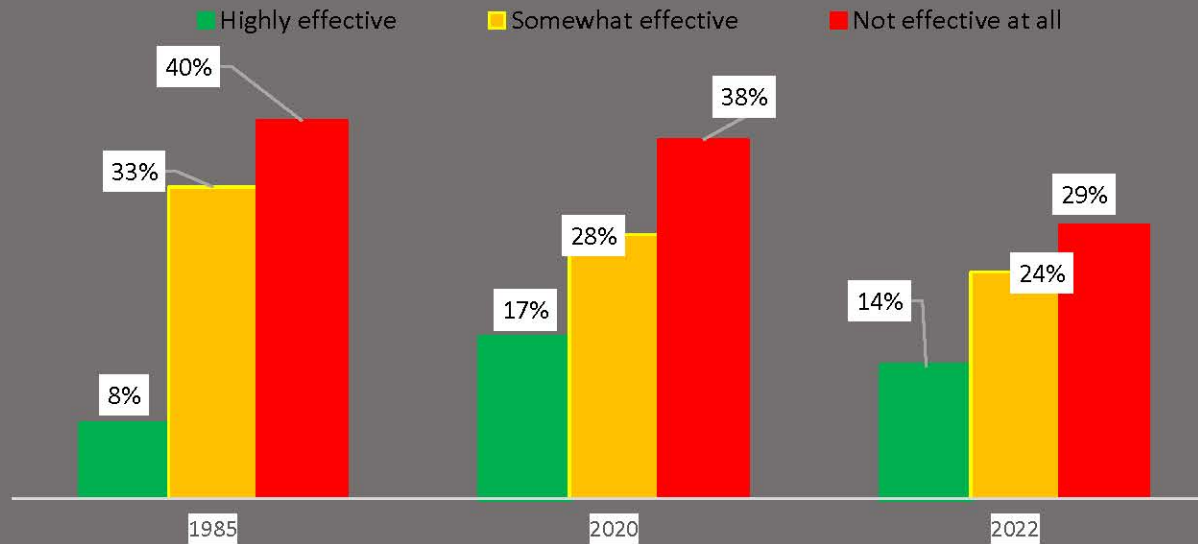

Support for United Nations as a peace-keeping organization increased by 6% from 8% in 1985 to 14% in 2022: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan

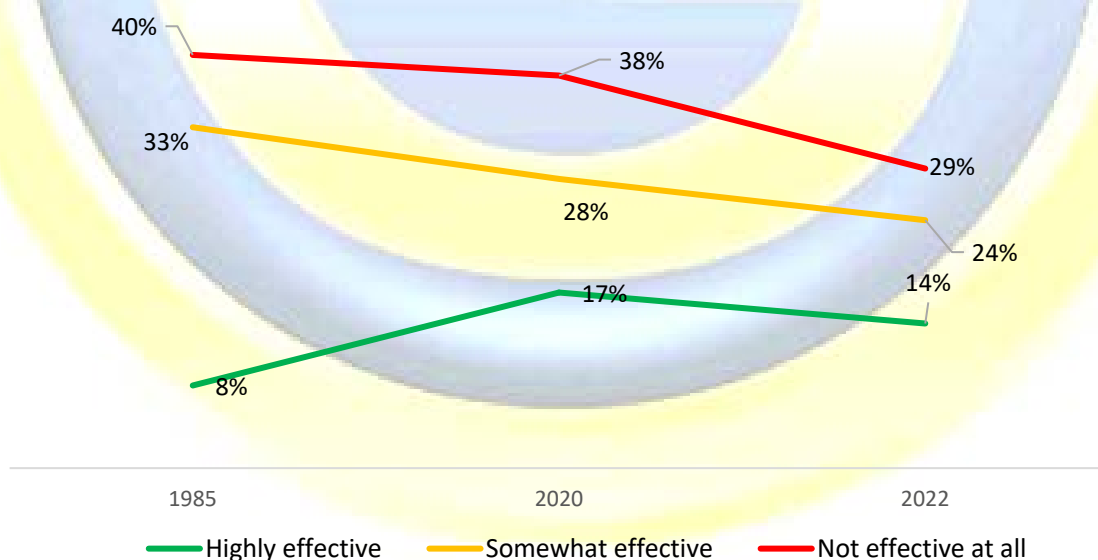
In a Gallup & Gilani Pakistan National Survey conducted in the year 1985, a representative sample of adult men and women from across Pakistan was asked the following question “*In your opinion, how effective has the United Nations been in keeping peace?*” In response to this question, 8% said highly effective, 33% said somewhat effective, 40% said not effective at all, and 19% didn’t know or gave no response.

Comparative Picture: This question was asked again in 2022 to allow a comparison to be made across the years. In response to this question in 2022, 14% said highly effective, 24% said somewhat effective, 29% said not effective at all, and 33% didn’t know or gave no response.

Trend Analysis: Support for United Nations as a peace-keeping organization increased by 6% from 8% in 1985 to 14% in 2022. However, respondents who believed United Nations to be somewhat effective decreased from 33% in 1985 to 24% in 2022.
