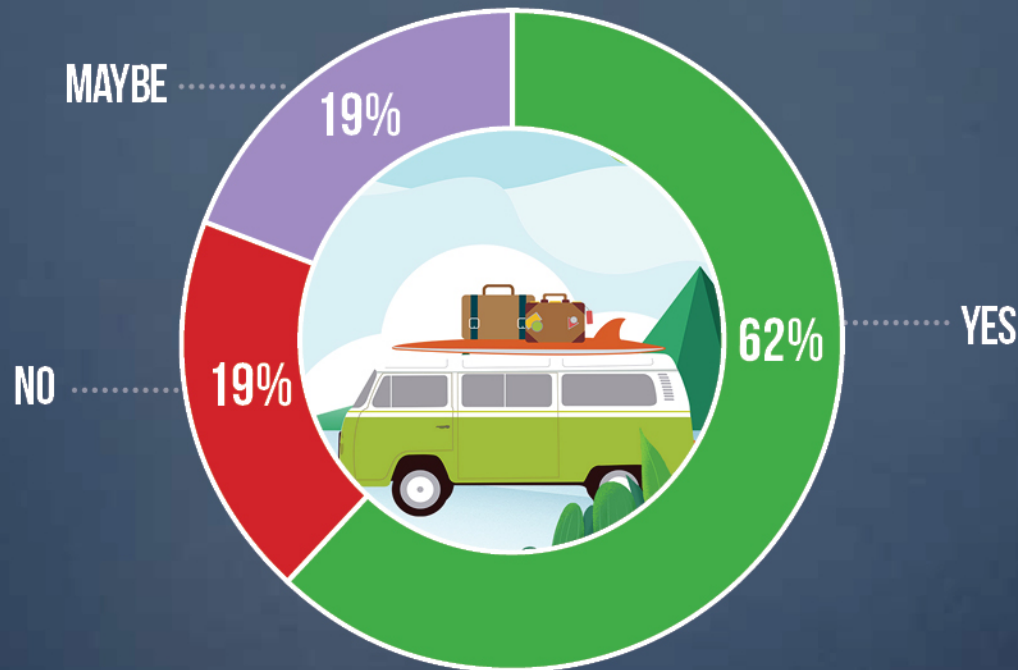

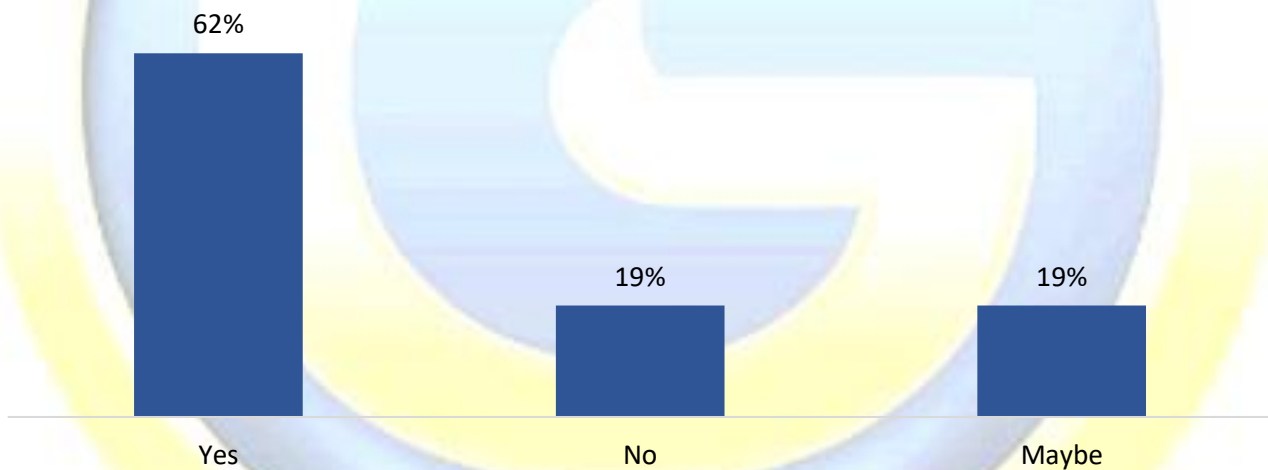

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 3 in 5 (62%) Pakistanis believe that traveling domestically is worth the money.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across Pakistan was asked the following question, *“Do you feel traveling domestically is worth the money?”*. In response to this question, 62% said yes, 19% said no and 19% said maybe.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 856 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country in 2020. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was CATI.
