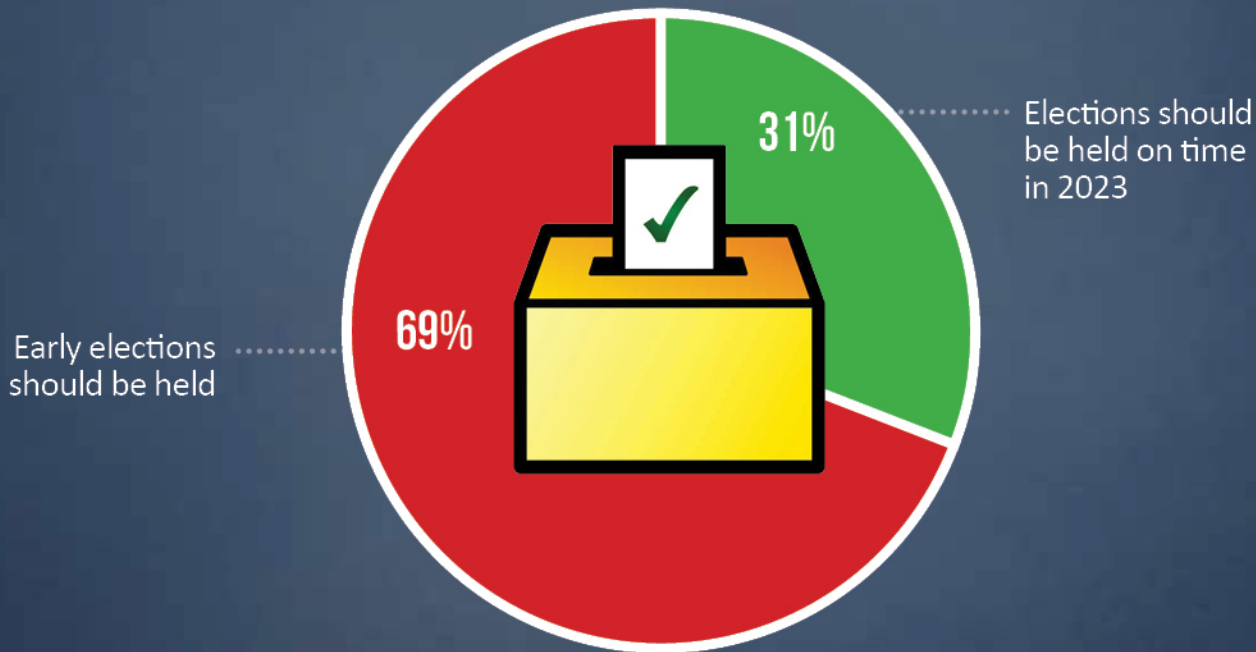

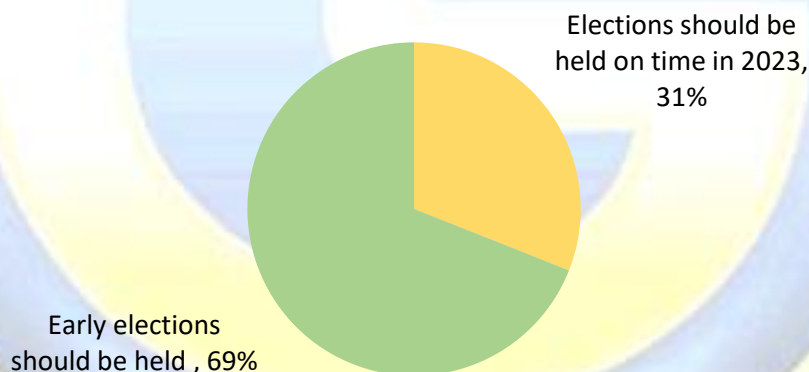

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 7 in 10 Pakistanis (69%) believe early elections should be held; a sweeping 78% in KPK want early elections for new voters.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four provinces was asked the following question, *“Some people think that early elections should be held in the country. While others think that elections should be held on time i.e., in 2023. What is your opinion?”* In response to this question, 69% said early elections should be held while 31% said elections should be held on time in 2023.

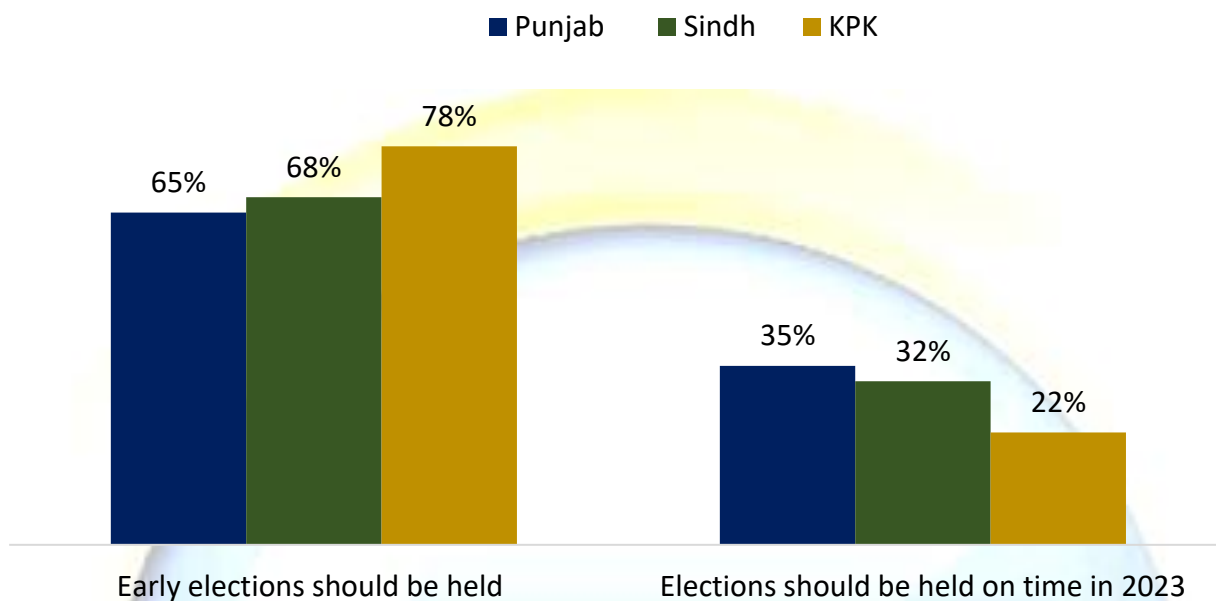

Provincial Breakdown

The call for early elections is highest in KP where a sweeping 78% want early elections for new voters.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, from April 10-11th, 2022. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was CATI.
