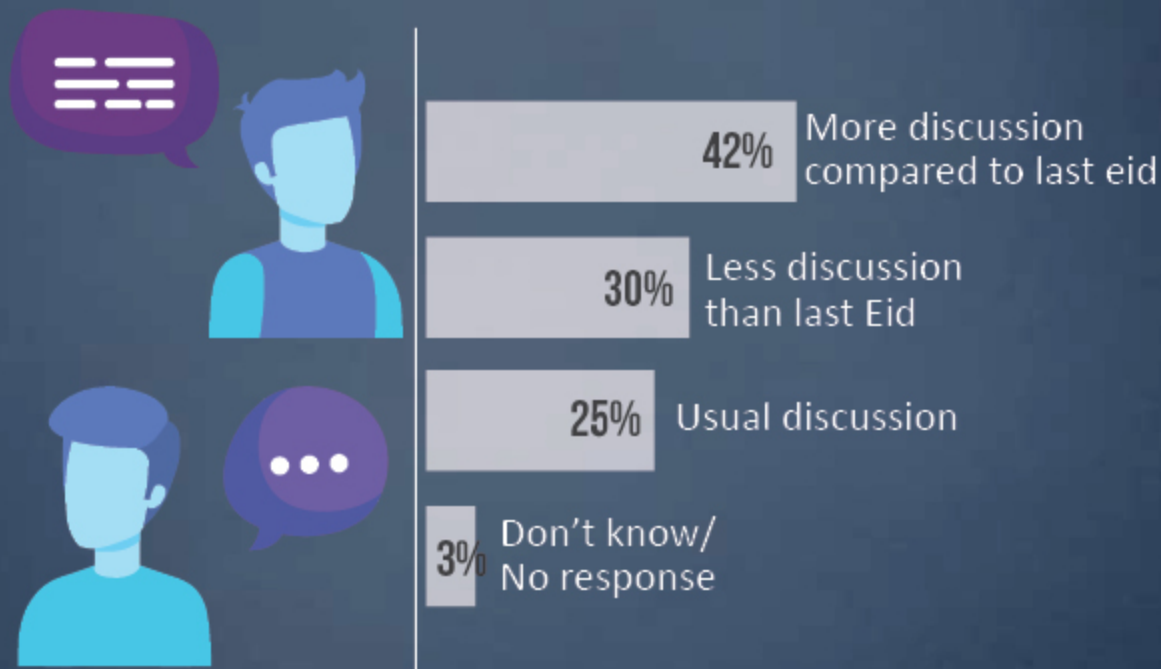

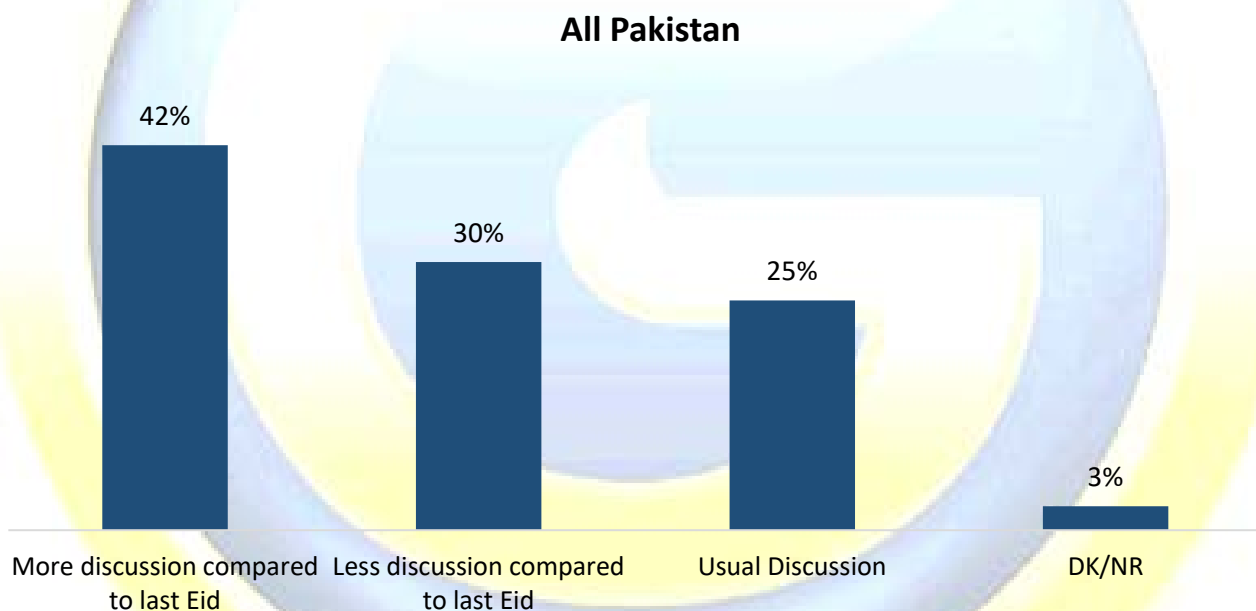
2 in 5 (42%) Pakistanis reported having more political discussions at family gatherings on Eid this year compared to last year: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 2 in 5 (42%) Pakistanis reported having more political discussions at family gatherings on Eid this year compared to last year.

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was presented with the following statement, “Compared to last year, what was the level of discussion on politics this year at Eid?” In response to this statement, 42% said more discussion than last Eid, 30% said less discussion than last Eid, 25% said the usual amount of discussion happened, and 3% did not know or gave no reply.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1369 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, from May 16, 2022 - May 23, 2022. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was CATI.
