

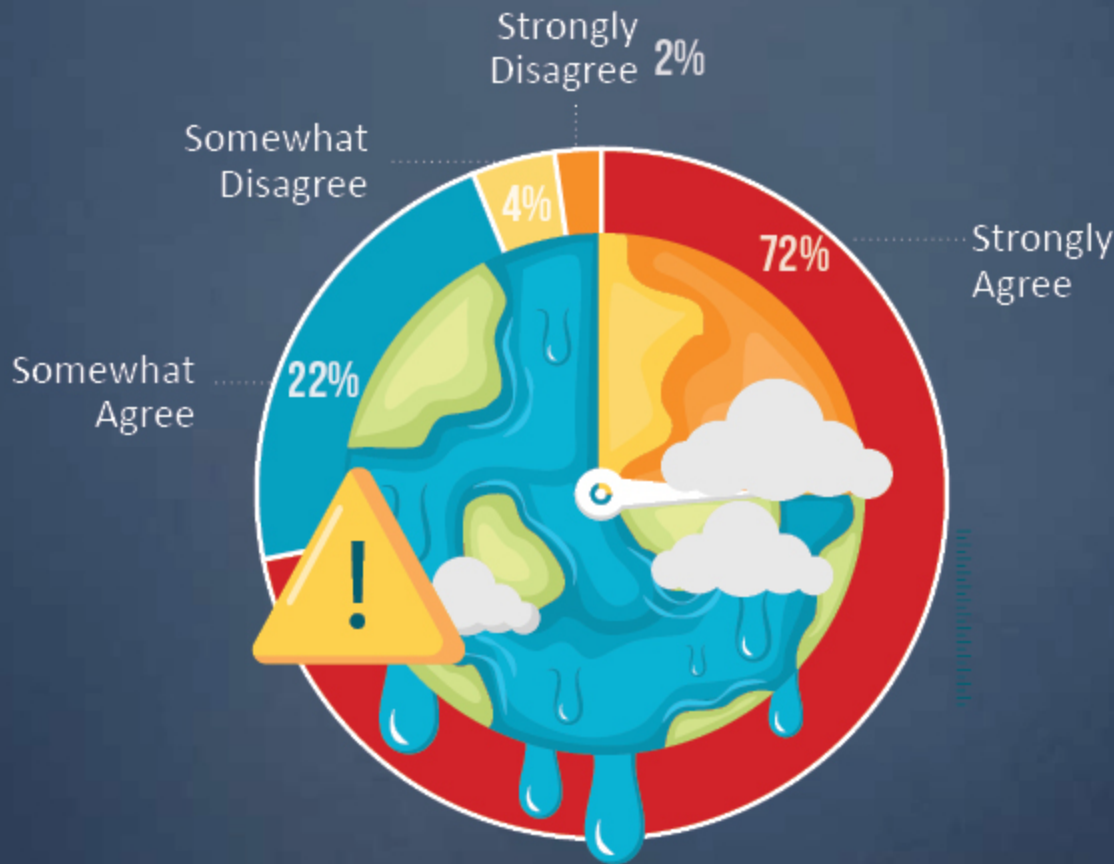

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan and Davaam 94% respondents either strongly agreed or agreed that they have felt extreme weather in recent years

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the four major cities of Pakistan including Lahore, Karachi, Rawalpindi/Islamabad, and Peshawar was asked the following question, “*I have felt extreme weather in the recent years?*” In response to this question, 72% respondents strongly agreed, 22% somewhat agree, 4% somewhat disagree and 2% strongly disagree that they have felt extreme weather in recent years.

The study was carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International and Davaam. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1000 men and women in urban areas of the cities including Karachi, Lahore, Islamabad/ Rawalpindi, and Peshawar, from 12th April – 17th May. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was CAPI.
