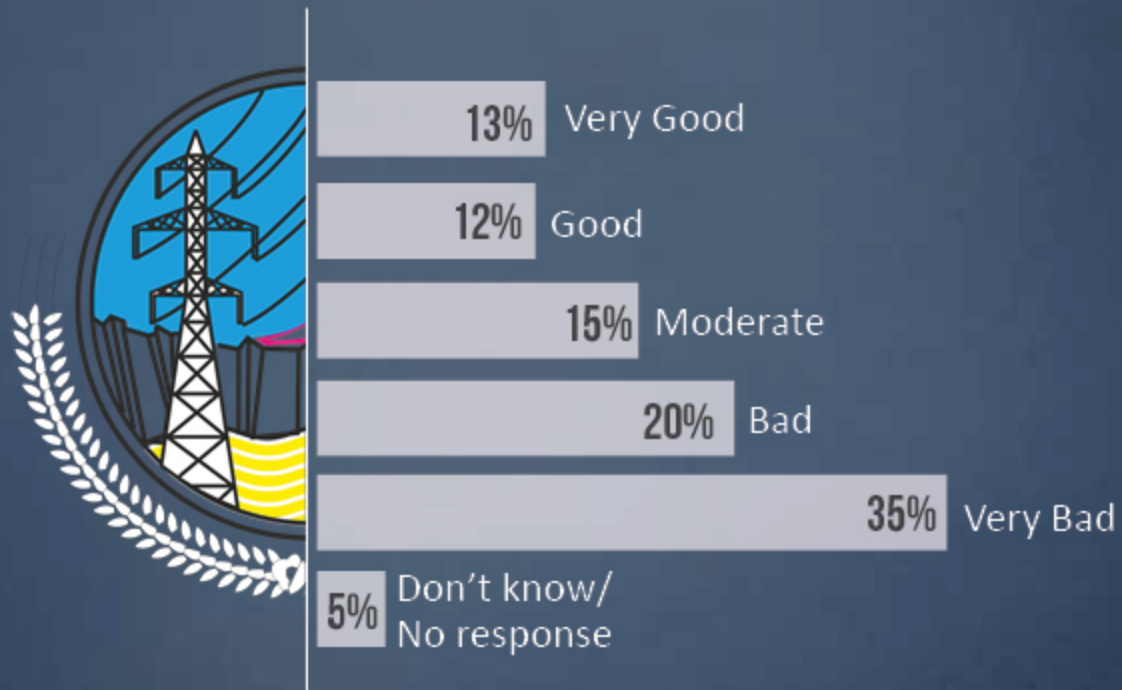

More than half (55%) believe that the performance of WAPDA has been bad over the past year: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

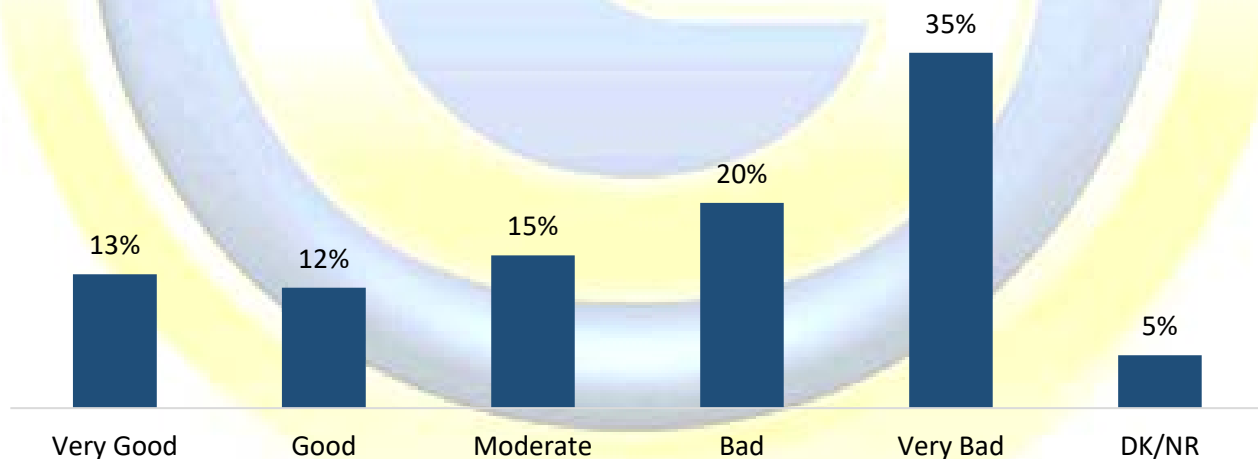

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, more than half (55%) believe that the performance of WAPDA has been bad over the past year

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was asked the following question, “I will name a few institutions. Please state your opinion on the performance of these institutions in the last year. Rate each institution's performance from very good, good, bad, to very bad. - WAPDA” In response to this question, 13% said that the performance of WAPDA has been very good, 12% said good, 15% said moderate, 20% said bad, and 35% said very bad, while 5% had observed that WAPDA is used as generic name for what are also called as DISCOs in the country. In other words, the rating may be taken as an overall view of the consumers about the electricity related institutions in general.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1234 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, from 30 May 2022 – 13 June 2022. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was CATI.
