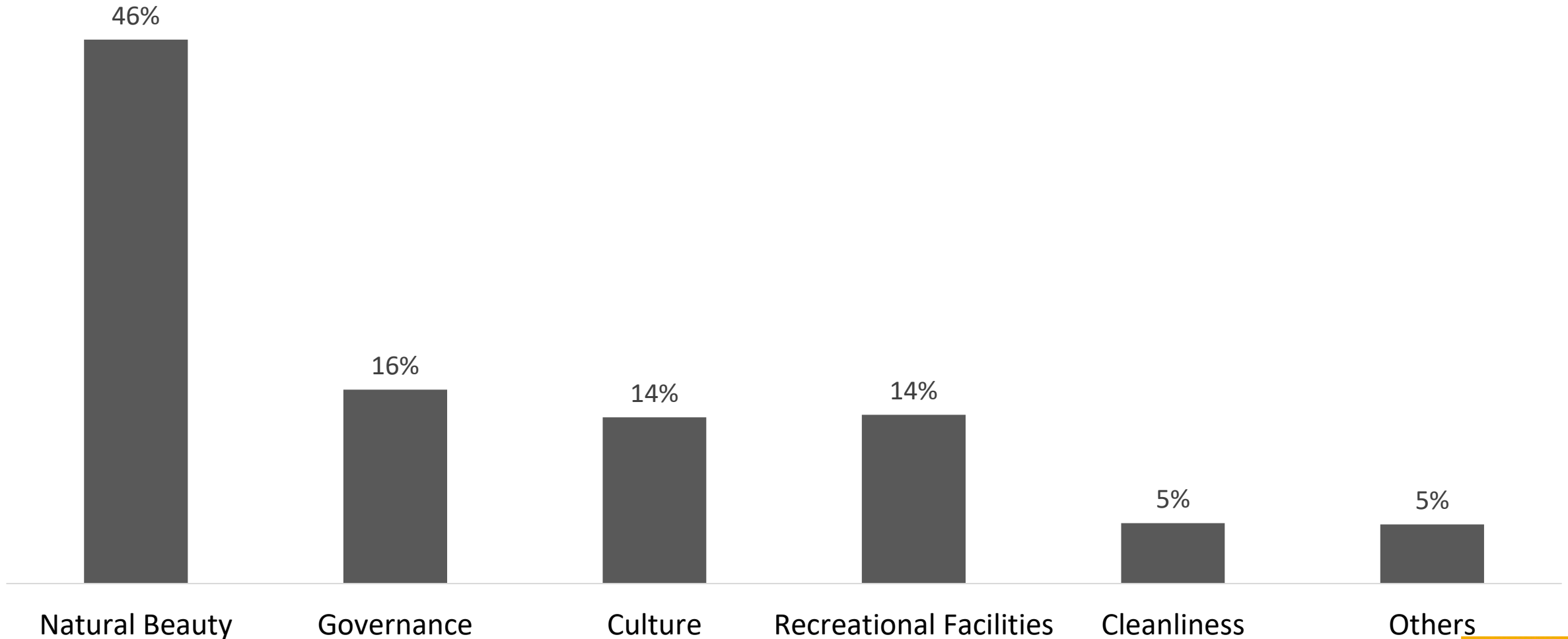

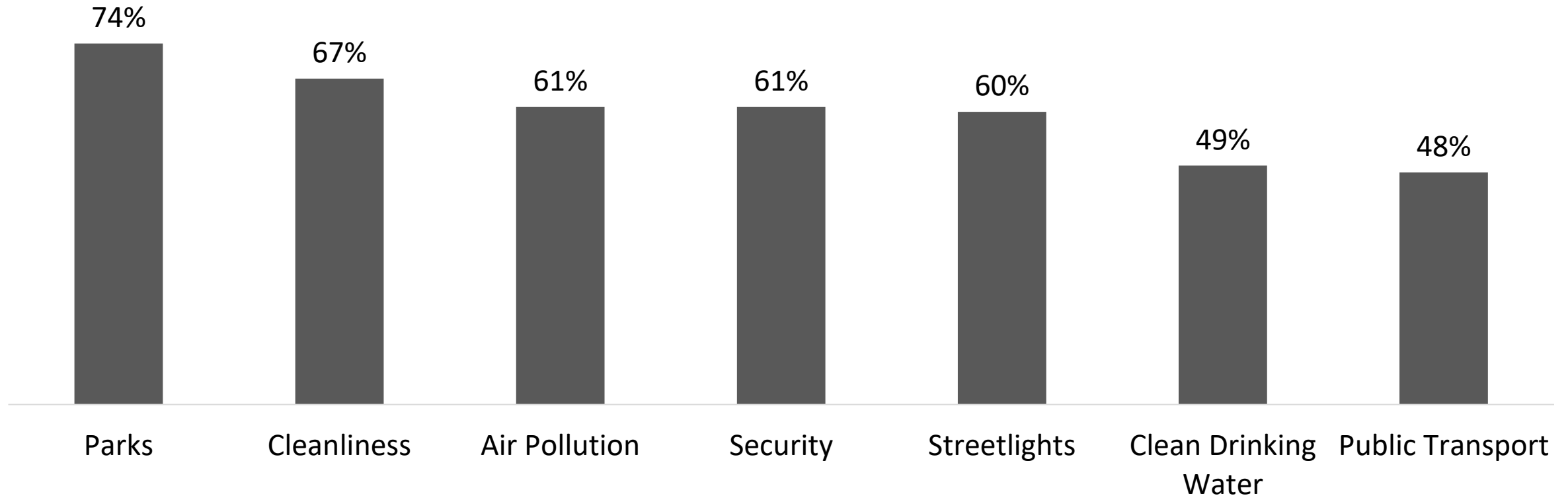

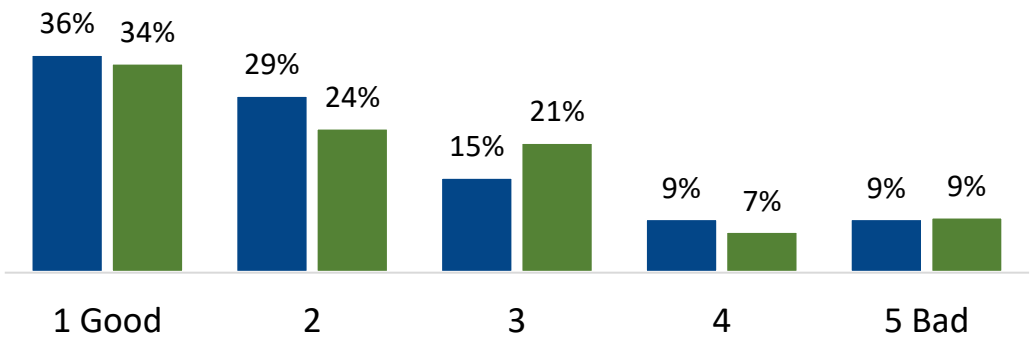

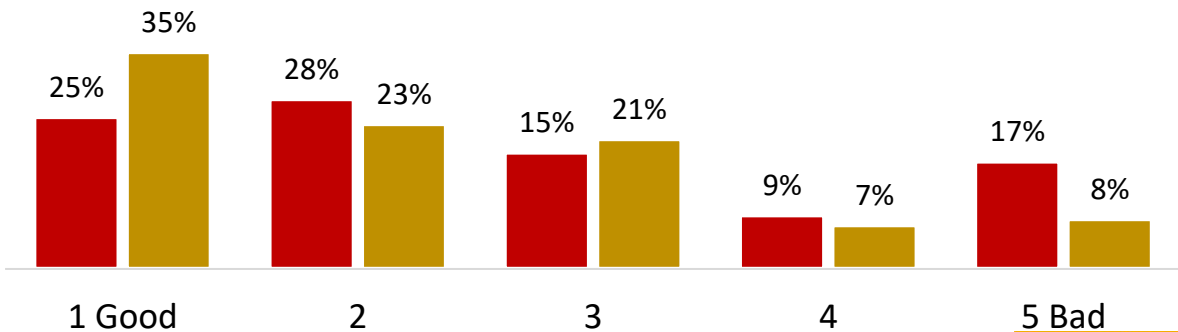

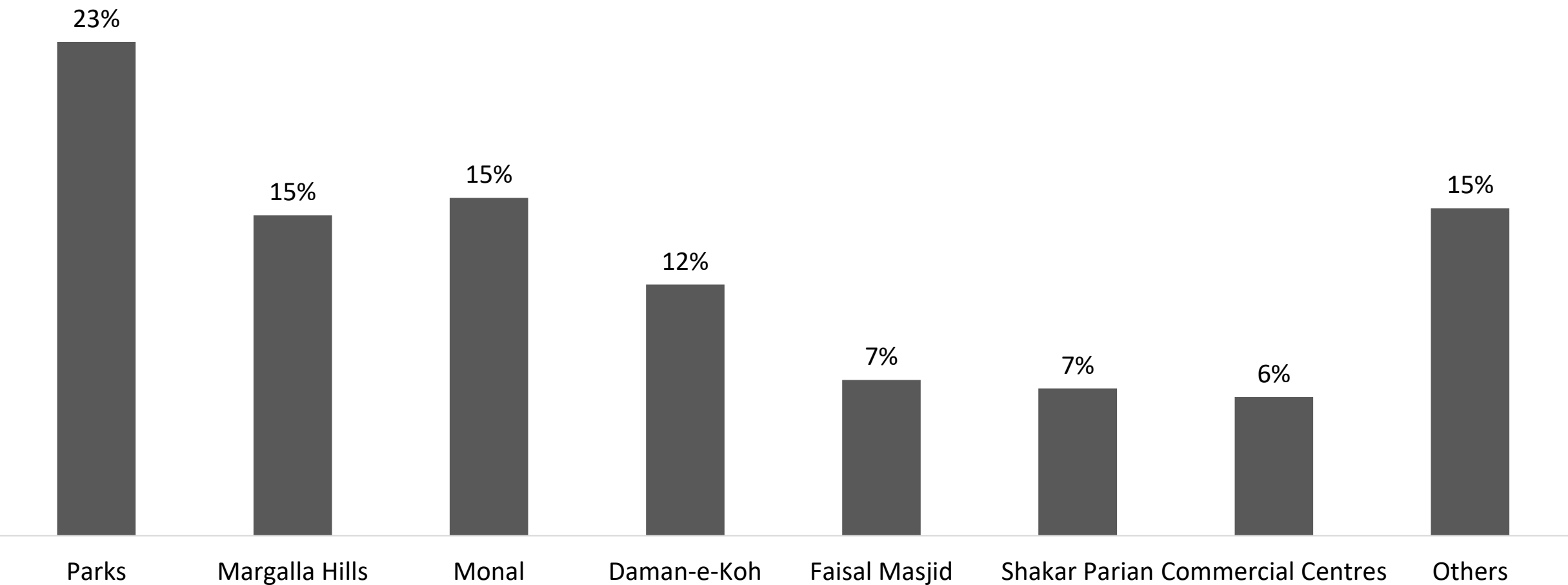

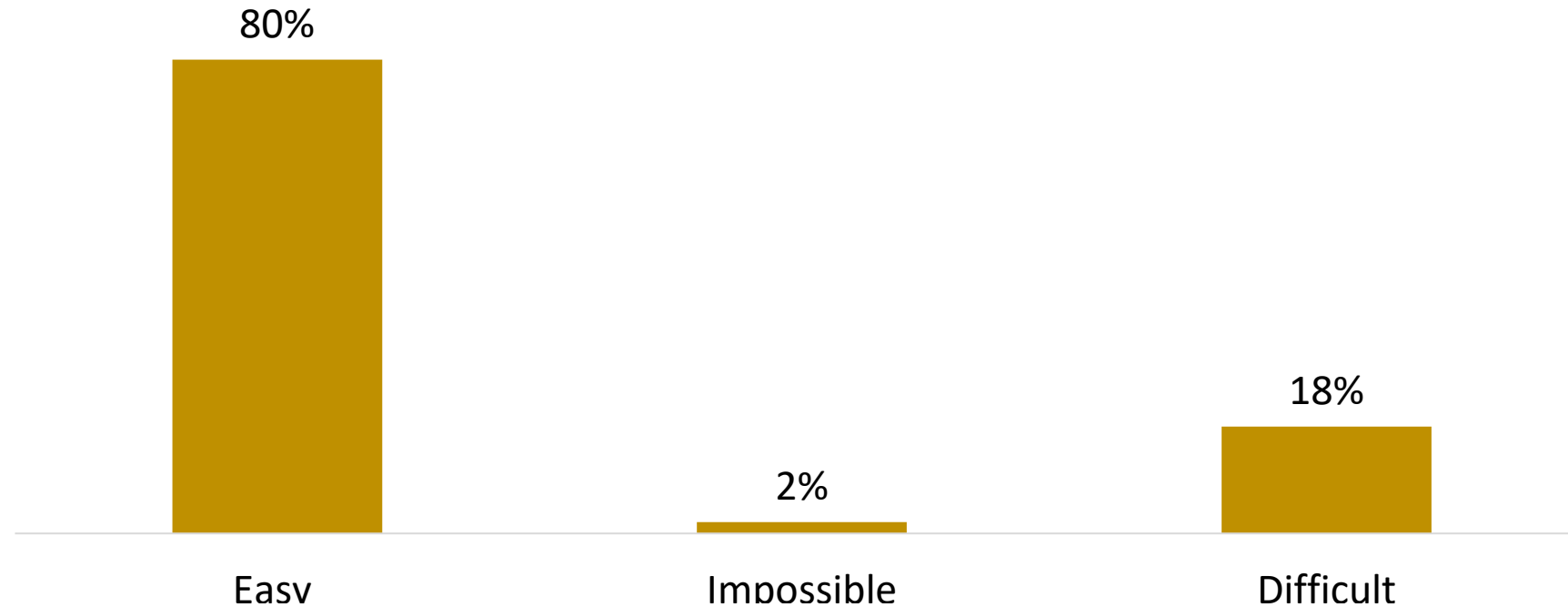

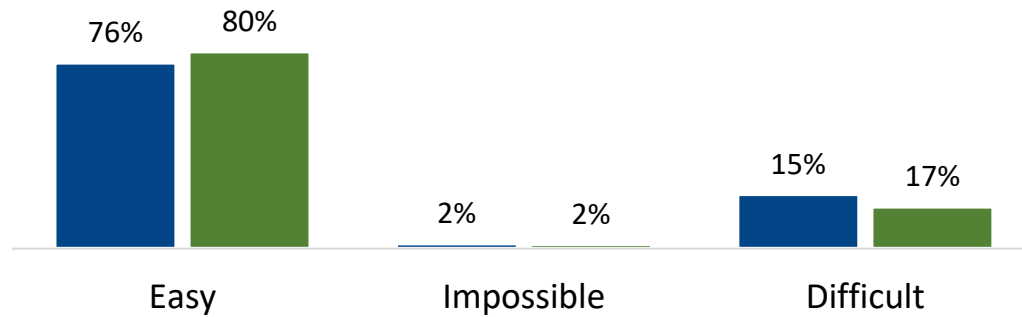

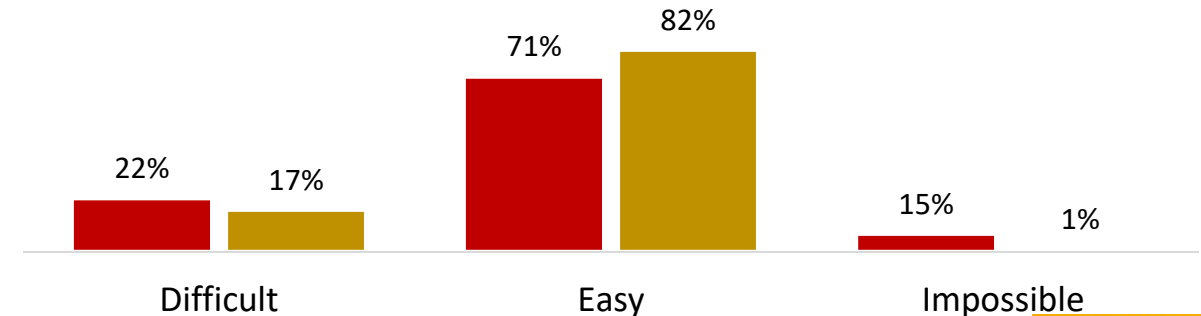

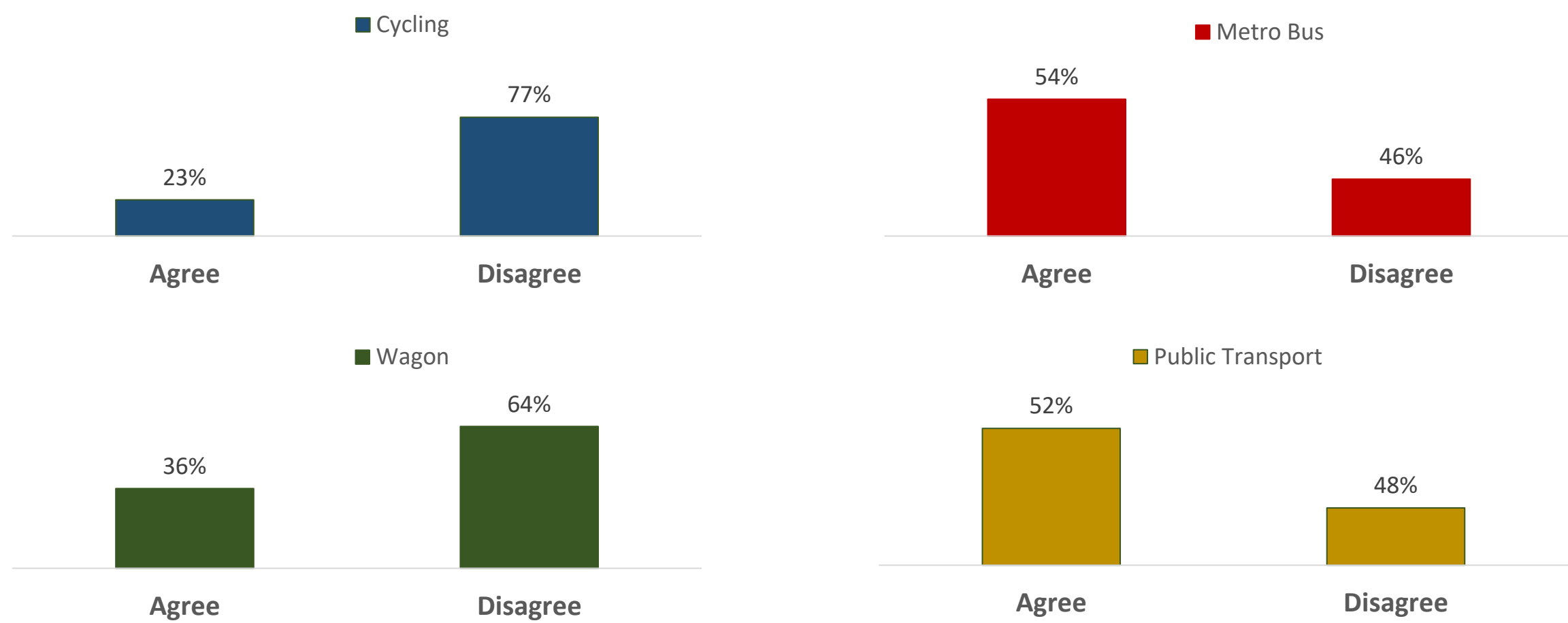

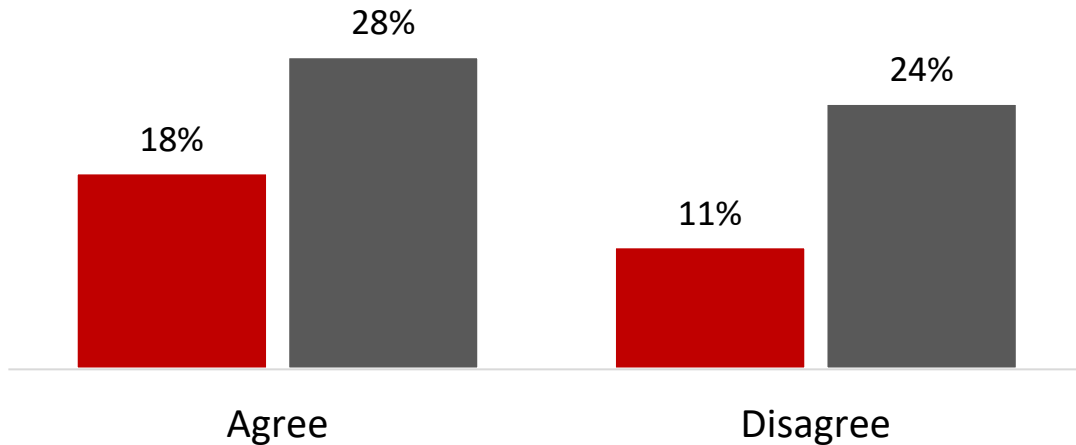

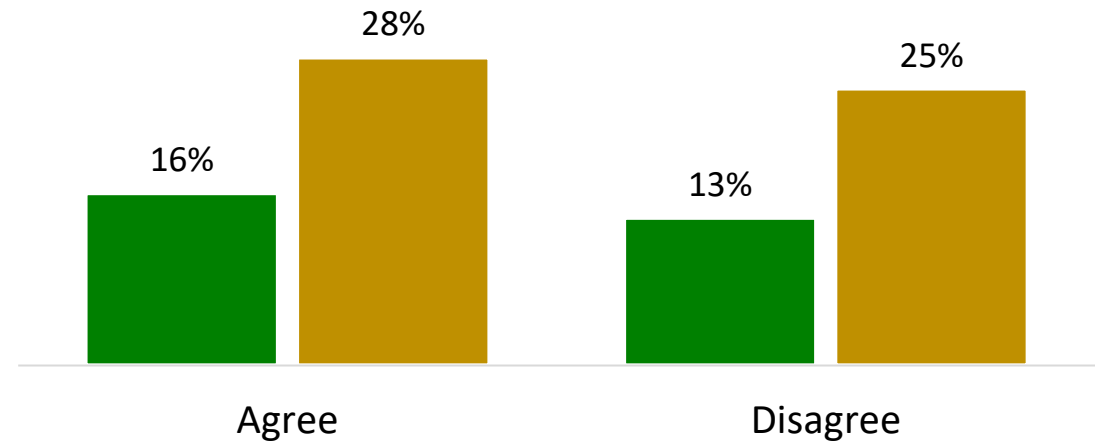

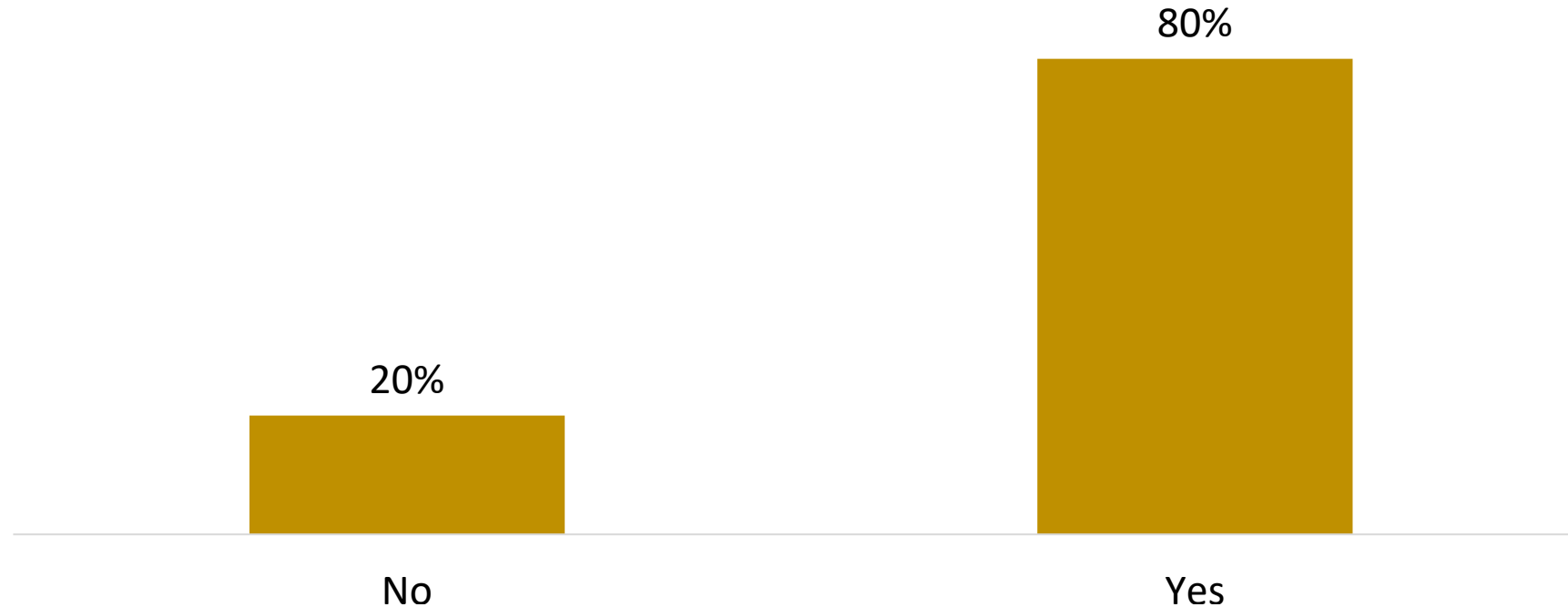

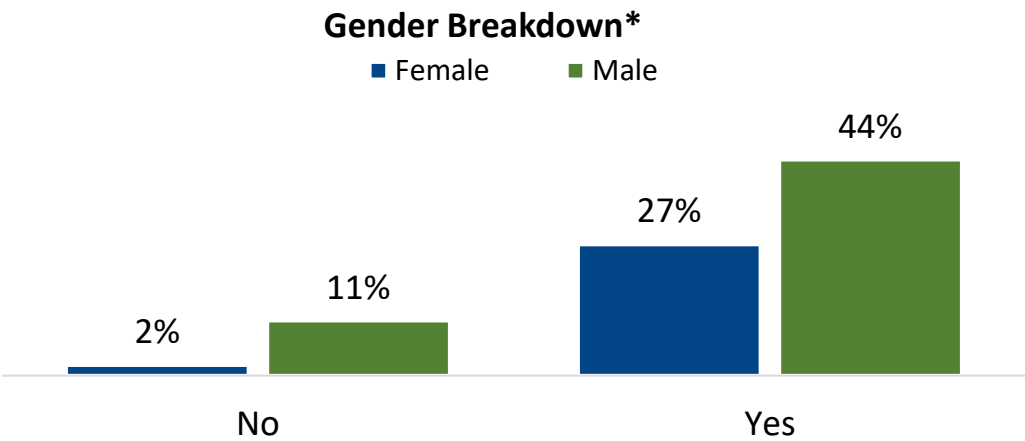

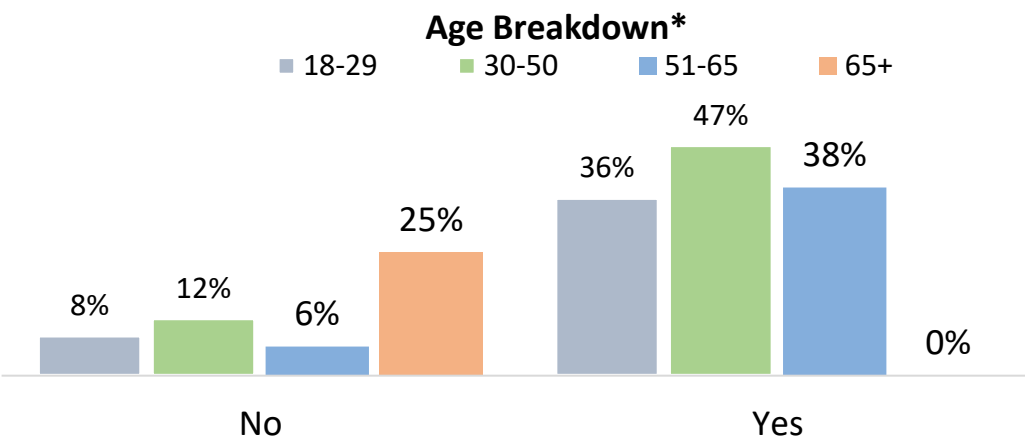

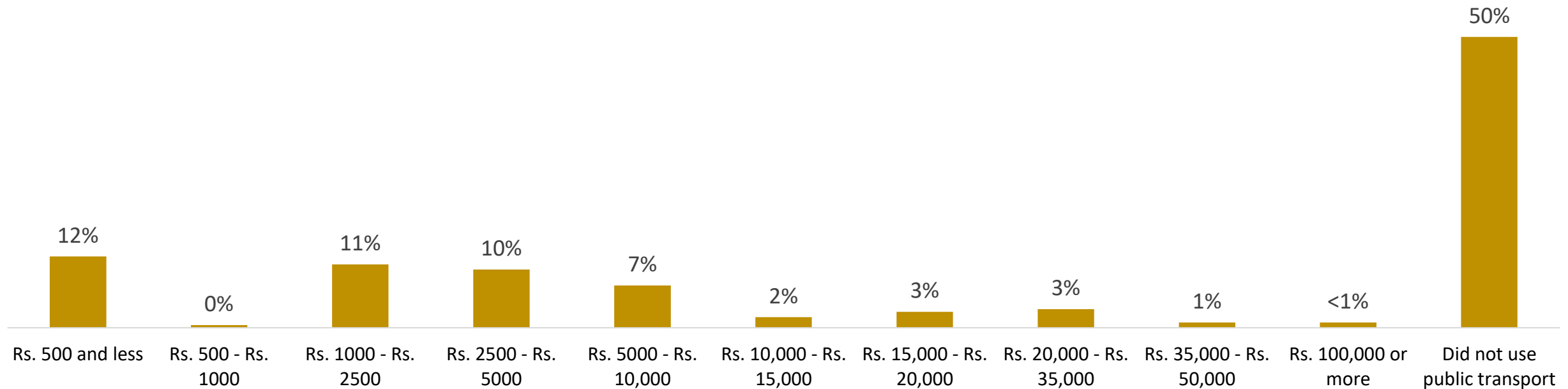

Detailed Note on Methodology

Gallup Pakistan's usual approach of fieldwork is conducting face-to-face interviews in households using geographical sampling. The sampling is done using the census as the frame. Due to coronavirus lockdown, as well as health and safety concerns, we have halted all face-to-face interviews, therefore CATI methodology has been employed.

This methodology uses Random Digit Dialling approach where all mobile phone numbers in Pakistan (130 million active sims) are the universe.

Exclusion in sample: According to PSLM (a government survey), 90% of households in Pakistan claim someone in their household owns a mobile phone. This means that 10% households are excluded from the sample.

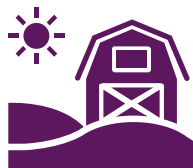

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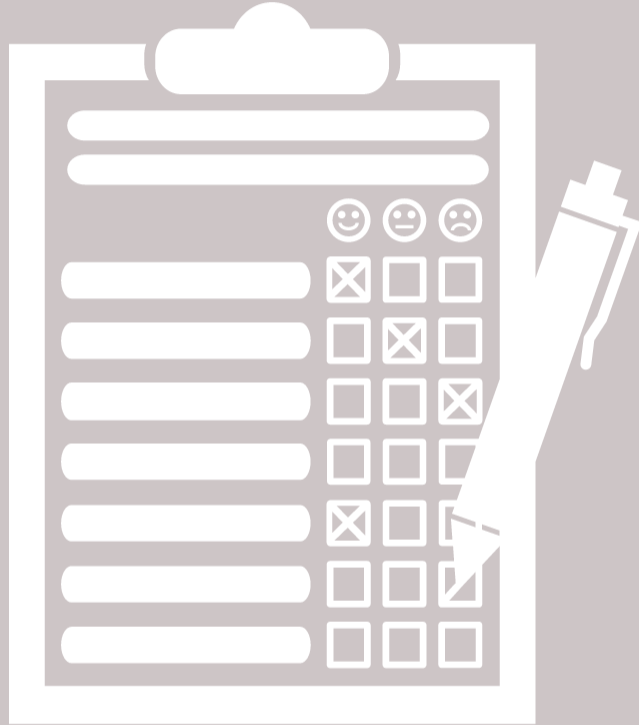
