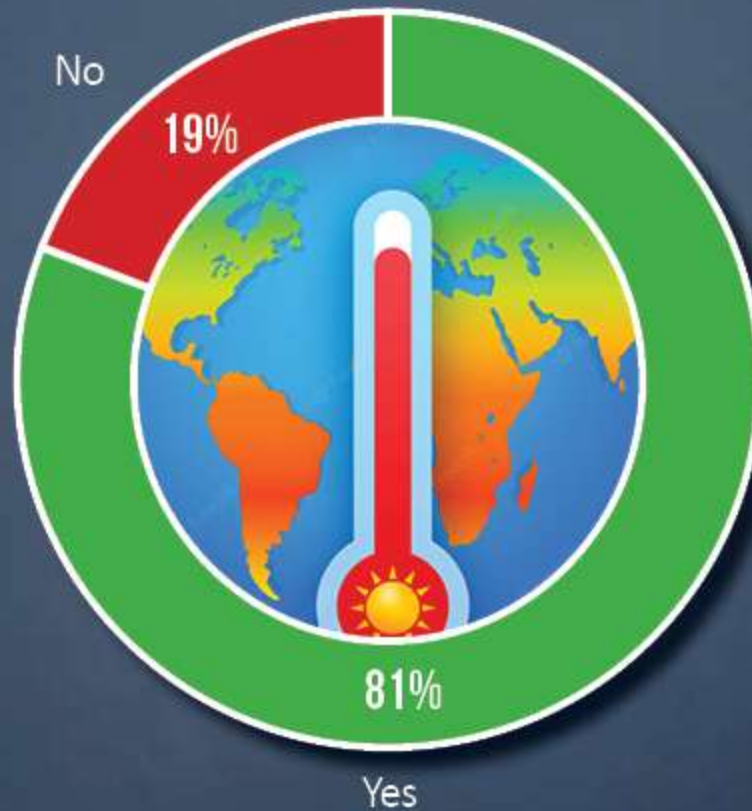

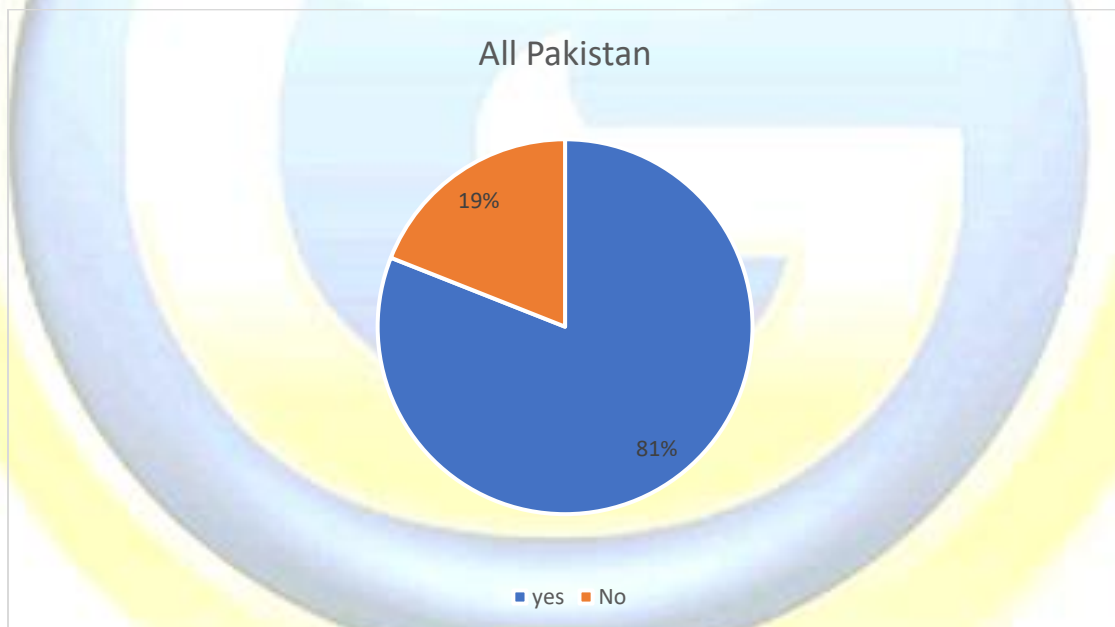
**81% Pakistanis believe that climate change has exacerbated the severity of flooding in Pakistan: Gallup & Gilani Pakistan**

According to a survey conducted by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 81% of respondents believe that climate change has exacerbated the severity of flooding

A nationally representative sample of adult men and women from across the country was asked the following question, “Some people think that due to climate change, the floods this year have been more serious, do you agree with this?” In response to this question, 81% said ‘Yes’ while 19% responded ‘No’

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of more than 991 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, from September 01, 2022 – September 16, 2022. The error margin is estimated to be approximately  $\pm 3$ -5 percent at the 95% confidence level. The methodology used for data collection was telephonic and Face to Face surveys
