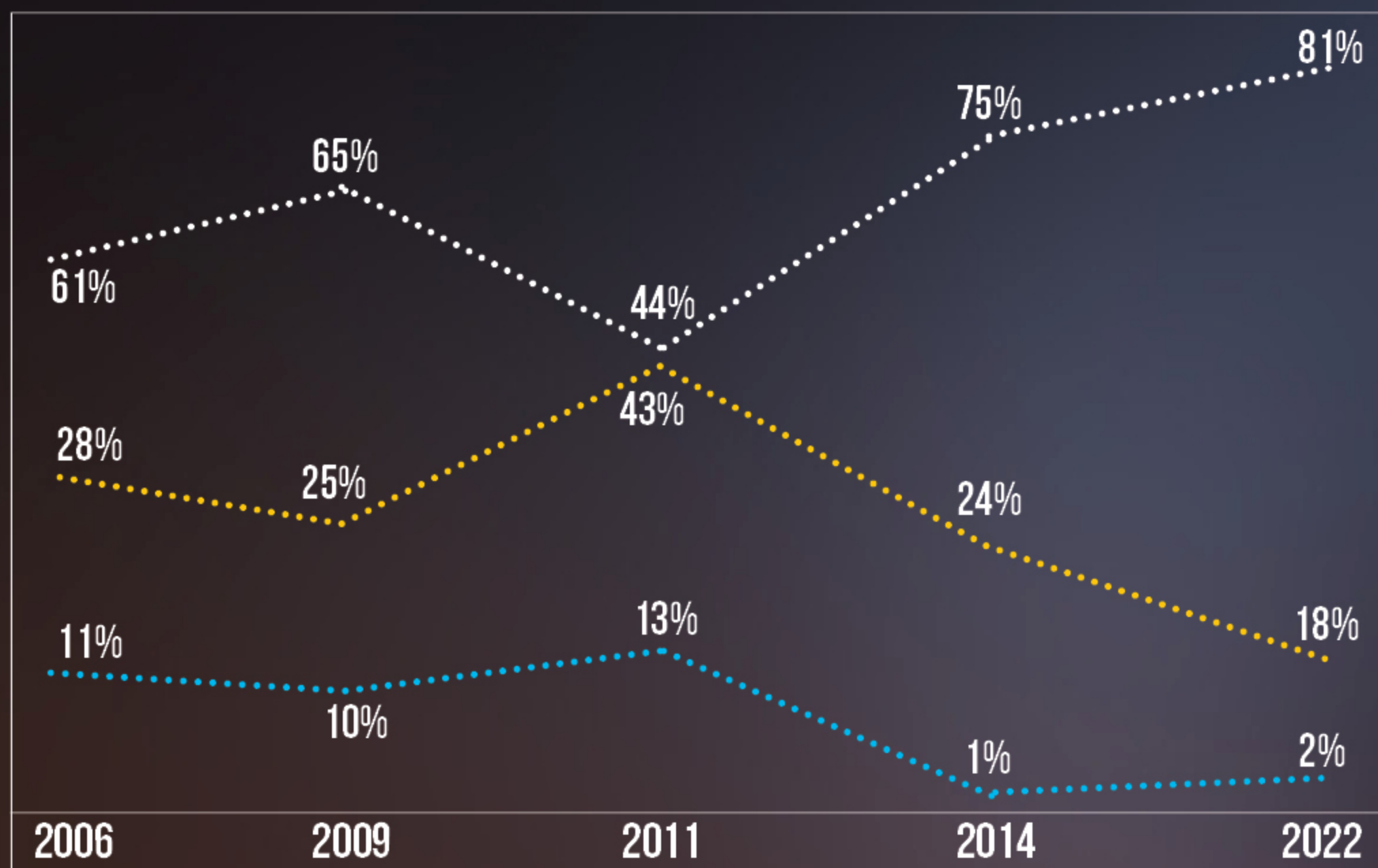


80% of respondents in 2022 compared to 61% in 2006 believe that drinking water is safe for their health in Pakistan: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan History Project

80% of respondents in 2022 compared to 61% in 2006 believe that drinking water is safe for their health in Pakistan: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan History Project

(Islamabad), May 31, 2022

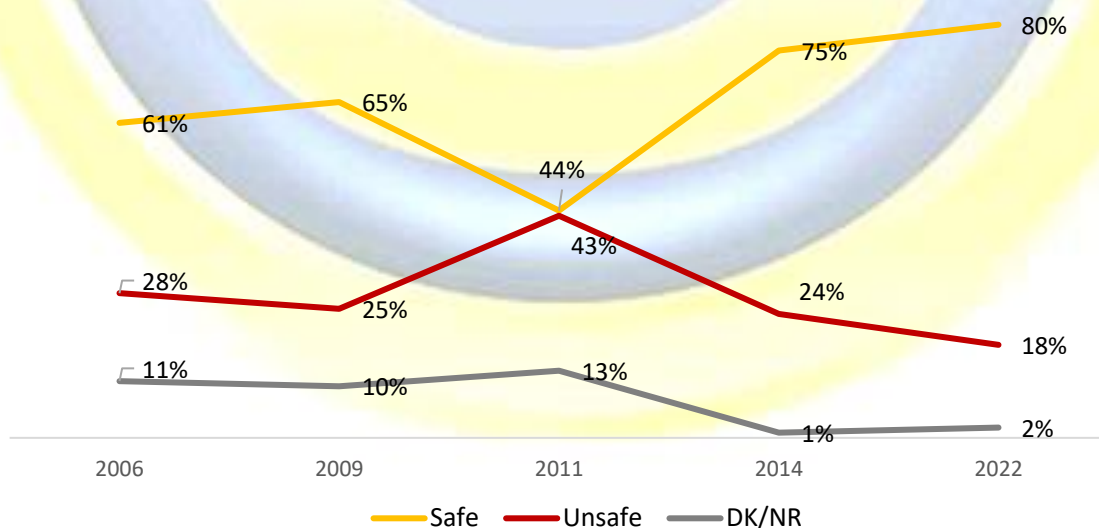
In a Gallup & Gilani Pakistan National Survey conducted in the year 2006, a representative sample of adult men and women from across Pakistan was asked the following question, “Do you think the water you use for drinking is safe or unsafe for your health?” In response to this question, 61% said it was safe, 28% said it was unsafe and 11% said don’t know or gave no response.

Comparative Picture: This question was asked again in 2022 to allow a comparison to be made across the years. In 2022, 80% said safe, 18% said unsafe and 2% didn’t know or gave no response.

Trend Analysis: 80% of respondents in 2022 compared to 61% in 2006 believe that drinking water is safe for their health in Pakistan. 2011 saw the lowest percentage (44%) of the respondents believing that drinking water was safe.
