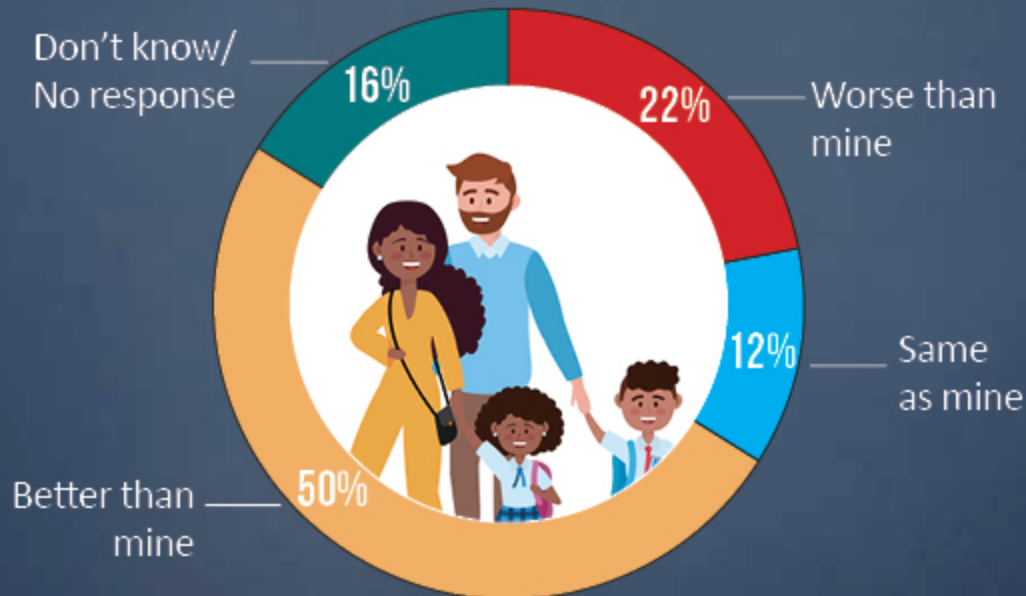

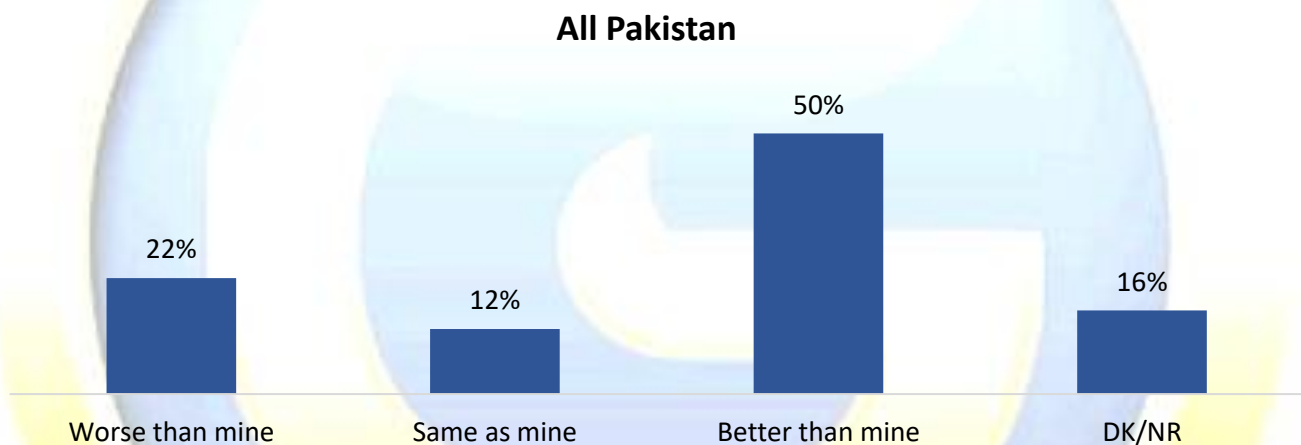
50% Pakistanis believe their children's standard of living will be better than theirs in the coming times: Gallup & Gallup Pakistan

(Islamabad), June 3, 2022

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 50% Pakistanis believe their children's standard of living will be better than theirs in the coming times.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the capital was asked the following question, *"When your children are as old as you are now, do you think their standard of living...?"* In response to this question, 22% said worse than mine, 12% said same as mine, 50% said better than mine and 16% didn't know or gave no response.

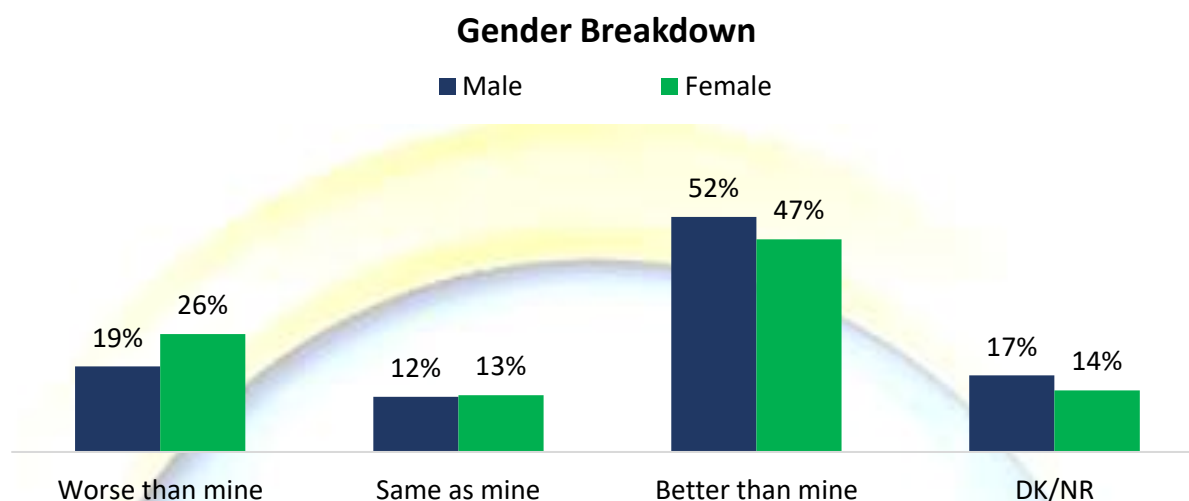
Question: "When your children are as old as you are now, do you think their standard of living...?"

Gender Breakdown

More males (52%) compared to females (47%) expect their children's standard of living to be better than theirs.



The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1103 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, from March 15, 2022 - March 23, 2022. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was CATI.
