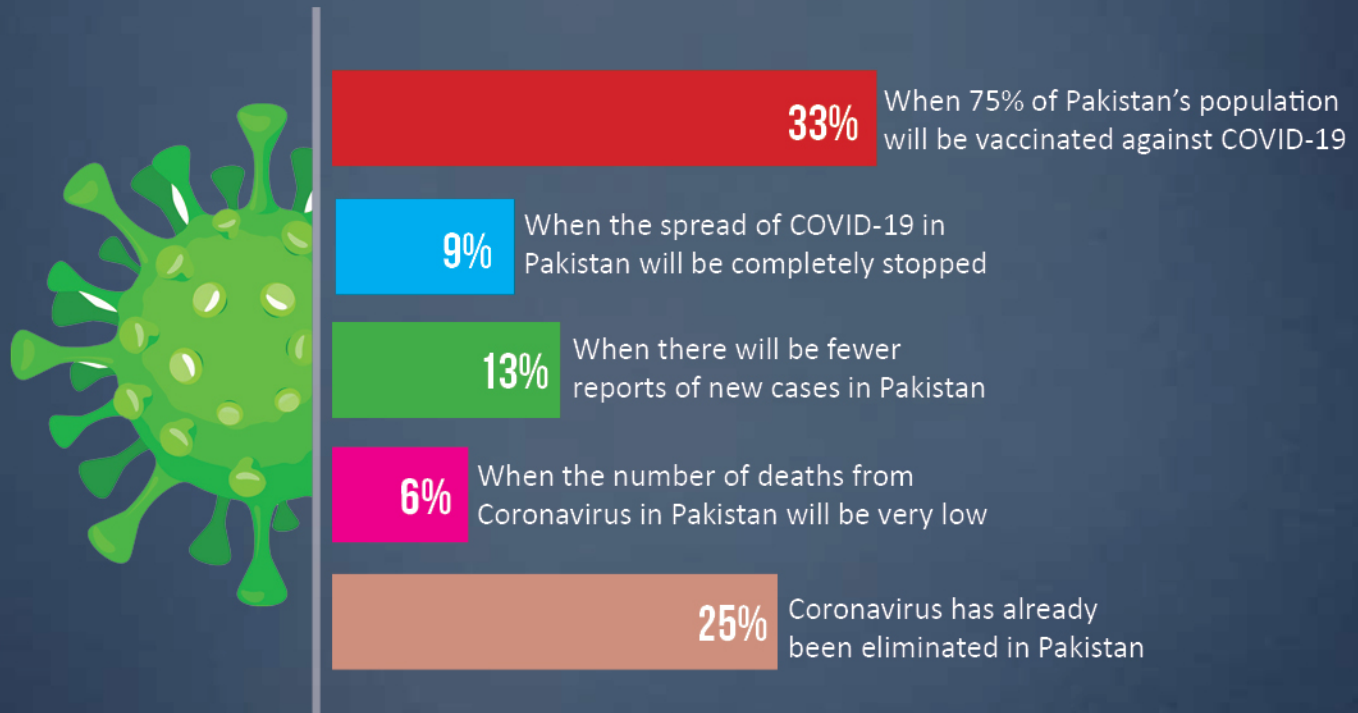

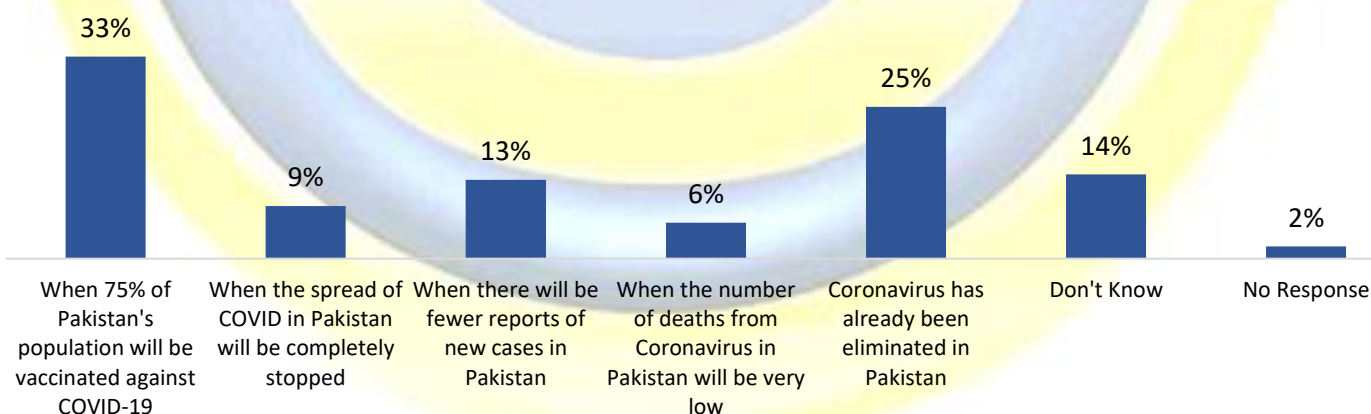
According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 25% of Pakistanis believe that Coronavirus has already been eliminated in Pakistan.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, “Which of the following do you think would indicate that the COVID-19 disease is coming to an end?” In response to this question, 33% said when 75% of Pakistan’s population will be vaccinated against COVID-19, 9% said when the spread of COVID-19 in Pakistan will be completely stopped, 13% said when there will be fewer reports of new cases in Pakistan, 6% said when the number of deaths from Coronavirus in Pakistan will be very low, 25% said Coronavirus has already been eliminated in Pakistan, 14% said don’t know and 2% gave no response.

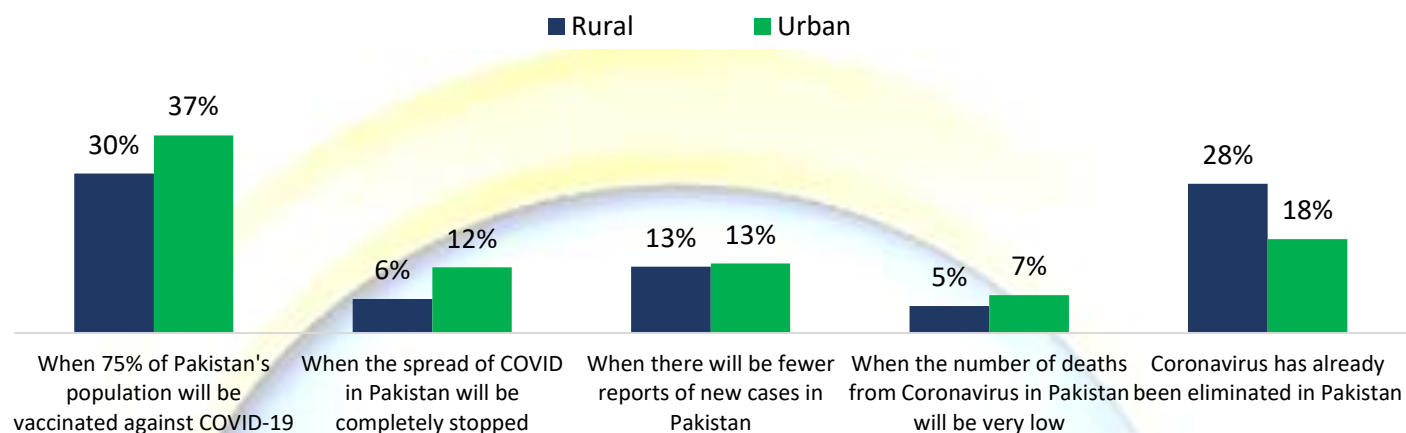

Rural-Urban Breakdown

More people from rural areas (28%) believe that COVID-19 has been eliminated in Pakistan and are likely the ones who would be requiring more consistent advocacy to follow SOPs.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1865 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, from December 22, 2021 - January 15, 2022. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was CATI.
