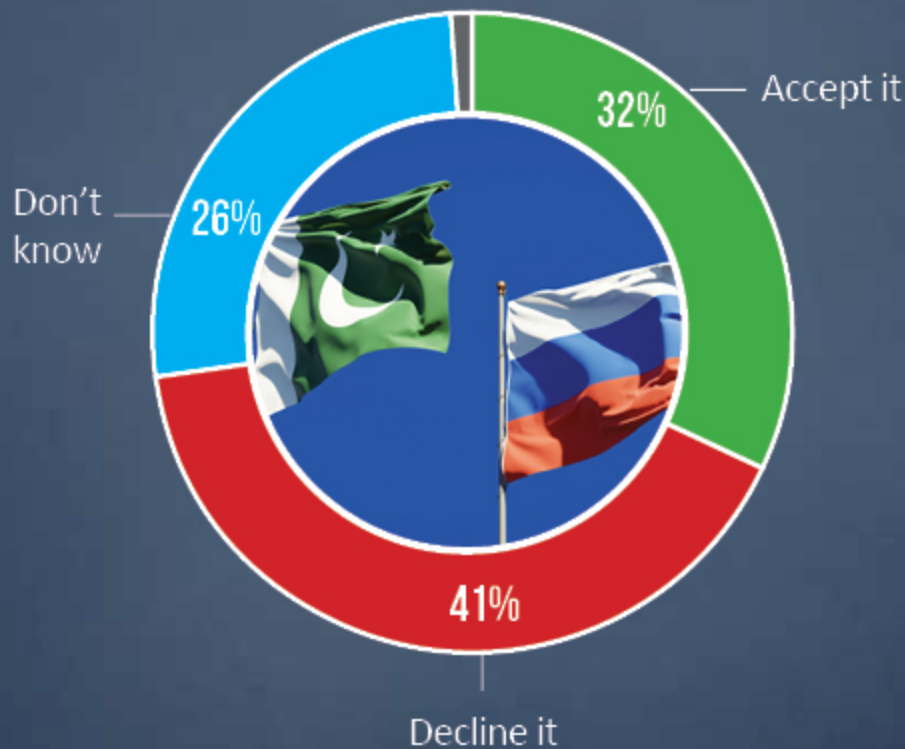

One-third (32%) Pakistanis are in favour of accepting aid or grant money from Russia: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

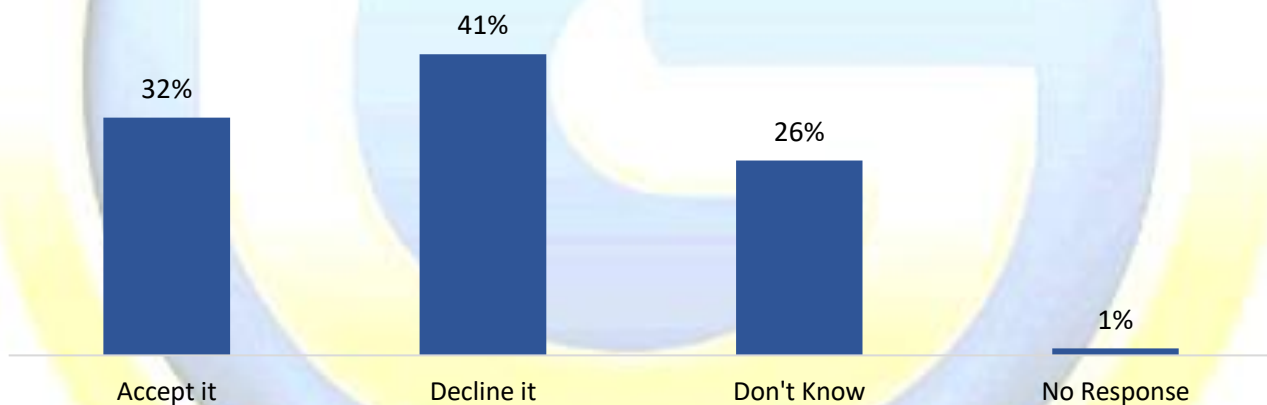

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, One-third (32%) Pakistanis are in favour of accepting aid or grant money from Russia.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across Pakistan was asked the following question, *“If Russia offers economic aid to Pakistan, in your opinion, Pakistan should...”* In response to this question, 32% said to accept it, 41% said decline it, 26% said don't know and 1% gave no response.

Question: “If Russia offers economic aid to Pakistan, in your opinion, Pakistan should...?”

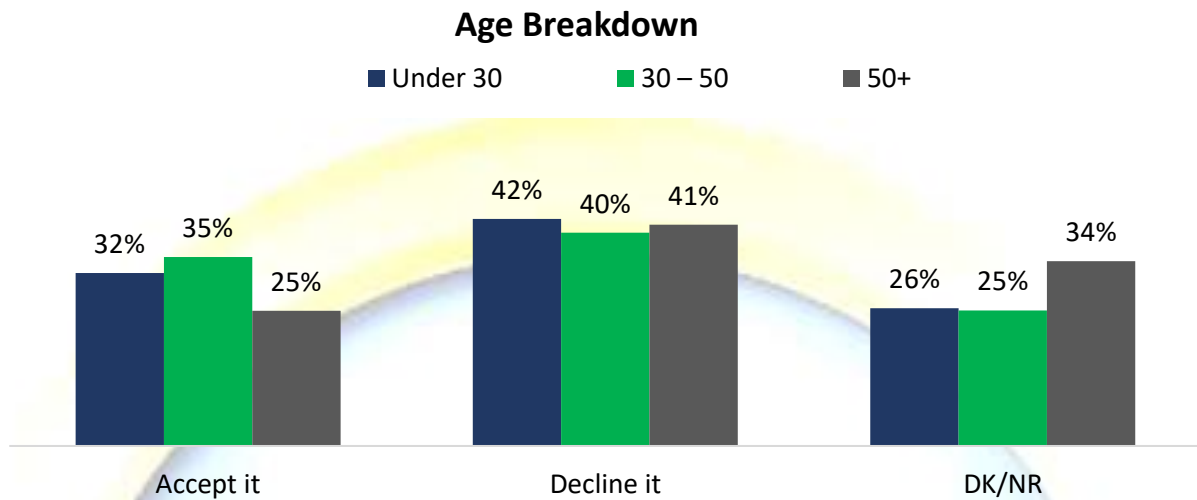
All Pakistan

Age Breakdown

More people (35%) in the age bracket of 30 to 50 years believe the government should accept economic aid from Russia.



The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1103 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, from March 15, 2022 - March 23, 2022. The error margin is estimated to be approximately ± 2 -3 percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was CATI.
