More than half (54%) of Pakistanis believe that inflation is the biggest challenge Pakistan currently faces: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

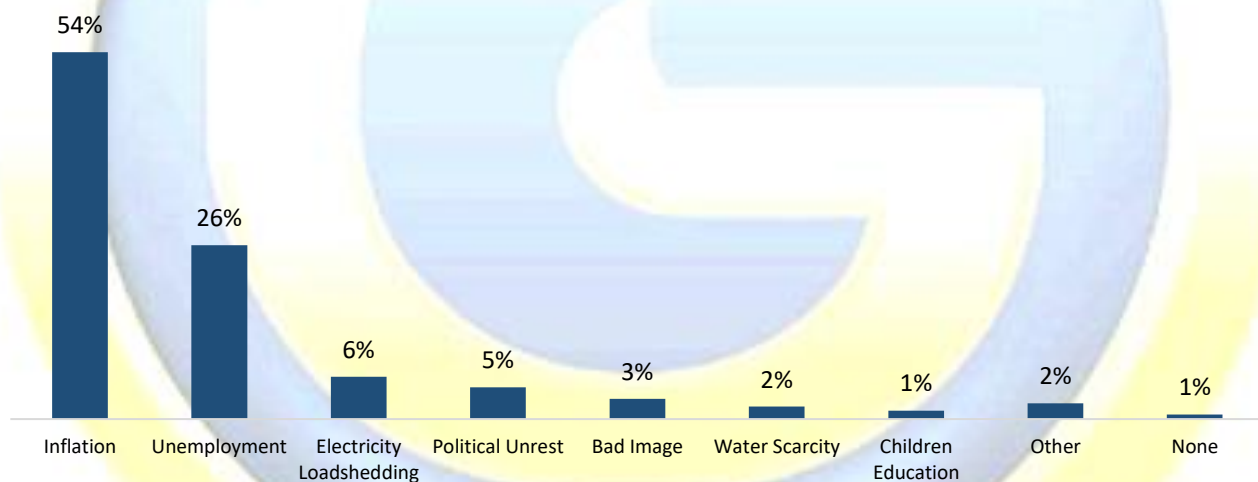

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, more than half (54%) of Pakistanis believe that inflation is the biggest challenge Pakistan currently faces.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was asked the following question, “Which is the biggest challenge that Pakistan is facing currently?” In response to this question, 54% said inflation, 26% said unemployment, 6% said electricity load-shedding, 5% said political unrest, 3% said bad image, 2% said water scarcity, 1% said children’s education, 2% said other and 1% said none.

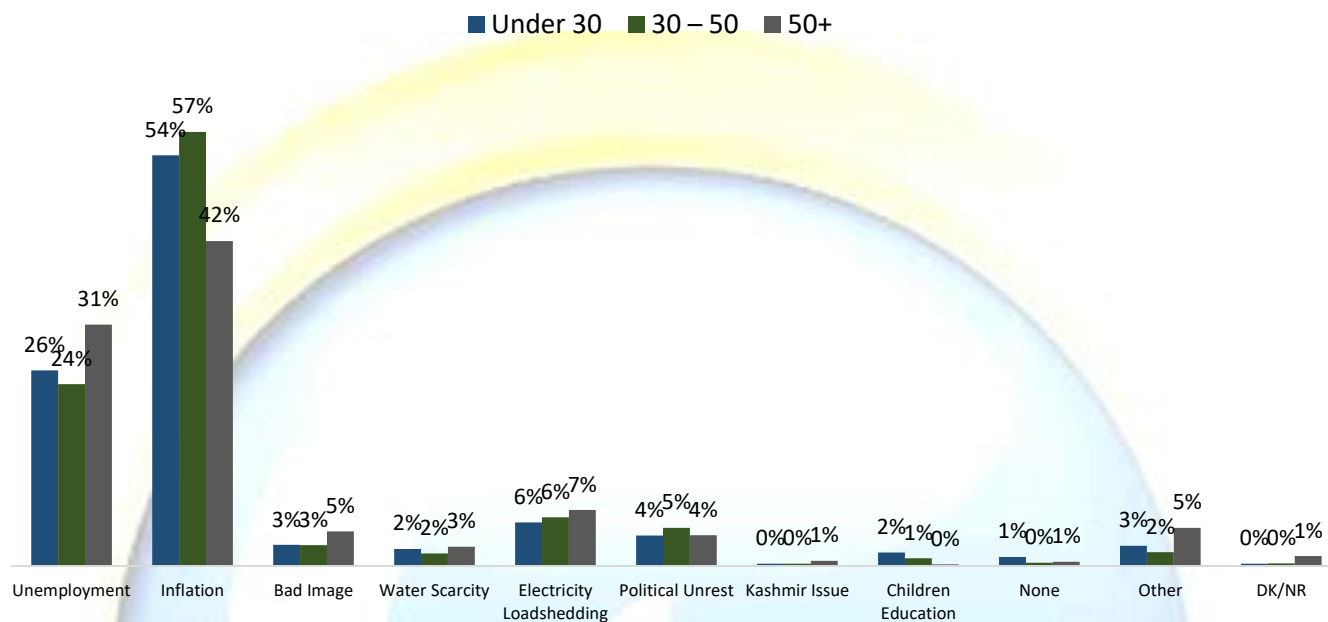

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1369 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, from May 16, 2022 - May 23, 2022. The error margin is estimated to be approximately ± 2 -3 percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was CATI.
