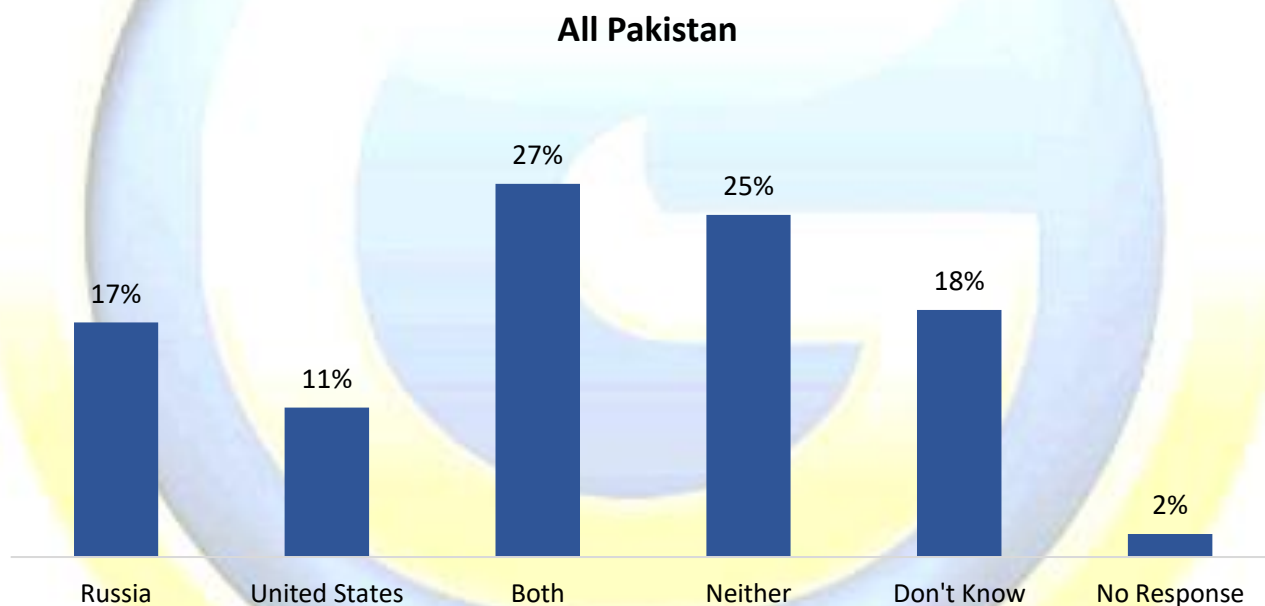
A quarter (25%) Pakistanis think that the country should not be allied with either the United States or Russia: Gallup & Gallup Pakistan

(Islamabad), June 15, 2022

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, a quarter (25%) Pakistanis think that the country should not be allied with either the United States or Russia.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the capital was asked the following question, “*If one must be allied with either Russia or the United States, which country should Pakistan be allied with?*” In response to this question, 17% said Russia, 11% said the United States, 27% said both, 25% said neither, 18% said don’t know and 2% gave no response.

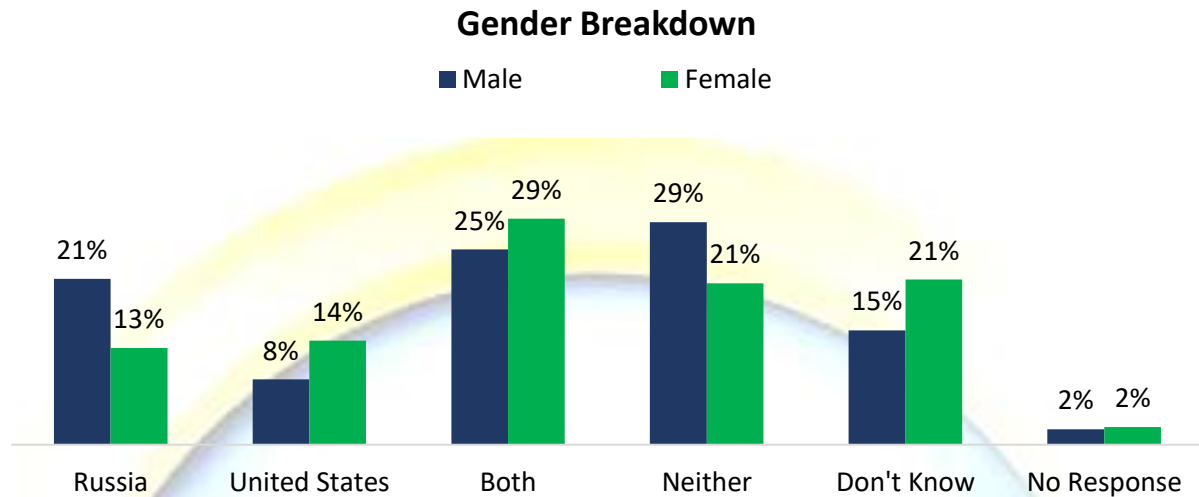
Question: “If one must be allied with either Russia or the United States, which country should Pakistan be allied with?”

Gender Breakdown

More females (29%) than males (25%) believe Pakistan should be allied with both the United States and Russia.



The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1103 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, from March 15, 2022 - March 23, 2022. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was CATI.
