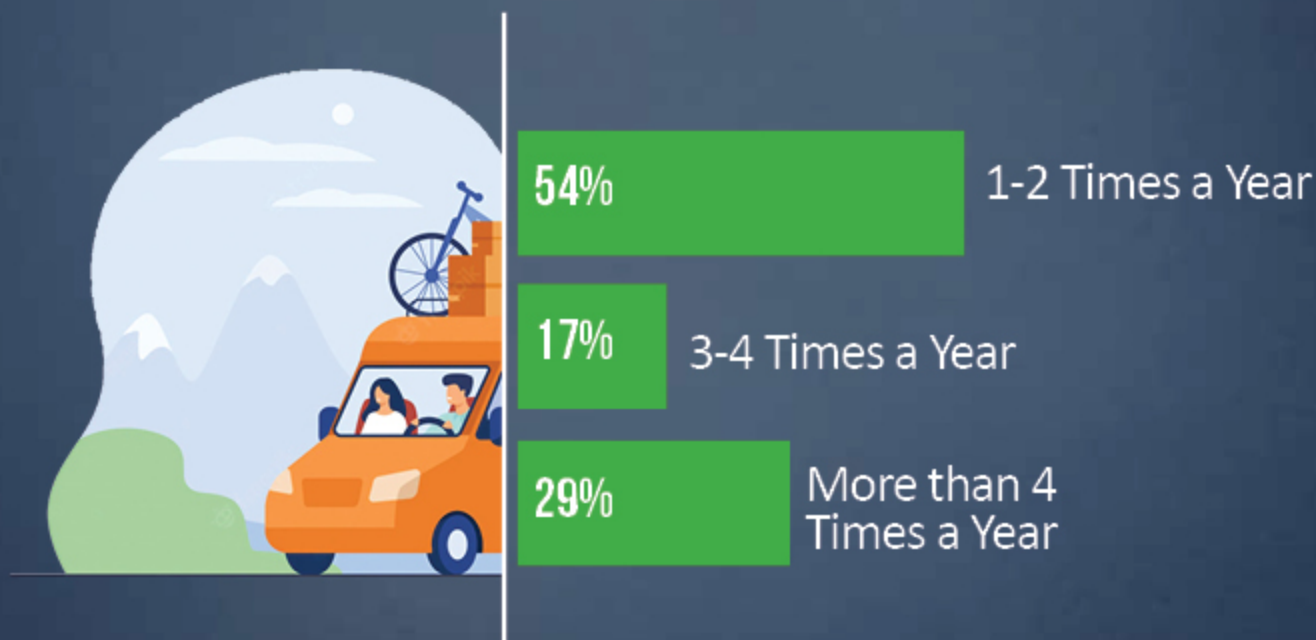

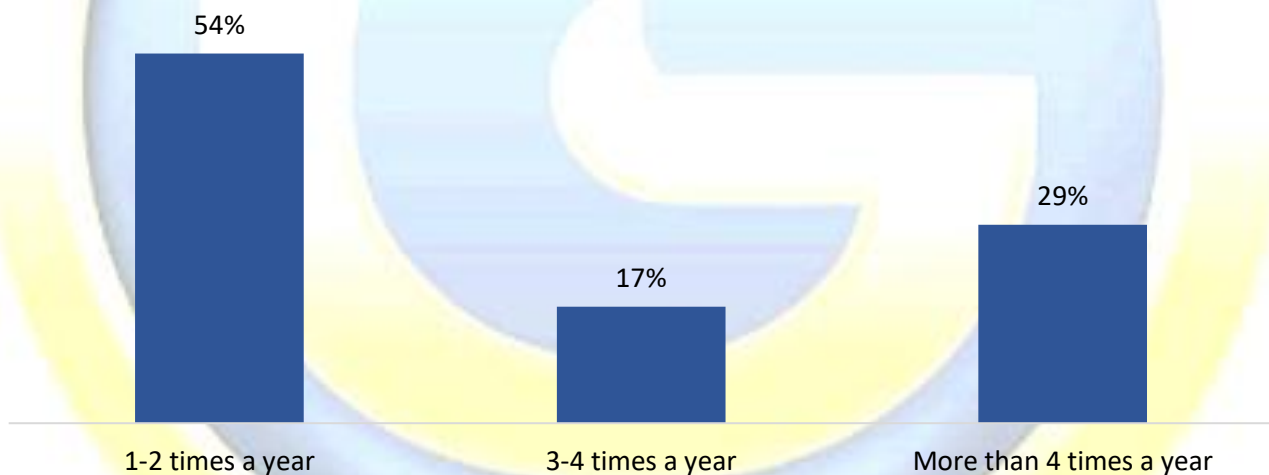

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, more than half (54%) of Pakistanis travel 1-2 times a year within Pakistan.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across Pakistan was asked the following question, “*How often do you travel inside Pakistan?*”. In response to this question, 54% said 1-2 times a year, 17% said 3-4 times a year and 29% said more than 4 times a year.

Question: “How often do you travel inside Pakistan?”

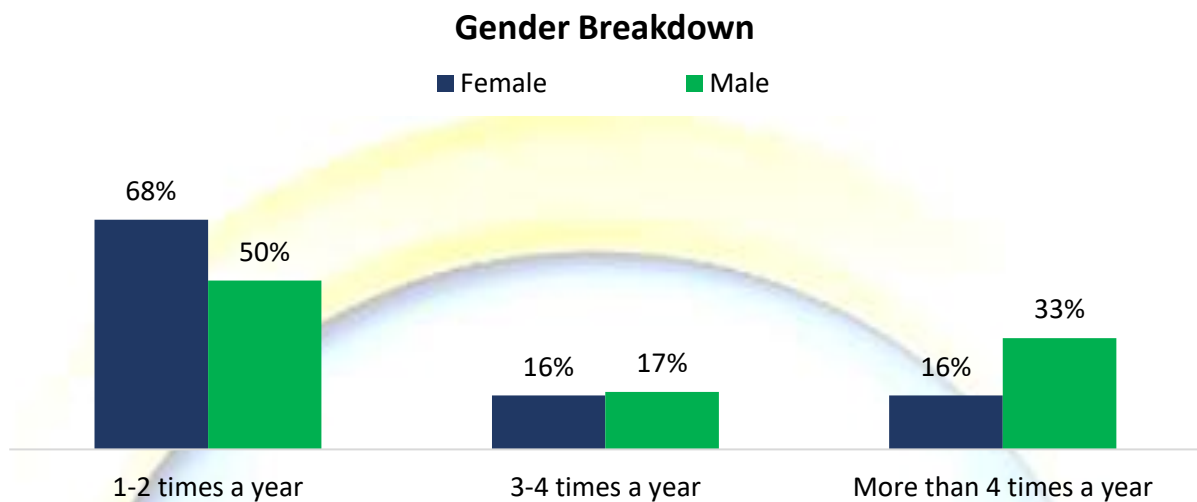
All Pakistan

Gender Breakdown

Domestic travel in Pakistan is more common among males as compared to females.



The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 856 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country in 2020. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was CATI.
