## Opinion Poll Security

**67% of respondents globally as compared to 32% of Pakistanis believe that Russia is not doing enough to stop the Russian-Ukrainian war; in Pakistan, more people say that the US is not doing enough to stop the war: Gallup Pakistan and WIN World Survey report released**

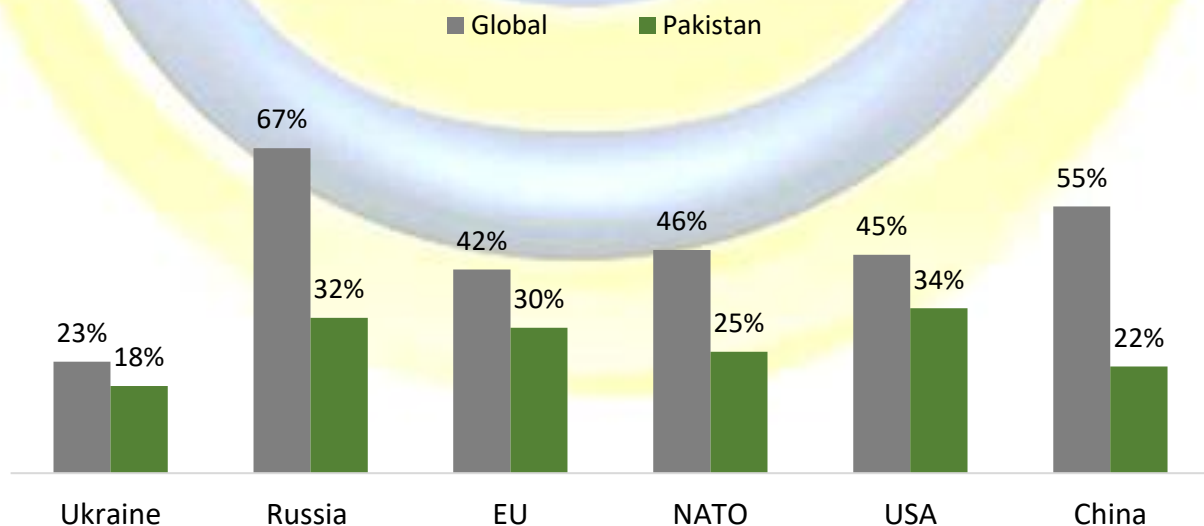
According to a Gallup Pakistan Survey in Pakistan (and similar surveys done by Worldwide Independent Network of Market Research (WIN) across the world), 67% of respondents globally as compared to 32% of Pakistanis believe that Russia is not doing enough to stop the Russian-Ukrainian war; in Pakistan, more people say that the US is not doing enough to stop the war.

These findings emerge from an international survey conducted across the globe by The Worldwide Independent Network of Market Research (WIN) - a global network conducting market research and opinion polls in every continent. WIN International has published the Annual WIN World Survey (WWS – 2021), exploring the views and beliefs of 19,422 individuals, among citizens from 24 countries across the globe. The fieldwork for Pakistan was conducted between 5<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> April 2022 and the sample size was 500 individuals.

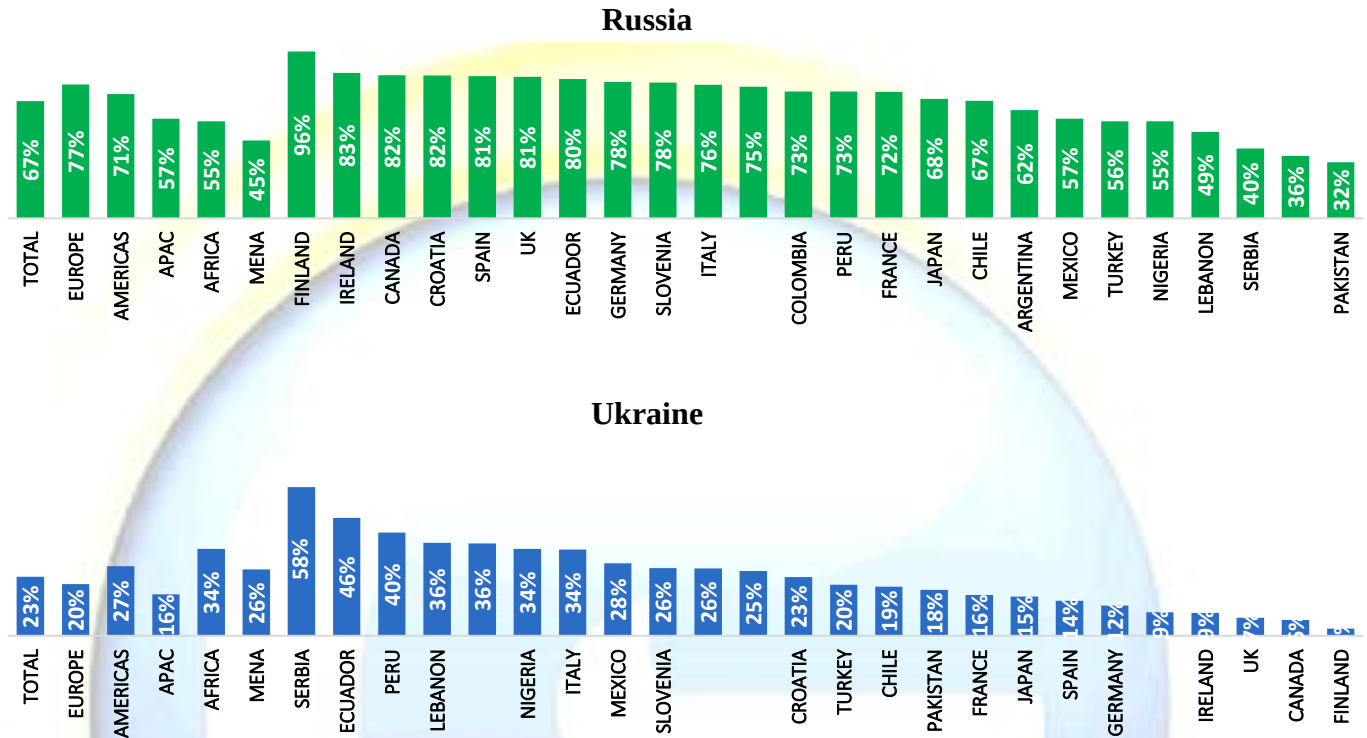
A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the world were asked the following question, “Do you think each of the following is doing enough or not doing enough to help stopping the war – Not doing enough” In response to this question in Pakistan, 18% said Ukraine, 32% said Russia, 30% said EU, 25% said NATO, 34% said USA, and 22% said China.

## Country Breakdown

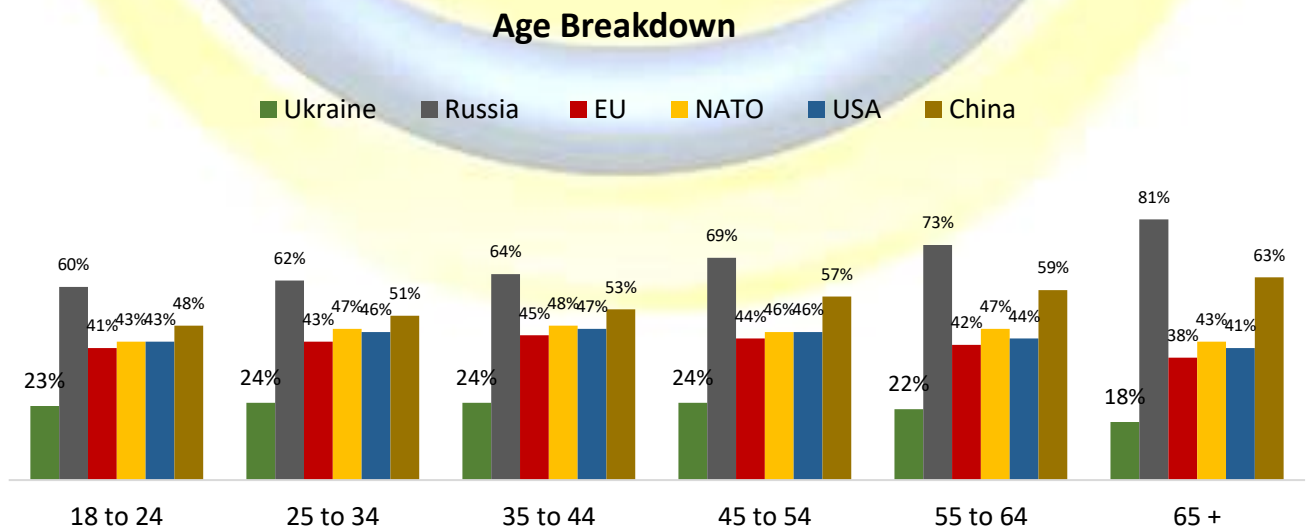
Finland (96%) has the highest number of people who say Russia is not doing enough to stop the war while Siberia (58%) has the highest number of people who say Ukraine is not doing enough to stop the Russian-Ukrainian war.

## Age Breakdown

Globally, the older generation (65+) has the greatest number (81%) of people who believe that Russia is not doing enough to stop the Russian-Ukrainian war.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 500 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, April 5 –April 8, 2022. The error margin is estimated to be approximately  $\pm 2$ -3 percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was CATI.
