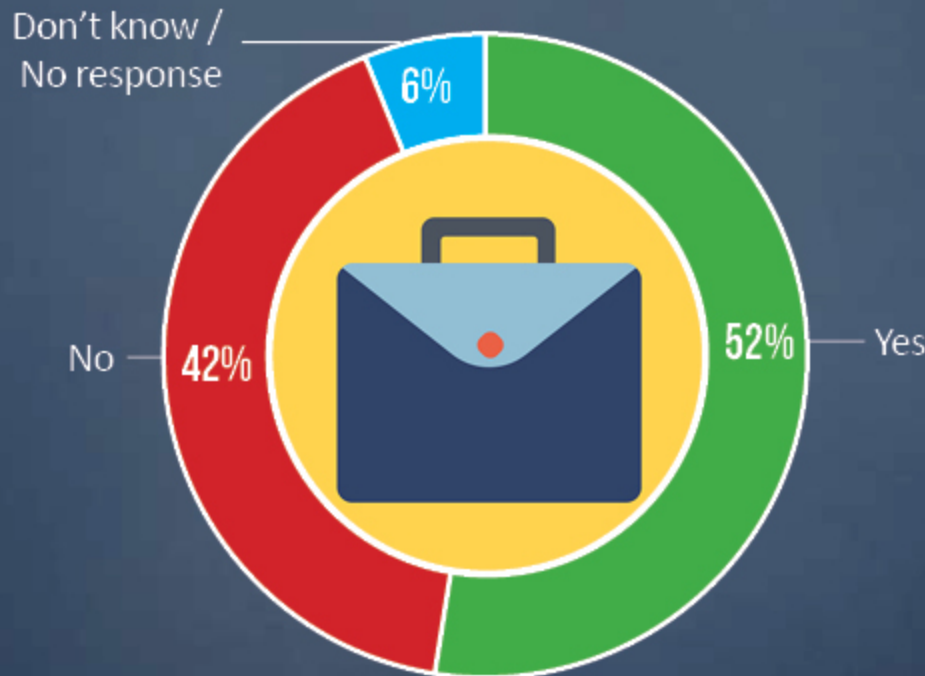

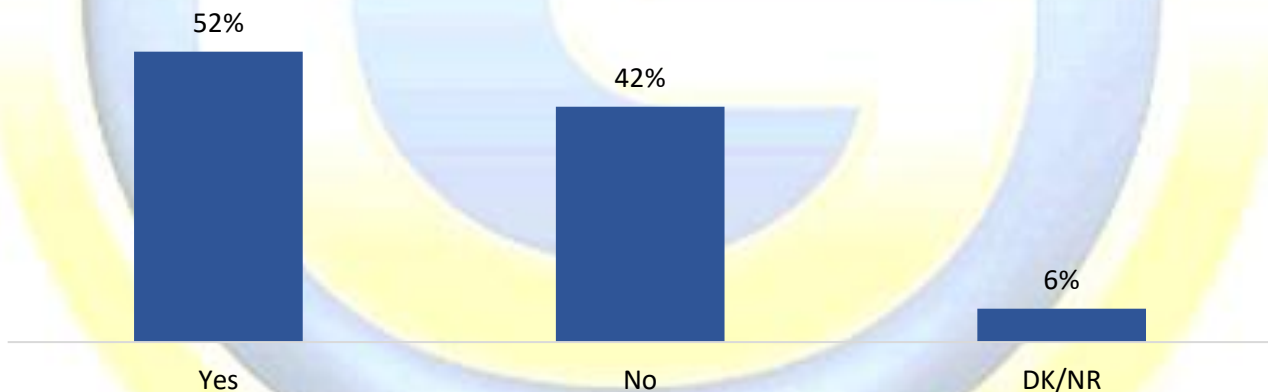

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, half (52%) Pakistanis report having the same occupation as their father with the majority of males (55%) as compared to females (49%) claiming this.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across Pakistan was asked the following question, “Would you please tell me if your father's occupation is different from yours?” In response to this question, 52% said yes, 42% said no and 6% didn't know or gave no response.

Question: “Would you please tell me if your father's occupation is different from yours?”

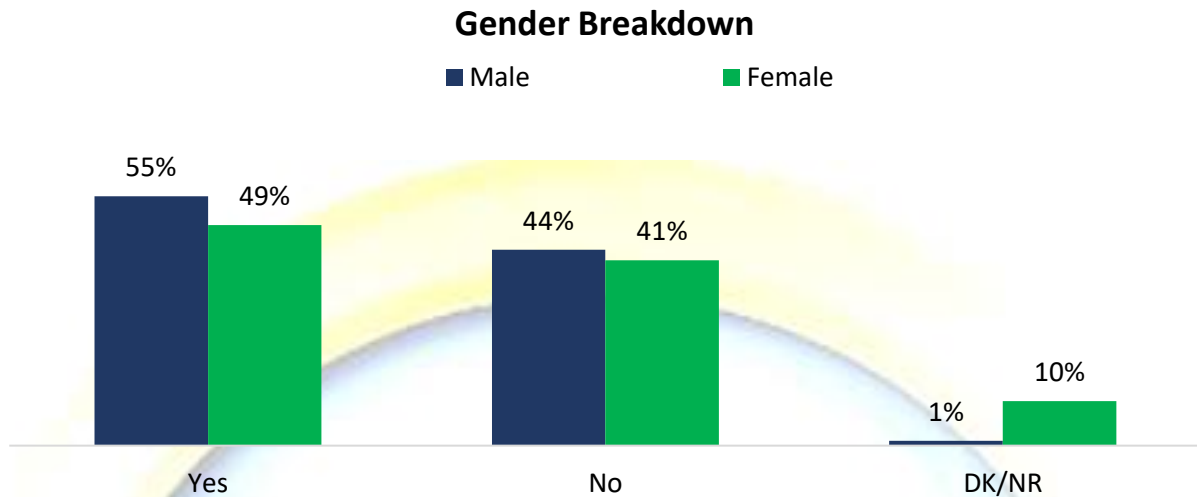

Gender Breakdown

More males (55%) than females (49%) report to be in the same profession as their father.



The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1103 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, from March 15, 2022 - March 23, 2022. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was CATI.
