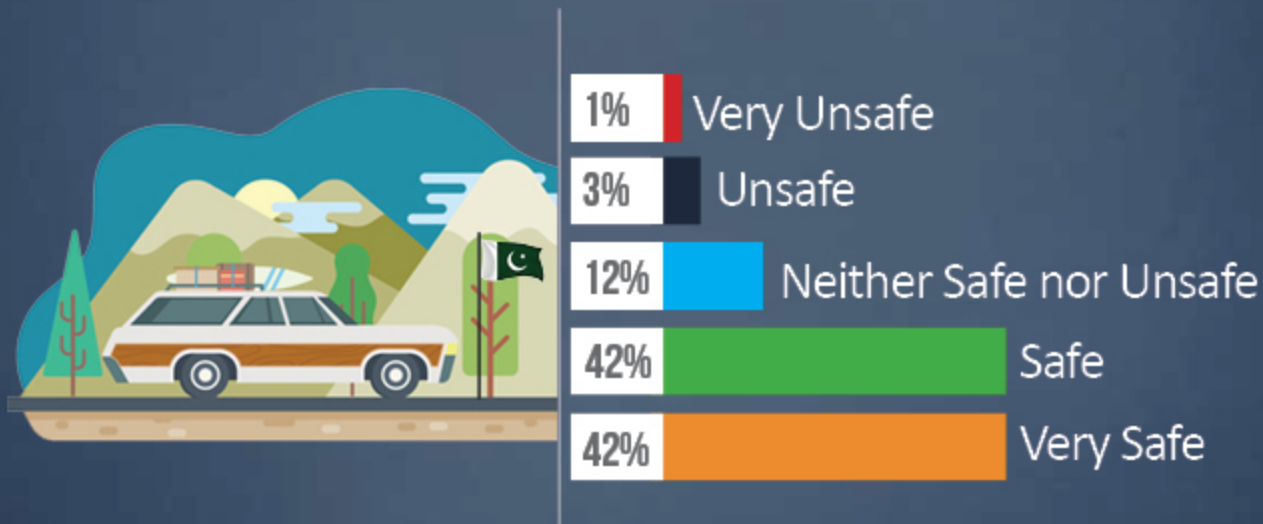

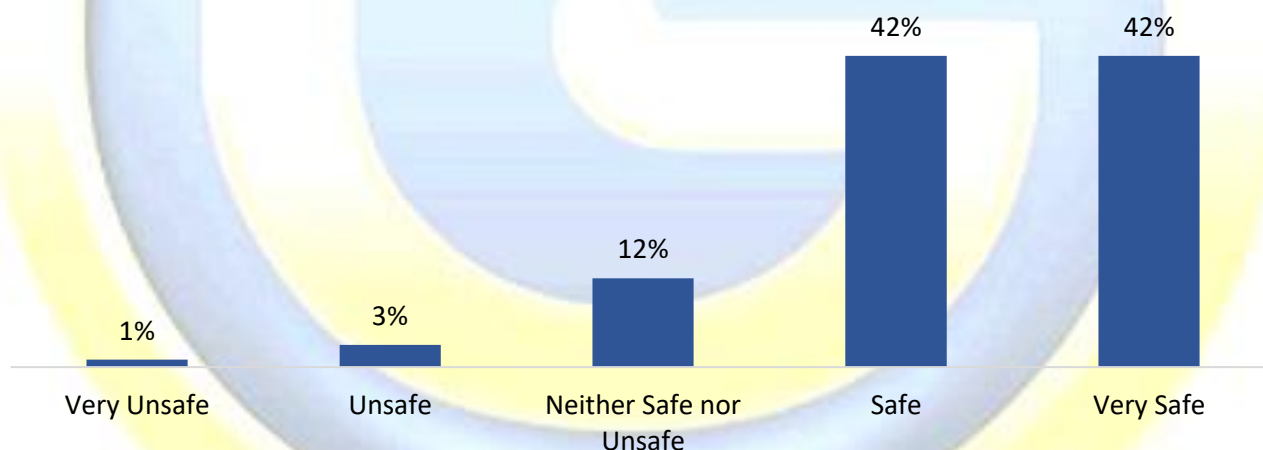

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, an overwhelming 84% of Pakistanis believe it is safe to travel within Pakistan.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across Pakistan was asked the following question, “*How safe have you generally felt when traveling inside Pakistan?*” In response to this question, % said very unsafe, 3% said unsafe, 12% said neither safe nor unsafe, 42% said safe, and 42% said very safe.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 856 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country in 2020. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was CATI.
